Syracuse Mets News and Notes

Game #89 of 150 – Home Game #41 of 75

Comeback Kids: Since June 2nd, Syracuse is 24-16, which is the second-best record in the International League since that point, one game behind Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. During that stretch the Mets have 13 come-from-behind wins and are second in the league with 226 total runs scored.

Turning It Around: Since May 24th, the Syracuse Mets are third in the International League with 262 runs scored in 48 games despite ranking 17th with a .246 batting average. From the beginning of the season to May 23rd, the Mets were last in the league with a .205 batting average and ranked second to last with 154 runs scored in 40 games.

Streaking: Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 40 of his last 45 games, including hits in 36 of 45. During his last 45 games since May 12th, Blankenhorn is hitting .344 with 30 RBIs, eight home runs, 13 doubles, 15 walks, and a .412 on-base percentage.

From the start of the season to May 11th, Blankenhorn hit .167 with 12 RBI, four homers, three doubles, four walks, 28 strikeouts, and a .216 on-base percentage.

Blankenhorn was named the International League's June Player of the Month by Minor League Baseball. In June, Blankenhorn hit .402 with 24 RBIs, five home runs, ten doubles, and a .486 on-base percentage in 25 games, ranking second in the league in batting average, on-base percentage, and RBIs in June while leading the league with a 1.160 on-base plus slugging percentage.

Do the Palka: Since reaching a season-low batting average of .205 on May 28th, Daniel Palka has reached base in 24 out of the last 27 games. During this stretch, the 30-year-old is hitting .333 with 22 RBIs, six home runs, seven doubles, 19 runs scored, ten walks and a .391 on-base percentage. Palka is tied for eighth in the International League with 16 home runs.

Heating Up: Since July 1st, Gosuke Katoh is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with ten RBIs, five home runs, three doubles, and a .420 on-base percentage. Katoh was named the International League Player of the Week for his performance last week in Buffalo where he hit .435 (10-for-23) with eight RBIs, four home runs, three doubles, and a .519 on-base percentage.

A Well-Deserved Rest: After wrapping up their series with Jacksonville on Sunday afternoon, the Syracuse Mets will have four days off as part of the All-Star Break across baseball. The Mets return to action with a three-game set at the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A affiliate, Boston Red Sox) next Friday through Sunday, then come home to NBT Bank Stadium for a six-game slate against the Omaha Storm Chasers (Triple-A affiliate, Kansas City Royals) from July 26-31. 60 games remain in the regular season once plays resumes next Friday.

Star In Syracuse: New York Mets starting pitcher Jacob deGrom made a Major League rehab start with the Syracuse Mets at NBT Bank Stadium on Thursday night. The two-time National League Cy Young Award winner was as advertised, allowing just two hits and one unearned run in four innings with one walk and four strikeouts. The hard-throwing righthander began the season on New York's injured list with a stress reaction on his right scapula. Thursday was deGrom's first rehab start with Syracuse and his third rehab start overall after making two appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, throwing 24 pitches in his first outing and 36 in his second appearance.

The Future Is Here: Francisco Álvarez and Mark Vientos are away from the Syracuse Mets this weekend, as they have both been selected to play in the Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday evening. Álvarez, currently the top-ranked prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline, joined Syracuse on July 4th after an electric start to the season with Double-A Binghamton. The 20-year-old smacked 16 doubles and 18 home runs in 67 games with the Rumble Ponies, including 10 home runs in the month of June alone.

Since May 2nd, **Mark Vientos** is hitting .289 with 38 RBIs, 15 home runs, five doubles, 20 walks and a .365 on-base percentage in 456games. Vientos is top ten in the International League with 16 home runs this season.

When he was released by Arizona in May 2020, a former manager reached out with an offer to pitch for an Independent League team: the Chicago Dogs. 
