Great Lakes has won six straight games, snapping the Lugnuts' own five-game winning streak with a victory in last night's series opener.

**Off the Field:** Tonight is a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the ballpark!

**Starting Matchup:** Lansing starts right-hander **Christian Fernandez**, acquired via trade with Tampa Bay, who is coming off five strikeouts in five hitless innings at Dayton. Great Lakes counters with right-hander **Robbie Peto**, making his second start for the Loons and 18th overall appearance.

**Last Night:** Loons 2, Lugnuts 1. Third baseman **Luis Diaz** delivered a tie-breaking RBI single in the top of the eighth inning, lifting Great Lakes to victory despite collecting only three base hits as a team. In the loss, Lansing starter **Jorge Juan** struck out five batters in three hitless innings.

### LUG•NOTES

**Skipper for the Series:** Lugnuts manager **Phil Pohl** is away for this week; **Veronica Alvarez** steps in as interim Lugnuts manager through Sunday. Today, Alvarez becomes the first woman to manage the Lugnuts in team history. A standout at Villanova, Alvarez served as the starting catcher for Team USA Baseball Women's National Team, winning medals in 2008 (bronze), 2010 (bronze), 2012 (silver) and 2015 (gold). She joined the Team USA's coaching staff as assistant coach in 2018, rising to manager of the Women's National Team beginning in 2019, when she led Team USA to a 7-0 record and the gold medal at the Women's Baseball World Cup Qualifier in Mexico, earning her the honor of 2019 USA Baseball Rod Dedeaux Coach of the Year. Since 2019, she has worked as a coach in Spring Training for the Oakland Athletics.

#### A's Farm Report:

- In **Triple-A Las Vegas**, 2022 Lugnuts lefty **Hogan Harris** made his Triple-A debut last night with four scoreless innings, striking out seven while allowing two hits and four walks in a 12-1 win over Sacramento. Today, 2021 Lugnuts slugger **Jordan Diaz** was promoted to the Aviators!
- In **Double-A Midland**, 2022 Lugnuts catcher/first baseman **Tyler Soderstrom** mashed his second home run with the RockHounds, an opposite-field shot, but Midland lost to Amarillo, 10-7. 2021-2022 reliever **Charles Hall** allowed his first run, striking out three in three innings and now has a 0.40 ERA (one ER in 22.1 IP).
- In **Single-A Stockton**, former Bowling Green Hot Rods ace **Brent Honeywell, Jr.** began his rehab stint back toward the Majors with a scoreless inning, striking out two, though the Ports lost to Lake Elsinore, 18-2.
- And in the **Arizona Complex League**, 2021-2022 Lugnuts outfielder **Austin Beck** began his rehab stint back toward Double-A, going 1-for-2 with a double and a walk in a 10-4 loss to the Brewers.

**Updated Prospect List:** MLB Pipeline has updated its Top 30 A's Prospects, with **Max Muncy** moving to No. 7, **Denzel Clarke** jumping up to No. 11, **Joey Estes** remaining stable at No. 16, **Euribiel Angeles** now at No. 16, **Brayan Buelvas** now at No. 23 and **Cooper Bowman** remaining No. 29. **Jorge Juan** fell off the list entirely (though if yesterday's three hitless innings with five strikeouts serves as an indicator, only temporarily). The Athletics' top five 2022 draft picks, all likely future Lugnuts, were each ranked: first-round catcher **Daniel Susac** at No. 5, second-round outfielder **Henry Bolte** at No. 6, compensatory second-round outfielder **Clark Elliott** at No. 13, third-round outfielder **Colby Thomas** at No. 16 and fourth-round pitcher **Jacob Watters** at No. 27.

**Running Men:** CF **Denzel Clarke** swiped second base twice yesterday and RF **Brayan Buelvas** stole second base once himself, putting him in position to score the Lugnuts' only run on **Joshwan Wright's** RBI single. That 3-for-3 day on the bases gives the Lugnuts 22 steals in 26 attempts through 13 games in August. The increasingly aggressive Lugnuts had eight stolen bases in April, 14 in May, 18 in June and 31 in July.

- Phil briefly played for the independent Laredo Lemurs in 2015, managed by Pete Incaviglia, hitting .311/.407/.473 with three home runs in 23 games. Laredo finished 57-43 and won the American Association championship.
- Since Phil is a native of Cooperstown, the National Baseball Hall of Fame is following his career closely. His gameworn Lugnuts baseball cap from the season's first weekend was sent to the Hall of Fame, by request.

**Inside the Park and Out of This World:** On August 2-3, 2022, CF **Denzel Clarke** joined Fred Bello (Everett, July 2-3, 2010) as the only Minor Leaguers since 2005 to have inside-the-park home runs in back-to-back games. The feat has never occurred in the Major Leagues.

**Roster Crunch:** The Lugnuts have used 51 different players this year: 25 position players and 26 pitchers (plus two position players pitching), with 18 different starting pitchers.

**From Far and Wide:** The Lugnuts include players from 10 different countries: USA, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, Mexico, Panama and Venezuela in addition to Puerto Rico and 11 different states: Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Hawaii, Idaho, New York, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Washington.

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has five players acquired by the Athletics via trade: **Cooper Bowman** (New York Yankees, acquired 8/1/22); **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22); **Joey Estes** (Atlanta Braves, 3/14/22); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17).

**To the Show:** Nine former Nuts have debuted in MLB in 2022, 170 all-time: A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018), catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019) and pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018); M's reliever **Danny Young** (2016); and Red Sox pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) and Marlins pitcher **Jake Fishman** (2017).

**Life as a Lugnut:** Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo).

**Last Appearance: August 10th at Dayton.** In finest outing with the Lugnuts, a day before his 23rd birthday, relieved Jorge Juan beginning the 4th and pitched hitless baseball through the 8th... allowed only two base runners, issuing a walk in the 4th and in the 5th... struck out five Dragons... 55 pitches, 33 strikes... Osvaldo Berrios pitched the 9th and 10th innings also without allowing a hit, and the Lugnuts prevailed 6-2 in 10.

**The Early Word:** When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury... Fernandez is eligible for the Rule 5 Draft at season's end.

**Home Cooking:** Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include Marlins ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

**Path Through the Pros:** Debuted in 2016 in the Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in the Appy League with Princeton... missed all of 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

**2022 Dominance in the Rays' System:** Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... longest start: 5 2/3 IP at Myrtle Beach, July 1 (5 H, 2 R on 2 solo HR, 1 BB, 6 K)... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
