STELLAR PITCHING LEADS RIDERS TO NINTH WIN IN A ROW:

The Frisco RoughRiders won their ninth-straight game and completed their seven-game sweep of the San Antonio Missions on Sunday, winning 5-2 from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. After a few scoreless frames, San Antonio (22-28) scored first when Robbie Tenerowicz homered in the fourth off of Frisco (34-17) **Emiliano Teodo**. Teodo allowed just two runs, one earned, on three hits over five innings while walking three and striking out four. After San Antonio took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the fifth, **Keyber Rodriguez** ripped a game-tying, two-run single in the top of the sixth off to knot the game at 2-2. After the first two reached in the seventh, **Alex De Goti** dropped a sacrifice bunt down against Francis Peña (0-1), but the catcher's throw got away down the left field line, allowing two runs to score and give the Riders a 4-2 advantage. Frisco added their final run in the top of the ninth when **Aaron Zavala** worked a bases-loaded walk to make it 5-2. On the mound, the Riders received scoreless work from **Triston Polley** (one inning), **Andy Rodriguez** (two) and **Ricky DeVito** (one) tossed a runless ninth for his second save. **Josh Hatcher** paced the Frisco offense with three hits while **Cooper Johnson** and Rodriguez both had two hits.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING:

The RoughRiders have won nine games in a row after their 5-2 win over San Antonio on Sunday. It's their longest winning streak since their 11-game winning streak from 6/17-6/29, 2021 (franchise record). This is the first time that the Riders are 17 games over .500 since August 11th, 2021. During this streak, the Riders are outscoring their opponents 41-19 with a 1.87 ERA. Offensively, **Frainyer Chavez** has a team-best 10 hits, batting .370 while **Josh Hatcher** has six RBIs to pace the team and **Cooper Johnson** leads the club with two homers. On the mound, **Emiliano Teodo** has made two starts, allowing just two earned across 11.0 innings (1.64) while the bullpen has been paced by **Andy Rodriguez** (5.0 scoreless innings).

MAY FLOWERS:

With the month of May coming to an end, the RoughRiders have tied their franchise record for most wins in May with 19 (third time in franchise history, tying 2003 and 2010). Their 19 wins were the most in the Texas League and tied for the most in Double-A. Frisco's 3.45 team May ERA was second in the Texas League and their bullpen has dominated to the tune of a 2.62 ERA. **Emiliano Teodo** went 3-0 with a 0.82 ERA over four starts in the month.

WELCOME TO THE ROAD TRIP OF YOUR DREAMS:

The RoughRiders are in the midst of a two-week, 13-game road trip against the San Antonio Missions and the Corpus Christi Hooks. Having started the trip 7-0, Frisco is now 21-3 combined against their two division opponents and 14-15 against everyone else in the Texas League this season. On the mound against Corpus Christi and San Antonio, the Riders have a 2.64 ERA (62ER/111.0 IP) and, funny enough, they have allowed exactly 31 earned runs in 12 games against both teams.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 16 games, they are 11-5, but are hitting .240 (30-for-125) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .279 with RISP. **Josh Hatcher** leads the team and is 11th in the Texas League, batting .327 with RISP.

MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

Keyber Rodriguez has been tearing up the baseball over the last couple of weeks. In his last 15 games, Rodriguez is hitting .389 (21-for-54) with seven multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, two triples, a home run, 10 RBIs, four walks, six runs scored and a steal. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .299 and OPS from .371 to .847 over the last two weeks.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Riders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** went 0-for-5 on Friday, snapping his 32-game on-base streak. During the streak, he hit .322 (38-for-118)/.409/.458/.867 with three doubles, a two triples, three home runs, 12 RBIs, 18 walks, seven steals and 29 runs scored. The streak was the second-longest active streak in the Texas League (Yeiner Fernandez, 34G with Tulsa). In his career, Strahm has the second-longest on-base streak in RoughRiders franchise history (37 games in 2022). His 165 career walks with the RoughRiders are the second-most in franchise history, trailing only **Guilder Rodriguez**, who walked 206 times over seven seasons from 2009 to 2015.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

In an incredible win on April 27th, **Josh Hatcher** hammered a three-run, walk-off home run for a 4-3 win over Amarillo. Hatcher's capper was his third home run in as many games. He is slashing .315/.354/.470/.824. Hatcher is third in the league in batting average (.315). Hatcher was named the Rangers Minor League Player of the Month for April. He slashed .373/.403/.576/.979 over 15 games for Frisco in April with three doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 11 runs and three steals. He finished third in the Texas League in batting average (.373), tied for eighth in RBIs (16), sixth in slugging (.576) and sixth in OPS (.979).

ABOUT JOSH

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Ala., and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate.

2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 80% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.
