# CONSISTENCY: The Renegades fall in the series opener to Wilmington ENEMY TURNED FRIEND: Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz turned in another on Tuesday. The two teams will face off 30 times in 2025, after seeing each other for 30 contests last year. Entering this series, the Renegades had won 14 straight games over the Blue Rocks. Hudson Valley swept the first six-game series of 2025 against the Blue Rocks in April. In 2024, the Renegades finished with a 20-10 record. Last August, Hudson Valley earned their first seven-game sweep in franchise history over the Blue Rocks. The SAL North foes will play 18 times in the first half, before 12 games in the final 66 games of 2025.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Lagrange struggled in the top of the first inning last Tuesday against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, allowing a two-run double to Paul McIntosh five batters into the game, but settled down after that to spin another strong start. He struck out eight and only walked one across 5.2 innings, and gave up only one hit after the first inning in picking up the win. Lagrange set down 14 of the final 15 batters he faced.

**LIMITED DUTIES:** Lagrange's 2024 season was hampered by lower back inflammation which limited him to only 21.0 innings during the regular season. Owing to that, the hard-throwing right-hander enters his fourth professional season in 2025 with fewer than 100.0 professional innings pitched.

**TOUCHING TRIPLE DIGITS:** Lagrange has always been a hard thrower, and in the 2025 Yankees Spring Breakout Game against Orioles prospects, Lagrange got the start for the Yankees squad, throwing four innings and allowing two runs (one earned), two hits, two strikeouts and no walks. One of the most eye-opening moments was his pitches being clocked at 100 mph.

**FALL STAR:** Following the 2024 season, Lagrange pitched for the Salt River Rafters of the prestigious Arizona Fall League to solid results. In five games (four starts), Lagrange posted a 2.08 ERA (2 ER/8.2 IP), and struck out 10 batters. However, he also issued 15 walks to 43 total batters faced, a shocking 34.8% walk rate.

**BREAKING BALL ADJUSTMENTS:** Like many pitchers in the Yankees system, Lagrange features two distinct sliders. He throws a sweeper (82-85), and a harder, shorter slider in the upper 80s. He previously threw a curveball, which he has mostly scrapped as a pitch, although reportedly he was throwing the curve some in the Arizona Fall Leaque.
