**Tonight's Game:** The Sounds and Storm Chasers play game three of the six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. Isaac Collins scored Nashville's second walk-off win of the season, coming away with the game-winning single in the 10th for a 6-5 win. Left-hander Aaron Ashby gets the start for the Sounds on Throwback Thursday, facing Omaha's Luis Cessa in a battle of former MLB starters.

**Aaron Ashby:** The 25-year-old makes his fourth start of the season and third with Nashville. The southpaw is 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA (7.1 IP/10 ER) with the Sounds and took the loss in his lone start with Milwaukee on April 8 at Cincinnati (3.2 IP, 6 H, 8 R, 4 ER, 2 BB, 2 K). Ashby was chased from his last start in the third inning at Memphis, getting credited with seven runs (all earned) in the loss. He totaled 64 pitches and 33 strikes. He missed most of the 2023 season recovering from arthroscopic surgery in his left shoulder, making only rehab appearances with Wisconsin, Biloxi and Nashville. He made his Major League debut in 2021 with the Brewers. Ashby signed a contract extension on July 23, 2022 that will keep him under contract through the 2027 season. He was originally taken in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft by Milwaukee out of Crowder College.

**Luis Cessa:** The 31-year-old veteran makes his fourth appearance and third start of the season with Omaha. He's 0-1 with a 9.53 ERA (5.2 IP/6 ER) in the start of his 14th season in affiliated baseball. Cessa took the loss in his last start vs. Gwinnett on April 12, allowing four runs (all earned) on three hits and three walks in one inning. He faced just six batters as his teammates nearly got him off the hook, dropping a 7-6 decision. Cessa pitched for Cincinnati, Albuquerque and Rochester last season, going 1-5 with an 8.57 ERA (42.0 IP/40 ER) at the Triple-A level and 1-4 with a 9.00 ERA (26.0 IP/26 ER) with the Reds. He's made 208 appearances and 35 starts in the Majors, mostly with the Yankees (2016-21), going 17-22 with a 4.43 ERA (425.0 IP/209 ER) with 141 walks and 331 strikeouts. Cessa was originally signed by the Mets as a free agent on July 9, 2008. He was born in Cordoba, Mexico in the state of Veracruz.

**In the Air Tonight:** After posting a night with three extra-base hits, Isaac Collins came through in the clutch with a walk-off single in the 10th inning. It was his first walk-off in affiliated baseball and the second walk-off in extras for the Sounds this season. In his first 10 games of the season, Collins is batting .278 (10-for-36) with six doubles, two triples, a homer, nine RBI, five walks and seven runs scored. He also boasts a .639 slugging percentage and .996 OPS in 42 plate appearances.

**Quality Carlos:** Starter Carlos Rodríguez put together his first quality start at the Triple-A level in a no-decision last night. After allowing two homers and three runs through the first three innings, the right-hander did not allow another run on the night. It was the second quality start by a Sounds pitcher this season and first since Tobias Myers' on April 6 vs. St. Paul. Rodríguez, who is the back-to-back recipient of the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year award, ended his Double-A season last year with three consecutive quality starts for the Shuckers.

**Paint It Black:** Tyler Black continued to crush the baseball at the plate last night, going 3-for-5 with a triple and two runs scored in the win. He is currently riding a five-game hitting streak (10-for--21) and has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games (381, 16 H, 8 RBI, 7 BB). The No. 41 prospect in baseball (MLB Pipeline) is tied for eighth in the International League with 20 hits.

**Bullpen Beat:** The Sounds bullpen gave up a pair of runs with Enoli Paredes' blown save in the ninth, but Harold Chirino kept Omaha off the scoreboard as the relievers picked up their sixth win of the season. Nashville relievers continue to lead the Triple-A level in most statistical categories, including ERA (1.30), WHIP (0.99) and opponent batting average (.159). The next closest bullpen ERAs at the level come in at 3.22 (Tacoma and Sacramento), while only Tacoma has a sub-.200 opponent batting average among relievers.

**Taking Bases:** Entering the series vs. Omaha, the Sounds had stolen 12 bases in 18 attempts on the season through 15 games. Since the series began, Nashville has swiped eight bases, four each in the last two games off Storm Chasers catcher Brian O'Keefe. It's the most by any team over the past two games at the Triple-A level. The Sounds are one of 13 teams at the level to have 20 stolen bases entering the day. Speedy cleanup hitter Brewer Hicklen is tied for sixth with eight stolen bases in Triple-A after taking a couple last night.

**Sounds to the Show:** Yesterday, Tobias Myers became the seventh Sound this season to be called up to Milwaukee's 26-man roster this season. He joins the list of JB Bukauskas (4/3), Aaron Ashby (4/6), Kevin Herget (4/9), Joey Wiemer (4/14), Jared Koenig (4/14) and Owen Miller (4/16).

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 691-592 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,283-2,113 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
