YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 2-1. **Diego Rincones** opened the scoring in the first inning with an RBI double. **Jacob Heyward** opened the lead to 2-0 with an RBI double in the fourth. Reading scored its only run in the fifth inning with a solo homer by Jack Conley. Richmond starter **Matt Frisbee**, making his first Double-A start since May, allowed one run over six innings to pick up his fifth win. The Flying Squirrels worked a series split with the Fightin Phils with the win in the series finale at The Diamond.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels are 7-7 in series openers this season, including a 4-2 mark on the road. The Baysox are the only team the Flying Squirrels play more than two series against in 2021. This is the last of four sets between the two teams this year. In the Flying Squirrels' last trip to Bowie from July 6-11, they went 4-2. The Baysox went 4-2 at The Diamond from May 18-23 and 5-1 in Richmond from July 27-August 1.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have lost 13 of the last 17 games after winning 12 of the previous 16 to close within one game of first place in the division. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 9.5 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .232 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked third in the league with a 3.82 ERA for the season.

THE BAYSOX have won seven of the last ten games. They split last week's road series against the Somerset Patriots. The Baysox are currently second in the division and sit 1.5 games out of the second postseason spot for the league. The Bowie offense is ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with a .238 batting average. Bowie's pitching staff is ranked fourth with a 4.13 ERA. Bowie's roster features XX of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Adley Rutschman (1), RHP Grayson Rodriguez (2), LHP D.L. Hall (3 - on IL), OF Yusniel Diaz (8), 2B Terrin Vavra (10 - on IL), OF Kyle Stowers (22), LHP Drew Rom (25) and SS Joseph Ortiz (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Trenton Toplikar** makes his 13th start of the season and his 17th overall appearance. Last time out, he tied a career high with 7.0 innings pitched and allowed three runs in a loss against Reading last Wednesday. In his last two starts, Toplikar has combined for a 3.55 ERA (5 ER/12.2 IP). He has faced the Baysox three times this season. On May 20 in relief, he allowed one run over 4.0 innings. He started at Prince George's Stadium on July 6 and allowed four runs over 2.0 innings in a loss. He most recently pitched against the Baysox on July 29 at The Diamond and allowed four runs (two earned) over 4.2 innings. For the year, he is 0-1 with a 5.40 ERA against Bowie. Toplikar was drafted in the 16th round by the Giants in 2018 out of UC Riverside. In 2019, Toplikar began the season with High-A San Jose and made eight starts and seven relief appearances, going 3-1 with a 3.98 ERA. He was sent to Low-A Augusta on June 12 of that season and worked as a starter the rest of the year, going 5-2 with a 3.62 ERA in ten starts. **For more on Toplikar, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Kyle Brnovich makes his seventh Double-A start. Last time out, he allowed three runs over 4.0 innings in a loss at Somerset last Wednesday. He has faced the Flying Squirrels twice this year. On July 7 in his home debut for the Baysox, Brnovich held Richmond to two runs over 5.0 innings in a no-decision. He pitched at The Diamond on July 29 and allowed two runs in 4.0 innings in a no-decision. Brnovich is 0-0 with a 4.00 ERA (4 ER/9.0 IP) when facing the Flying Squirrels this season. He was drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the eighth round in 2019 out of Elon. On December 4, 2019, he was traded along with three other right-handed pitchers to the Orioles for right-handed pitcher Dylan Bundy. He made his professional debut this year on May 6 for Aberdeen at Wilmington, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings and allowing one hit with no walks and six strikeouts. With the IronBirds, he went 4-1 with a 2.36 ERA in eight starts. He was promoted to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Over his last four starts since July 16, Brnovich is 0-1 with a 2.50 ERA (5 ER/18.0 IP) with 22 strikeouts and four walks.

