### INDY BITS

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 prospect Bubba Chandler tied his career high with 11 strikeouts, and Henry Davis laced a tiebreaking RBI single in the seventh inning to help the Indianapolis Indians emerge with a 3-2 win over the St. Paul Saints on Friday night at Victory Field. With the game scoreless in the bottom of the fifth inning, Billy McKinney broke through with a solo shot to right field. With Chandler out of the game, the Saints grabbed their brief lead with an RBI single off the bat of former Indian Diego A. Castillo and a sac fly courtesy of Junior Severino. After St. Paul tallied a pair of runs in the top of the seventh to take the lead, Indianapolis countered with a two-run half inning of its own after the stretch. Jake Lamb scored on a fielder's choice RBI after being walked earlier in the inning and the Indians took the lead for good on Davis' two-out knock to right field. Hunter Stratton stranded two men in scoring position in the ninth to seal Indy's ninth win in 10 games against St. Paul this season.

**CHANDLER'S CAREER HIGH:** The Pittsburgh Pirates No. 1 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, right-handed pitcher Bubba Chandler, stunned the St. Paul Saints with a career-high tying 11 strikeouts over 6.0 shutout innings. His first career-high 11-strikeout performance came on June 24 with Double-A Altoona vs. Akron. Chandler has now fanned 17 batters across 13.0 scoreless innings since making his Triple-A debut on Aug. 9. In his first start, he took a no-hitter into the sixth inning and earned the win after allowing just two base knocks with one walk and six strikeouts to be named the International League Pitcher of the Week by Minor League Baseball on Monday. Currently rated by MLB Pipeline as the No. 48 prospect in MiLB, Chandler has the lowest WHIP (0.68) and second-lowest batting average against (.150) among all full-season qualifiers in professional baseball since June 21.

**BILLY CIRCLES THE BASES:** Billy McKinney launched his fifth home run of the season to put the Indians on the board last night and extend his on-base streak to 15 games since May 9. It was his second homer of the series vs. St. Paul after launching one on Tuesday and third in eight August games. Since his on-base streak began, he is hitting .396 (19-for-48) with 11 runs, three homers, six RBI and eight walks. He has hit safely in 13 of those 15 games and nine of his last 10 with a .400 batting average (12-for-30).

**NICK KNACKS:** Nick Yorke went 1-for-4 last night to continue a hot streak with the Indians. He has reached base safely in 22 of his last 23 games since June 19 and has hit safely in 18 of his last 19. Since beginning a 15-game hitting streak on July 25, he is hitting .362 (25-for-69) with eight doubles and 11 RBI. Since the beginning of June, York ranks among International League leaders in batting average (3rd, .330), hits (T-3rd, 66), on-base percentage (6th, .413), runs (T-6th, 39). He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester and is hitting .382 (21-for-55) with six doubles, nine RBI, a .491 slugging percentage and .917 OPS.

**WINNING IN HD:** Henry Davis was at the center of the Indians offense last night, going 2-for-4 with an RBI for his third consecutive multi-hit game. He has reached base safely in 21 of 23 games since July 13 with a .333 batting average (31-for-93), 18 runs, 10 extra-base hits, 19 RBI and a .940 OPS. Davis recorded six multi-hit games in a nine-game span from July 20-31 to begin that stretch, and has four multi-hit performances in 12 August games. In 50 total games with Indianapolis this season, he is hitting .313 (60-for-192) with 40 runs, 26 extra-base hits, 38 RBI and a .981 OPS.

**LET HIM COOK:** Billy Cook, who was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30, went 2-for-4 last night and has now hit safely in all four games vs. St. Paul this series after launching a grand slam on Tuesday. Since making his organization debut with the Indians on Aug. 3, Cook ranks among International League leaders in stolen bases (T-2nd, 5), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 7), total bases (T-5th, 25), OPS (8th, 1.076) and slugging percentage (10th, .641). Cook has now reached base safely in 14 of 16 games since July 26 (1) with Triple-A Norfolk with a .452 batting average (23-for-53), 11 runs, eight doubles, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBI between both teams.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians will look to build on four consecutive comeback victories to open the series tonight in the fourth contest of the six-game series vs. the St. Paul Saints, Triple-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. The Saints visited Victory Field from April 16-21, with the Indians taking five of six games. The two teams have one more series scheduled in the 2024 season, with Indianapolis heading to the Twin Cities for the final six games of the campaign from Sept. 17-22. Continuing the series today is RHP Thomas Harrington (0-1, 6.10), who is making his third Triple-A start and second at Victory Field. Countering for the Saints is RHP Randy Dobnak (9-5, 3.61). Dobnak has faced Indianapolis nine times (six starts) in his career, going 1-4 with a (27er/31.0ip) and 24 strikeouts.

**BORUCKI'S BACK:** The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that left-handed relief pitcher Ryan Borucki will begin a rehab assignment tonight at Victory Field. The 30-year-old was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 7 (retroactive to April 6) and later transferred to the 60-day IL with left triceps inflammation. He began a rehab assignment on June 25 and appeared in seven total games across two stints with Indianapolis, going 1-1 with a 7.11 ERA (5er/6.1ip) and 13 strikeouts. He also made three appearances with Double-A Altoona and posted a 5.40 ERA (2er/3.1ip). In four big-league outings to begin the season, he registered a 5.40 ERA (2er/3.1ip) and six strikeouts.

**THIS DATE IN 1988:** Pinch hitter Razor Shines ripped a two-out single to drive in Johnny Paredes and finish off an 8-7 comeback win for Indianapolis. The Indians were in control when a three-run third inning broke the game's 2-2 tie, but Iowa responded with five runs in the sixth to go ahead, 7-5. The Indians countered in the seventh with two runs of their own to tie the game. The win extended Indy's Eastern Division lead to 9.5 games.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Thomas Harrington:** Right-hander Thomas Harrington is set to make his second home start of the year against St Paul. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after going 2-2 with a 2.24 ERA (17er/68.1ip) with the Curve.

**Last Outing:** Harrington logged 4.2 innings with five strikeouts in his first Triple-A road start vs. Nashville on August 10.

**Against the Saints:** Harrington has never faced St. Paul.

**Punch 'Em Out, Tommy:** Harrington fanned double-digit batters in back-to-back starts with the Curve on July 10 vs. Bowie and July 20 at Somerset. The prior featured 11 strikeouts across 7.0 one-run innings, tying his career-high in both innings and punchouts.

**SAL Player of the Week:** Chandler was named the South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on June 11, 2023, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, no walks and eight strikeouts. After giving up back-to-back fourth-inningingles, he retired his final 11 batters consecutively.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of Campbell (Buies Creek, N.C.) University.
