**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn and Aberdeen had their game suspended after three and a half innings due to rain on Friday. With the IronBirds holding a 1-0 lead entering the bottom of the fourth, the umpires ushered players off the field before the half-inning started due to rain and lightning. After a 46-minute delay, the game was suspended. DH **Nick Morabito** began the game with a first-pitch triple but was stranded at third base. Aberdeen scored the game's only run in the second when LF **Reed Trimble** walked, stole second, advanced to third on a ground out, and scored on a two-out SS **Jalen Vasquez** single. LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** tossed 3.0 innings of one-hit, one-run ball for Brooklyn, striking out four. RHP **Levi Wells** and LHP **Deivy Cruz** each struck out two in scoreless innings to start for Aberdeen. RHP **Nestor German** followed with two perfect frames in his High-A debut for Aberdeen.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 3, 2003, the Cyclones honored **Jackie Robinson** and his No. 42 in a pre-game ceremony on Coney Island. **Rachel Robinson**, Jackie's widow, was on hand to celebrate the occasion. Appropriately, that night, **Stacy Bennett** became the first player in franchise history to steal home. In 2008, after trading runs in the ninth inning, Brooklyn scored two in the top of the 13th on a CF **Sean Ratliff** ground-rule double and a SS **Matt Smith** squeeze bunt in a 5-3 win at Staten Island. In 2012, RHP **Luis Cessa** (5.0 IP), RHP **Matt Bowman** (3.0), and LHP **John Mincone** (1.0) combined on a two-hit shutout in a 3-0 win vs. Connecticut. In 2016, RHPs **Harol González** (7.0 IP) and **Gary Cornish** (2.0) pitched for a four-hit shutout in a 3-0 win at Hudson Valley. In 2023, 1B **Ryan Clifford** blasted a two-run home run in the top of the first inning his first at-bat as a member of the Mets' organization. RHP **Jawilme Ramírez** pitched into the ninth inning in his High-A debut, as Brooklyn won 6-3 at Jersey Shore.

**A BREAK IN THE ACTION:** Friday's suspended game marked the first for the Cyclones since the 2022 season. Brooklyn had not played a game halted mid-contest since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 14, 2022, vs. Wilmington. That contest was delayed at the start due to rain and ultimately suspended before the beginning of the top of the third due to fog with Wilmington leading, 2-1. The Blue Rocks won the game the following day, May 15, 3-2, in nine innings.

**YOU SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY:** RHP **Luis G. Moreno** celebrates his 26th birthday on Saturday. The Santa Rosa, Colombia native was assigned to the Cyclones on July 12. After picking up the win on Thursday, Moreno is 2-1 with a 5.23 ERA (6 ER in 10.1 IP), six walks, and 10 strikeouts in five relief outings.

**CORN-IELLY ON THE COB:** RHP **Joshua Cornielly** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Saturday. Entering play on Saturday, the 23-year-old was tied with Wilmington's LHP **Matt Cronin** for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (8). In 25 appearances for Brooklyn in 2024, Cornielly held a 2-5 record with a 4.35 ERA (19 ER in 39.1 IP), 15 walks, and 50 strikeouts. Over two seasons with the Cyclones, the Caracas, Venezuela native posted a 4-8 mark with a 3.99 ERA (40 ER in 90.1 IP), nine saves, 32 walks, and 108 strikeouts. Cornielly is the 15th Cyclone to be promoted to Double-A Binghamton in 2024.

**EVERY ROSE HAS ITS THORN-TON:** LHP **Zach Thornton** joined Brooklyn's roster from Single-A St. Lucie on Thursday and is scheduled to make his High-A debut on Saturday. In 13 appearances (six starts) for the Mets, the 22-year-old tallied a 3-2 record with a 4.39 ERA (20 ER in 41.0 IP), one save, 47 hits allowed, 16 walks (8.74 BB%), and 32 strikeouts (17.49 K%). Thornton missed a month on the 7-day injured list from June 4 to July 14. The southpaw has thrived in a starting role. In the Florida State League, Thornton was 2-0 with a 3.42 ERA (9 ER in 23.2 IP), seven walks (6.67 BB%), and 20 strikeouts (19.05 K%) in six starts. In seven relief outings, he was 1-2 with a 5.71 ERA (11 ER in 17.1 IP), nine walks (11.54 BB%), and 12 strikeouts (15.38 K%). Thornton was selected by the New York Mets in the fifth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Grand Canyon University.

