TOUGH ONE-RUN LOSS

Oklahoma City hung on for a 2-1 win over Round Rock on Saturday. Round Rock starter RHP James Marvel (0-1, 4.00) went home with the loss after allowing the two runs to score during his 6.0-inning start. Marvel's outing saw five hits, one walk and two strikeouts. Oklahoma City starter RHP Robbie Erlin (2-1, 7.71) claimed the win with 5.0 innings of one-run ball. Dodgers RHP Nick Robertson earned a save after a shutout ninth. The Dodgers took a 2-0 lead in the second inning. C Hunter Feduccia and 1B Ryan Ward hit back-to-back singles to put runners on the corners. Feduccia scored on a Yonny Hernández groundout before Ward came home as DH Steven Dugger singled. Express RF Sandro Fabian made it a 2-1 game in the fifth with a solo home run onto the left field berm. The teams combined to put 12 runners on base during the final four innings, but neither could add to their total.

ANDERSON A STARTER

Express RHP Grant Anderson will make his first professional start on Sunday afternoon. Anderson has appeared in six games out of the Round Rock bullpen this year with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP). On Thursday he tossed 2.2 innings of scoreless baseball with one walk and three strikeouts.

A SIX-GAME SWEEP?

Round Rock is in danger of being swept in six games for the first time in franchise history on Sunday. The Express entered this six-game series with the Dodgers trailing by only a half-game in the PCL Standings. They have lost all five games of the series thus far and have been outscored 27-11. Round Rock's six-game losing streak is their longest of the season and they are now 3-8 this month after going 18-8 to start the season which tied their best 26-game start in club history.

SLUGGISH OFFENSE

Round Rock was held scoreless for 18.0 straight innings spanning three games before RF Sandro Fabian's solo home run during Saturday's fifth inning. They have scored just one run in the last 23.0 innings. The most recent Express run had come during the fourth inning on Thursday, May 11.

A FIRST FOR FOSCUE

Express 1B Justin Foscue made his first career start at first base on Saturday after never having played the position either in college or professionally. Foscue went 1-for-3 and recorded 10 putouts along with three assists. Foscue has made 155 career starts at second base and 20 at third base. The infielder was also part of two double plays, including a 1-3 lineout double play to help Round Rock get out of a critical jam.

BULLPEN COMES THROUGH

Relievers LHP Taylor Hearn and LHP Lucas Jacobsen finished the night with scoreless outings out of the Round Rock bullpen. Hearn tossed 1.2 innings and one strikeout while Jacobsen threw 1.1 innings. The scoreless outings come after the E-Train bullpen held a 6.65 ERA (32 ER/43.1 IP) entering last night's game.

HOME RUN ONE FOR FABIAN

Express OF Sandro Fabian blasted his first home run of the season on Saturday night. The righty has collected 10 or more home runs in each of the last two seasons and last year hit four home runs in 32 games for the E-Train. Yesterday was his 65th career bomb.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
