LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox clinched their first six-game series win of the season with a 3-1 triumph over the Akron RubberDucks on Saturday night. Bowie struck first in peculiar fashion, as Billy Cook tripled to deep center field in the fourth inning, before being plated on a balk by Akron starter Tanner Burns. It was the only damage done in the first five frames for the Baysox against Burns. However, Bowie would chase the Akron right-hander in the sixth inning, as TT Bowers clobbered his third Double-A home run in just his tenth game at the level - a two-run shot that extended the Baysox lead to 3-0. More strong pitching paved the way for Bowie, as Justin Armbruster fired five shutout frames, allowing just three hits and walking two, while striking out six. Armbruster picked up the win, improving his record to 3-1 while lowering his ERA to 1.40. Left-hander Easton Lucas notched a scoreless 2.2 innings around a pair of hits, before handing the ball off to right-hander Nolan Hoffman, who retired each of the two hitters he faced. Wandisson Charles did allow an RBI double to Joe Naranjo in the ninth inning to get the RubberDucks on the board, but would find the last two outs for his third save of the season in the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Akron RubberDucks enter tonight with a record of 20-23. Akron sits fifth in the Eastern League Southwest division - three-and-a-half games out of first place. The RubberDucks split their six-game series in Richmond last week and took four of six from the Baysox in Bowie last month. Both sides enter the series struggling defensively. Akron's 44 errors on the season are the second-most in Double-A. Only the Baysox (46) have more. Akron's roster is highlighted by six of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Positioned prospects include INF Angel Martinez (No. 9), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15) and INF Jose Tena (No. 21). On the mound, the RubberDucks' staff is led by right-handers Tanner Burns (No. 20) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30), along with southpaw Doug Nixhazy (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jack Leftwich is projected to get his second start of the series tonight. Leftwich pitched on Tuesday, taking the loss after allowing four earned runs on six hits across 4.2 innings, but did strike out a season-high six batters. Leftwich has allowed 12 earned runs on 14 hits across his past two starts (8.1 innings). The No. 30 Guardians' prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has an 11.77 ERA with a .316 BAA and five home runs allowed in the month of May, after a 4.32 ERA with a .200 BAA and zero home runs allowed in April. Leftwich made his Double-A debut on 4/12 in Bowie against the Baysox, as he took a no-decision in the start after allowing two earned runs on four hits across three innings with a single strikeout. Originally a seventh-round selection for the Guardians out of the University of Florida in 2021, Leftwich features a mid-90s fastball, a low-80s slider with depth, and a low-80s changeup with fade.

HOME RUN HEADACHES

While Akron entered this series with 29 home runs on the season, the second-fewest in the League, and third-fewest in Double-A, Baysox pitching has allowed five home runs in five games across this week's series. The Eastern League has had a wide variation between home run friendly teams, as three teams (ALT, NH, SOM) are among the four best teams in Double-A at limiting home runs, while four teams (REA, HFD, BNG, BOW) are among the top seven teams for home runs allowed in Double-A.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto has been heralded as the contact king of the Eastern League. Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 58 hits and a .363 average - 42 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hits in 19 of his 21 games this month and holds a .369 average and a .971 OPS in May. Prieto's 58 hits are tied for the most in the Orioles' system, while his average is second in the Baltimore farm.

LEAVING CRATERS IN CANAL PARK

Bowie has enjoyed some unexpected success via the long ball this week. In the first five games of the series, the Baysox have clobbered seven home runs. By comparison, the RubberDucks had allowed six long balls in their first 15 home games - the lowest total in the Eastern League. Strangely enough, Bowie had launched just 10 home runs on the road this season entering this week - the second-lowest total in the league and the third-lowest total in Double-A. The home run has accounted for over 52% of Baysox run production in this series, after accounting for 23% of run production in the first 14 road contests of 2023.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

This has been Bowie's most successful trip to Akron in years. The Baysox had not won a series at Canal Park since taking three-of-four from 7/11-7/14/2019. The Baysox sport a 2.91 staff ERA in road contests this season. That is the best mark at the Double-A level and the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. In particular, the staff has pitched to a 1.84 ERA in the five games at Canal Park against Akron this week. Starting pitching has paved the way for Bowie. Baysox starters have only allowed 4 ER across 25.2 innings (1.40 ERA) in the series, with four of five starts blanking the RubberDucks through the first five frames.

CAREER NOTES

- Went 2-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 6 appearances (5 starts) for the Baysox last season.
- Had a sensational start to his time in the Orioles' system, winning the organization's Pitcher of the Month honors after 4-0 with a 2.57 ERA with 34 strikeouts to just 7 walks across 28 innings, between Aberdeen and Bowie
- Struggled in September, as he allowed 10 ER in 7.1 IP in the month, including allowing 4 in 1.2 innings against Akron in the season's final game on 9/18, in what would be a loss to eliminate the Baysox from postseason contention.
- Had a 4.08 ERA in 20 appearances (19 starts) for the Twins' organization across two seasons.
- Spent parts of two seasons with the Nebraska Cornhuskers, only full season was 2021, where he finished 6-1 with a 3.11 ERA in 81 innings.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/8 Allowed two early baserunners in the first with none out, but stranded both. Got two quick ground outs in the second inning, but allowed the next four batters to reach, including three hits, needing 28 pitches in the inning. Faced the minimum in the third.
- 4/15 Struck out five of the first eight batters faced. Allowed two baserunners in the third, only inning to allow multiple runners.
- 4/21 Allowed three runs in the first inning on two walks and two hits, needing 32 pitches for the frame. Two more runs in the third inning on a single, triple, and passed ball.
- 4/29 Front end of a doubleheader, struck out seven batters in his first trip through the order. Only hit allowed was a two-out double in the third. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/5 Struck out three batters over first two innings, but allowed two runs in the third including a solo home run. Struck out four more batters, but back-to-back two-out base hits in the fifth forced his exit.
- 5/11 Struck out seven of first 11 batters faced. Faced one over the minimum through four innings, but allowed two singles to start the fifth inning before striking out the side. **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**
- 5/17 Allowed each of the first three batters to reach base, and all to score on two sacrifice flies and a double. Allowed two more runners to move into scoring position, but none to third base.
- 5/23 After Bowie had taken a 2-0 lead in the second, allowed a walk and game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the frame. Only allowed two baserunners over final three innings.
