For the second night in a row and fourth time in five games this season, eight different Northwest Arkansas Naturals batters recorded hits, as a team effort led to an 8-5 win over the Wichita Wind Surge Wednesday night at Arvest Ballpark.

- Seuly Matias started the scoring with a sacrifice fly in the first, then Maikel Garcia drew a bases loaded walk in the second, his second of three walks in the game, at the time to tie the score 2-2 ... the Naturals added two more runs in the fifth to take a lead again, on Michael Massey's second double of the night and a fielder's choice RBI from **Sebastian Rivero** ... NW Arkansas responded to two Wichita runs in the top of the seventh with four in the bottom half, as a Wind Surge error that broke the 4-4 tie, then Robbie Glendinning tripled in Matias and Rivero and Logan Porter doubled home Glendinning.
- Center fielder Nick Loftin put together his second consecutive multi-hit night, going 3-for-5 while scoring three runs, crossing the plate every time he reached base.
- Starting pitcher Alec Marsh compiled the best start of the year for a Naturals starting pitcher, striking out nine across 4.2 innings, the first to pitch into the fifth inning this year... Christian Cosby earned the win with 2.1 innings of relief while striking out three and **Zach Willeman** closed the door, striking out three as well. Combined, the staff struck out 15, the most since the staff struck out 16 on Aug. 11 against Frisco.

#### The Naturals are 3-7 all-time when playing on April 14

On April 14, 2012, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals edged out the Corpus Christi Hooks, 9-6 at Arvest Ballpark. Northwest Arkansas homered three times, the first coming from **Wil Myers**, a three-run shot in the first inning. Myers finished the day 4-for-5 with a pair of singles and a double, just a triple shy of the cycle while driving in five runs. Carlo Testa added a solo homer in the second and current Naturals assistant hitting coach Christian Colón hit a go-ahead solo home run in the sixth inning, making the score at the time 8-7.

## THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, seven players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Angel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was catcher Tyler Cropley and outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, development list player **Holden Capps** was on the Naturals' championship Series roster, while development list player Gavin **Stupienski** and pitcher **Alec Marsh** both played for the Naturals in 2021.

#### FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Angel Zerpa.

## STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP **Drew Parrish** starts today for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 38.
- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts tomorrow (April 15th) for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP Angel Zerpa starts Saturday, April 16th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him
- LHP **Asa Lacy** started the home opener on Tuesday and will go ahead on Sunday, April 17th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 left-handed pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.
- RHP **Alec Marsh** started yesterday, Wednesday, April 13th for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.

#### **TOOLSY TEAM**

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the

### WALK THIS WAY

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has drawn 10 walks through the season's first five games, which is not just the most in the Texas League and all of Double-A, but the most among ALL Minor League hitters as well.

- Garcia has drawn at least one walk in every game he's played, while walking twice or more four times. He collected his first three-walk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 27 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base times, for a cool .593 on-base percentage (6 hits + 10 walks) ... his OBP ranks fourth in the league and is the best among qualified Naturals hitters.

### SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

Last Saturday, right-handed pitcher Collin Snider made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: **Scott Barlow**, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.

## FALL LEAGUE PHENOMS

The Kansas City Royals sent nine players to the Arizona Fall League in 2021 to play for the Surprise Saguaros ... of those nine, seven are on the Naturals

- Zach Haake pitched in six games (five starts) and went 1-1 with a 6.61 ERA (12 ER in 16.1 IP) and 14 strikeouts ... Asa Lacy made four starts and went 2-0 with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP) and 15 strikeouts ... Alec Marsh made one start and went 1-0 with a 27.00 ERA (4 ER in 1.1 IP) and three strikeouts ... Stephen Woods Jr. pitched in 10 games (one start) and went 0-0 with a 4.67 ERA (9 ER in 17.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts.
- Nate Eaton played in 20 games, hitting .317 (26-for-82) with a .815 OPS and 13 runs batted in, he finished fourth on the team with 38 total bases ... Seuly Matias played in 22 games, hitting .188 (15-for-80) with a .712 OPS, six home runs and 20 runs batted in, both of which were tied for the team lead ... Jake Means played in 19 games, hitting .171 (12-for-70) with a .515 OPS and five runs batted in.
