

After jumping out to a 2-0 series lead at home in the Double-A Central Championship Series, the Naturals hit the road and traveled to Wichita , where after falling behind early, stormed back to take a lead and win the game 6-2, while April														

- sweeping the series as well. Clay Dungan started the scoring in the game for the Naturals, bringing home Blake Perkins on a sacrifice fly in the third inning, tying the score at 1-1.
- Brewer Hicklen connected on a go-ahead grand slam in the fourth inning, a home run that ended up being the difference in the game ... the inning began with a Meibrys Viloria single, followed by a Seuly Matias walk and Freddy Fermin single, loading the bases for Hicklen to hit his second grand slam of the season ... Hicklen's first grand slam of the season came just two weeks earlier at Riverfront Stadium, on September 9th as a part of a 10-run second inning in Wichita.
- Drew Parrish started for the Naturals, allowing two runs on three hits with five strikeouts across 4.0 innings. Nolan Watson earned the win, his third in the span of two weeks ... Watson followed Parrish with 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits and not walking a batter while striking out one.
- As he did in each of the first two games of the Championship Series, Jose Cuas finished the game for the Naturals, throwing a scoreless ninth inning to secure the win for Northwest Arkansas.
- Seven of the nine Naturals starters in the lineup recorded hits, including a 2-for-4 day from Fermin. All six runs were scored by different players as well. Vinnie Pasquantino drove in a run, in addition to Dungan and Hicklen.

This Day in Naturals History The Naturals are 4-6 all-time when playing on April 8

On <u>April 8th, 2011</u>, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the San Antonio Mission 5-4 at Arvest Ballpark in an extra

inning thriller. San Antonio scored twice in the eighth to tie the score at four and force extra innings and in the

bottom of the 11th, Nick Van Stratten hit a single to right field to score Anthony Seratelli from second base, the

22nd walk-off win in franchise history and first of seven in 2011. Current Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach Christian

Colón started at shortstop and hit second in the order, going 2-3 with a double, one of four two-hit games that day.

### THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 Opening Day Roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Angel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was catcher Tyler Cropley and outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, Holden Capps was on the Naturals' championship Series roster, while Gavin Stupienski and Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021.
- Parrish started Game 3 of the Double-A Central Championship Series
   in Wichita, the last game the Naturals played ... he will start today at Springfield as well in the season opener.

### **STAR-STUDDED ROTATION**

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP **Drew Parrish** will start Friday, April 8th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 30 in the system, while *Baseball America* has him at No. 38.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano will start Saturday, April 9th for the Naturals

   MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 18 in the system, while Baseball America
   has him at No. 21.
- LHP Angel Zerpa will start Sunday, April 10th for the Naturals ... MLB
   Pipeline lists him at No. 14 in the system, while *Baseball America* has him at No. 21.
- LHP Asa Lacy will start Tuesday, April 12th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 left-handed pitching prospect, while *Baseball America* has him at No. 2 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.
- RHP Alec Marsh will start Wednesday, April 13th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.

### Follow The Leader

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Burlington (2019) and Quad Cities (A+) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, as well as in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Angel Zerpa.

### **OPENING DAY HISTORY**

2022 marks the 14th Opening Day for the Northwest Arkansas Naturals.

- The Naturals are 6-7 all-time on Opening Day, a win today would bring the club's Opening Day Winning percentage to .500.
- The Naturals have won three consecutive season openers: April 5, 2018 @ Corpus Christi (5-4 W); April 4, 2019 vs. Springfield (5-1 Win) and May 4, 2021 @ Arkansas (7-4 win).
- 2021 marks just the second time the Naturals have opened up against the Cardinals, the last being at home in 2019.
- The Naturals are opening on the road for the second straight season and seventh time in 14 Opening Day games.
- Last year on Opening Day, catcher MJ Melendez became just the second Natural to homer twice in the season opener, while Dairon Blanco became the first to draw three walks, while he and Brewer Hicklen each stole two bases in North Little Rock.

### **BOBBY BASEBALL DEBUTS**

Yesterday, infielder **Bobby Witt Jr.** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 110th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Witt is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 14 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Right-handed pitcher Collin Snider and 2021 Naturals reliever will likely be the 111th Natural to make his big league debut, as he cracked the opening day roster for Kansas City but did not pitch Thursday.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: Scott Barlow, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont, Bobby Witt Jr ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals and Snider has not yet debuted.

### FALL LEAGUE PHENOMS

The Kansas City Royals sent nine players to the Arizona Fall League in 2021 to play for the Surprise Saguaros ... of those nine, seven are on the Naturals roster.

- Zach Haake pitched in six games (five starts) and went 1-1 with a 6.61 ERA (12 ER in 16.1 IP) and 14 strikeouts ... Asa Lacy made four starts and went 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts ... Alec Marsh made one start and went 1-0 with a 27.00 ERA (4 ER in 1.1 IP) and three strikeouts ... Stephen Woods Jr. pitched in 10 games (one start) and went 0-0 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER in 17.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts.
- **Nate Eaton** played in 20 games, hitting .317 (26-for-82) with a .815 OPS and 13 runs batted in, he finished fourth on the team with 38 total bases ... **Seuly Matias** played in 22 games, hitting .188 (15-for-80) with a .712 OPS, six home runs and 20 runs batted in, both of which were tied for the team lead ... **Jake Means** played in 19 games, hitting .171 (12-for-70) with a .515 OPS and five runs batted in.

## **#36 CHRIS WIDGER • MANAGER**

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by *Baseball America* following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.

## **#43 DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH**

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.
- Pitching coach timeline: 2004-07: GCL Braves (Gulf Coast League, RK)... 2008-10: Danville Braves (Appalachian League, RK)... 2011-13: Rome Braves (South Atlantic League, A)... 2014: Lynchburg Hillcats (Carolina League, A+)... 2015-2016: Carolina Mudcats (Carolina League, A+)... 2017: Mississippi Braves (Southern League, AA)
- He played seven seasons in the Braves' organization from 1997-2003, after being selected in the 20th round of the 1997 draft.