STARTING STRONG: Over the last 11 games since July 28, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to post a 1.87 ERA (12 ER/57.2 IP). In the last series against Reading, Flying Squirrels starters posted a 1.06 ERA (4 ER/34.0 IP) across six games. **Sean Hjelle** pitched 7.0 innings scoreless innings last Tuesday. **Trenton Toplikar** worked 7.0 innings last Wednesday and allowed three earned runs. **Aaron Blair** did not surrender an earned run over 3.0 innings in his start last Thursday. **Michael Plassmeyer** worked 5.0 scoreless innings last Friday night. **Akeel Morris** pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in a combined shutout last Saturday. **Matt Frisbee** allowed one run over 6.0 innings on Sunday in the finale. Richmond starters have not surrendered an earned run in four of the last six games.

TAKE A WALK: In 2019, **Jacob Heyward** set the single-season franchise record with 80 walks, surpassing the previous mark held by **Mark Miniccozzi**, who walked 62 times in 2013. Heyward has walked 26 times this season. For his career with the Flying Squirrels, Heyward has worked 106 walks, which sits him in second in the team's history in career walks. The franchise career walks record is held by **Ricky Oropesa**, who walked 113 times in his four seasons with Richmond from 2013-2016.

POWER SURGE: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank ninth in the circuit with 83 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 119 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 109 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .380 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the second-highest in the franchise's history (Behind a .382 mark from 2013). Richmond's 83 home runs this season is a higher total than the entire 2012 (76), 2014 (74), 2010 (71) and 2015 (61) seasons.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Over his last 17 games since July 17, **Diego Rincones** is batting .281 (16-for-57) with four homers, four doubles, one triple and 15 RBIs. He homered in three consecutive games from July 17-20 and added a fourth on July 29 against Bowie. Over his last six games since August 3, Rincones is batting .318 (7-for-22) with three doubles and four RBIs. He knocked go-ahead hits in the Richmond wins on Saturday and Sunday.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 28 games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .284 (27-for-95) with six home runs, five doubles and 20 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 13 homers this season and second with 36 RBIs. He is hitless in his last 18 at-bats over six games since July 31, going 0-for-18 with 11 strikeouts, no walks and one sacrifice fly.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** is batting .325 (25-for-77) over his last 21 games since July 15 with six doubles, one triple, one homer and six RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 14 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fifth in the Double-A Northeast. For the year, Whiteman has picked up a total of 31 steals in 34 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season. Whiteman saw his six-game hit streak end with an 0-for-3 outing on Sunday night.

TORRES ON A TEAR: **Bryan Torres** is currently riding a 13-game hitting streak dating back to July 3, which is the longest hit streak for any player on the Flying Squirrels this season. During that span, Torres is batting .386 (19-for-49) with three doubles, a triple and seven RBIs. He has picked up two hits in five of his last eight games played. He is batting .306 this season in 34 games, which would be the highest average of his professional career. Torres is playing his first season at the Double-A level after previously topping out at the rookie level before 2021.

LEFT ON BASE: Over the last 16 games, the Flying Squirrels have hit .143 (19-for-133) with runners in scoring position and have left 137 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .131 (8-for-61) with the bases loaded, which is the second-lowest mark of the 120 full-season minor league teams this year.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked eighth with 49 RBIs. **Simon Whiteman** is tied for fifth with 14 stolen bases. **Joey Marciano** (29/T-4th), **Frank Rubio** (28/T-6th), **Raffi Vizcaino** (28/T-6th), **Patrick Ruotolo** (28/T-6th) and **Matt Seelinger** (27/T-10th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. **RJ Dabovich** and **Ruotolo** are tied for sixth in the league with six saves.

FREE FALLING: The Flying Squirrels have lost 13 of the last 17 games since July 21. On August 1, their record dropped .500 for the first time since May 5 (1-1). On August 5, the record fell below .500 for the first time since May 4 (0-1). Prior to this stretch, the Flying Squirrels were tied for second place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Akron. The team has fallen back to fifth and is now 9.5 games back.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13 - on IL) and **Sean Hjelle** (14). **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baseline" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Three players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
