Today's Game

The Fightin Phils finish the first series of the second half of the season at Richmond. It is the final-of-six games against the Flying Squirrels this season and the last of six games at The Diamond, the final game Reading will ever play at The Diamond. Richmond captured the 2024 series over Reading 5-1. The Flying Squirrels don't return to Reading this season and have not played at FirstEnergy Stadium since June 28-July 3, of the 2023 season. With a win today, the Fightin Phils will capture their second series win of the season, with the other being May 13-18 against New Hampshire, which Reading won 4-2.

Game 72 Recap

The Fightin Phils led wire-to-wire in Saturday's 4-2 victory over Richmond. Reading struck first with three runs in the top of the third inning. Paul McIntosh hit a solo home run, then Jose Rodriguez clubbed a two-run shot, his first home run since returning to Reading. The R-Phils tacked on another run in the fourth thanks to a sac fly from Alex Binelas. Estibenon Jimenez started and did not allow any runs through the first five innings of the night. Jimenez was tagged for back-to-back home runs by Carter Howell and Victor Bericoto to make it 4-2. In total, Jimenez allowed two runs on three hits over 5.2 innings, along with three strikeouts. Daniel Harper followed by not allowing a run over 1.1 innings of work, then Tommy McCollum got the final six outs for his third save of the season.

The Ball was Flying in June

Entering the final game of June, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit for the month with 29. That mark leads second place Somerset by two homers. Entering play today, the R-Phils rank third in the league in home runs hit with 62 on the season. Reading has matched a season-high with home runs in five-straight games, dating back to Tuesday. For the week, Reading and Richmond are tied for the most home runs hit in the Eastern League with six.

Cabrera in Control

Sunday's starter Jean Cabrera has showed vast improvements in his walk numbers on the season. He enters play today with 38 walks allowed, which is the second most issued in the Eastern League this season. But, since May 25 (six starts/32.1 IP) Cabrera has issued just eight walks, which ranks as the 49th most allowed in the Eastern League. Entering play on Sunday, Cabrera is fifth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (70), third in innings pitched (73.2) and fifth in average against (.210). Also, Cabrera has the 13th-best ERA amongst qualified pitchers in the Eastern League at 3.91. The right-handed arm was strong on Tuesday against Richmond, allowed two runs over six innings, and picking up his second victory of the season.

Shutting Them Down

Reading's pitching staff turned in its second shutout of the season on Thursday night. The last shutout came May 27 against Erie, when Reading also won 1-0. Mitch Neunborn also pitched in that shutout win for the Fightin Phils, tossing three-scoreless innings. The Fightin Phils turned in 10 shutout wins in 2024, but have only tossed two so far this season. A big help in the shutout win was Richmond hit into four double plays on Thursday night. The R-Phils entered the night last in the league in double plays turned, and after flipping four on Thursday, now sit tied for eighth in the league in the category.

Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas continued his recent surge with a two-run home run on Wednesday. Since June 10 (15 games), Binelas is slashing .353/.400/.667 (1.067 OPS). He's added 11 runs, four doubles, four home runs and 16 RBI. Since June 10, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 6th AVG (.353), T-2nd HR (4), 1st RBI (16), 5th SLG (.667), 5th OPS (1.067) and T-6th TB (34).

Keep Flexing Felix

Felix Reyes continued his stellar 2025 season with three-more hits, a double and his team-leading eighth home run of the season on Friday night. Reyes now has five three-hit games on the season and ranks tied for fifth in the Phillies organization with his eight home runs this season. Over 17 June games, Reyes is slashing .324/.352/.632 (.984 OPS), along with 13 runs, five doubles, two triples, four home runs and nine RBI. Reyes' Eastern League ranks for June are: 7th AVG (.324), T-6th HR (4), 4th SLG (.632), 4th OPS (.984), T-5th 3B (2) and T-7th TB (43).

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 29, 2016: At Reading, Dylan Cozens and Rhys Hoskins both homered to stay tied for EL lead with 21 long balls in a 14-1 pasting of Erie. It is the 9th time that season that both homered in same game. Osmel Aguila and Harold Martinez add homers of their own, with Aguila's being his first.

Rolling into Richmond

Richmond finished the first half of the season with an Eastern League-worst 21-46 record. The Flying Squirrels took four-of-five games at Altoona last week in the Trey Wilson bowl to finish the half. Following this week, Richmond remains home and hosts Chesapeake for three games before hitting the road to continue the series with the Baysox. Richmond's roster features five of the Giants' top-30 prospects: Joe Whitman (6), Diego Velasquez (15), Aeverson Arteaga (16), Sabin Ceballos (23) and Jack Choate (27).

Squirrel on the Bump

Righty Manuel Mercedes makes the start today for Richmond. This season, Mercedes is 3-8, with a 7.62 ERA (48 ER, 56.2 IP) over 14 games and 13 starts. He has struck out just 30, and walked 32, over 56.2 IP (4.76 SO/9.0 IP). Mercedes suffered the loss Tuesday against Reading, allowing six runs on seven hits over 5.1 innings of work, with no walks and three strikeouts. Mercedes spent all of 2024 with Eugene (A+), going 4-9, with a 5.28 ERA over 26 appearances. He spent all of 2023 and '22 with San Jose (A) and began his pro career in 2021 with the ACL-Giants (ROK). The 22-year old signed with the Giants as an International Free Agent in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.

Cabrera spun another strong start, this one a quality outing on Tuesday at Richmond. He picked up his second win of the season and issued just one walk for the fifth time in his last six starts. Cabrera was tagged for a run in the third and sixth innings, but posted zeroes in 4/6 frames on the night. Cabrera was relieved by Jack Dallas in the bottom of the seventh inning.

2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft; optioned to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opened the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Tabbed as Reading's Opening Day starter Apr. 4 vs Portland (ND, 4.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO)
- Lone win of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)
- Season-high six innings on four occasions: Apr. 22 at Portland, May 8 at Binghamton, June 6 at Harrisburg and June 24 at Richmond
- May 8 at BNG: 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO; eight strikeouts was season-high
- Walked season (and career-high) five batters twice: May 1 vs HBG and May 20 at POR
