ON THE BUMP: RHP Deivi Garcia will make his second appearance of the year and his first start after working an inning of relief for the Sounds on Opening Night. He signed with the Brewers as a free agent on November 18, 2024 after spending all of last year with the White Sox organization. He made the first Major League Opening Day roster of his career last year and made 14 relief appearances before spending the remainder of the year with Triple-A Charlotte.

DOUBLE DURBIN: Brewers no. 22-ranked prospect Caleb Durbin picked up his second double of the season on Tuesday against Gwinnett. His two doubles have him in a tie for the fifth-most in the International League in the early part of the season. His 10 total bases are tied for the sixth-most in the league after the Sounds wrapped up an early game in Gwinnett.

BOOTS WERE MADE FOR WALKIN': After drawing two more walks to start the series in Gwinnett, Anthony Seigler has drawn multiple walks in consecutive games for the Sounds and his four walks are one off the International League lead currently held by Rochester's Juan Ypez and Gwinnett's Eddy Alvarez. Seigler came around to score the Sounds only run on Tuesday after drawing one of his two walks and then stealing his first base of the year to get into scoring position.

WES IS MORE: Wes Clarke ended his two-game hitless streak to begin the season with a multi-hit performance on Tuesday. After going 0-for-8 in his two games played against Jacksonville over Opening Weekend, Clarke started his year 0-for-9 with a strikeout in his first plate appearance on Tuesday. He then proceeded to single in his next two plate appearances. Clarke ranked second in the Brewers farm system last year with 21 home runs and put together consecutive 20+ home run seasons in 2023-2024. He entered this year with 15 more home runs than anybody in the Brewers farm system over the past two seasons.

RISP REWARD: Nashville finished the game 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position as the team still struggles to capitalize on prime scoring opportunities. Through their first four games of the season, Nashville is hitting just .091 (3-for-33) and have left 47 runners on base when hitting with runners in scoring position. Only Scranton/WB (75) and Rochester (49) have more in the situation. In total, the Sounds have left 28 on base through their first four games, T-12th in Triple-A and T-6th in the International League.

OFF THE SLIDE: The Sounds had four 3+ game losing streaks in all of 2024 including a season-worst five game slide from June 13-18 at Gwinnett and vs. Durham. The team also lost four straight to start a series in Norfolk from April 30-May 3. The 1-3 start to the season is the worst for Nashville since also starting 1-3 to begin the 2019 season.

GIVE 'EM THE BIZ, MIZ: Jacob Misiorowski dominated his season debut on Sunday afternoon. The Brewers top-ranked pitching prospect gave the Sounds five scoreless innings in which he allowed just one hit and punched out seven Jumbo Shrimp. **For his efforts, Misiorowski was named International League Pitcher of the Week(end by Minor League Baseball yesterday.** It is the first International League Pitcher of the Week award for his career after making 14 appearances (2 GS) for the Sounds after a late-season promotion in 2024. He did however win Southern League Pitcher of the Week three times last year and was one of three pitchers in the minors to earn 3+ weekly honors (Yilber Diaz [ARI] and Quinn Priester [STL]).

EXTRA, EXTRA: Nashville played their first extra inning game of the year after having played 17 in 2024. The Sounds went 9-8 in extra-inning games last year and were 3-4 at home.

OPRAH WINFREY OF STRIKEOUTS: Nashville's pitching staff has been handing out strikeouts left and right to begin the season. With their 16 strikeouts on Sunday afternoon, Sounds' pitchers racked up 41 strikeouts during the three-game series. The club posted back-to-back 14+ strikeout performances on the mound for the seventh time since 2016. The most recent was May 4-5, 2023, against St. Paul when the club also went 14-16 in the strikeout total in those two games. From August 6-14, 2022, Nashville pitchers strung together eight straight games with 10+ strikeouts. Nashville's 46 strikeouts are the third-most in Triple-A through the first four games of the year. Charlotte leads the way with 51 and Gwinnett jumped to second with 16 strikeouts against the Sounds in the first game of the series on Tuesday.

- Originally signed by the New York Yankees as an International Free Agent on July 2, 2015... Entered the 2019 season as the no. 1-rated prospect in the Yankees farm system.
- Made his Major League debut in 2020 with the Yankees (6.0 IP, 4 H, 6 K, 0 BB) and retired his first nine batters... Became the 10th Yankee in franchise history to pitch at least 6.0 IP and not allow an earned run in his Major League debut... Was the youngest player (21 years, 103 days) to start a game for the Yankees since Phil Hughes in 2007... Recorded 6+ strikeouts in five of his first six big league starts.
- Claimed off waivers by the Chicago White Sox on August 10, 2023... Made 20 appearances for the White Sox during his time there and made the first MLB Opening Day Roster of his career with them in 2024.
- Earned his second career MLB save on April 17, 2024 against the Royals.
- Appeared in 40 games (5 GS) for Triple-A Charlotte in 2024 and went 3-6 with a 6.18 ERA in 51.0 IP... Had an 18-game stretch from April 10-June 7 where he did not allow more than two earned runs in 16 of his outings.
