RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (3-4, 39-34)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their first home stand of the second half, as they host the Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks) tonight in game five of a six-game set. After the game tonight, fans will enjoy a Fireworks Spectacular, thanks to Tam's Burgers! The Quakes are home through Sunday, capping the series with our Independence Day Fireworks Celebration at 6:30pm on Sunday night, courtesy of the Ontario International Airport.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 20th of 30 head-to-head meetings with Visalia this year and the 17th of 18 here at LoanMart Field. Rancho has dominated the season-series, going 12-7 against the Rawhide, including 11-5 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes played a solid all-around game, defeating the Visalia Rawhide by a final of 7-2 on Friday night at LoanMart Field. Benony Robles was strong over 4.2 innings in the start, with Carlos De Los Santos (3-0) earning the victory in relief. Luis Diaz had a huge night with three hits, two RBIs and a career-high four stolen bases. Griffin Lockwood-Powell slugged his third home run as a Quake off Visalia starter Yilber Diaz (1-2), who took the loss for the Rawhide.

LUIS ON THE LOOSE: Luis Diaz was on stage last night, as he went 3-for-3 with a walk, two RBIs and a career-best four stolen bases. Diaz leads the team in steals with 24 and had only stolen two bags in a single game on two other occasions this year. He'd been fairly consistent with his monthly totals this year, grabbing seven bases in both April and May before stealing six in June. However, he's one day into July, already with four stolen bases for the month.

STILL ALIVE FOR A SERIES WIN: Last night's win for Rancho gives the Quakes two wins in four games against the Rawhide this week, keeping them alive for a series win if they are able to take both Saturday and Sunday's games. They have won each of their other two home series against the Rawhide. The Quakes dropped four of six in the series to Lake Elsinore, marking just the second six-game series loss of the year and the first within the division. Rancho's series losses this year include losing five of six at Fresno and two of three to Visalia in the opening three-game set of the year. Overall, the Quakes are 4-3-5 (W-L-T) over their first 12 series in 2022.

DAMON KEITH LOVIN' THE RAWHIDE: Quakes' outfielder Damon Keith finished last night's game 0-for-2, but still contributed to the win, as he walked twice and drove in the game's first run with an RBI groundout. The former Cal Baptist University product has enjoyed head-to-head action against Visalia, as he's batting .400 (26-for-65) over 18 games, with three homers and 16 of his team-high 50 RBIs.

GAUTHIER GETTIN' ON BASE: Quakes' outfielder Austin Gauthier leads the league in on-base percentage at .454. Gauthier has walked in an incredible 11 straight games and is now atop the league with 65 walks overall.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a total of four moves on Thursday, activating both outfielder Jake Vogel and Thursday's starting pitcher Maddux Bruns. To make room for both players, the Quakes have placed both RHP Joan Valdez and catcher Nelson Quiroz on the Injured List.

SUCCESSFUL RETURN FOR MADDUX BRUNS: Former first-round left-hander Maddux Bruns made his first start in more than a month on Thursday night, as he was activated from the Injured List before Thursday's game. Bruns retired six of the seven batters he faced, walking just one, while recording three strikeouts in the no-decision.

JERMING ROSARIO: Right-hander Jerming Rosario will make his 15th appearance and 13th start tonight, his fourth appearance and third start against the Rawhide. In three previous appearances, he's 1-0 with an ERA of 3.86, allowing four runs on ten hits over 9.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed seven runs on six hits with three walks over just 2.2 innings in a loss at Lake Elsinore on June 26. Rosario was signed by the Dodgers out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

YAIFER PERDOMO: Left-hander Yaifer Perdomo will make his 12th start tonight for the Rawhide, his fourth against the Quakes. In his three prior starts versus Rancho, he's 0-2 with a 20.65 ERA, allowing 13 runs on 12 hits with eight walks in just 5.2 innings. In his last outing overall, he scattered one hit over five scoreless innings with nine punch-outs in a win at Inland Empire on June 25. Perdomo was traded from Toronto to Arizona in September of 2021.