**HEATING UP:** Several Cyclones hitters are starting to catch fire at the plate as the calendar flips to August. INF **Mateo Gil** is 8-for-23 (.348) in his last six games with six runs scored, two doubles, two home runs, and three runs driven in. IF/OF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** has also started to turn things around after a tough month of July. The 21-year-old is 6-for-19 (.316) in his last six games with six runs scored, three doubles, a home run, and seven runs batted in. C **Christian Pregent** is also hitting .250/.385/.344 with a .729 OPS, four runs scored, a home run, and four runs batted in in his last 11 games since July 2.

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks. After earning the win in Game 2 on Wednesday, the 21-year-old is 3-2 with a 2.48 ERA (9 ER in 32.2 IP), allowing only 24 hits and 10 walks, while striking out 50 over his last seven starts since June 20. Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and is second among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (88). Tong is also fourth in batting average against (.219), fifth in ERA (3.36), sixth in WHIP (1.26), and tied for ninth in innings pitched (64.1). Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season. Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (1.97), second in strikeout rate (36.0%), fourth in strikeouts (124), and fifth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.7%).

**vs. ABERDEEN:** After a nine-game homestand, Brooklyn hits the road for its first six-game series since the All-Star break against the Orioles' High-A affiliate. The IronBirds have five of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** (4), LHP **Luis De León** (13), and RHP **Michael Forret** (23). RHP **Juan Núñez** (22) and C **Creed Willems** (27) are currently on the injured list. The Cyclones went 7-5 at home against Aberdeen this year, but dropped 5-of-6 in the previous meeting at Leidos Field (June 25-30). Aberdeen leads the season series, 10-8. In 260 meetings dating back to 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 136-124 (.523).

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season. The 21-year-old finished with his 29th multi-hit game of the year in Thursday's win and is currently riding a six-game hitting streak since July 26, going 10-for-25 (.400) with three runs batted in and five stolen bases. Morabito has also reached base safely in nine consecutive games since July 23, hitting .382/.462/.382 with a .844 OPS and eight swiped bags. The McLean, Va. native is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (46). He is just two steals (35) away from tying OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year. Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (77), is second in stolen bases (35), tied for sixth in runs scored (45), sixth in batting average (.288), and eighth in on-base percentage (.367). The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (35), sixth in batting average (.288), and eighth in on-base percentage (.367) for the season. The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.313), stolen bases (46), on-base percentage (.408), and hits (108). He is also tied for second in runs scored (59), third in total bases (134), fifth in OPS (.796), and tied for fifth in walks (48).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since. The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 16 games. Since July 6, he has been hitting .364/.435/.400 with a .835 OPS, eight runs scored, two doubles, and three runs batted in over the 16 games. Clark leads the South Atlantic League in on-base percentage (.435) since that date, in addition to sitting third in batting average (.364) and tied for eighth in hits (20).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton. The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on Sunday and has homered in five of his last 12 games since July 13 at Wilmington. Four of those five home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead. De Los Santos is hitting .250/.283/.705 with a .988 OPS in that span with eight extra-base hits. Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fifth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases. The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen. Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for the South Atlantic League (70) lead and is sixth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately. The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington. The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record. The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League. The Cyclones are also tied for sixth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts. Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season. The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park. The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the third time in the homestand, the second time in the series, and the fourth time this season, the Cyclones walked off winners on Sunday afternoon vs. Rome. Down by two runs with one out in the ninth, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph. The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024. SS **William Lugo** and OF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green. It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season. 3B **Nick Loruso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14. The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins during the homestand on Friday, July 19, on C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on Wednesday, July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome. Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 15.38% of all defeats, including 27.27% of all road losses, while earning 11 walk-off wins. 29 of Brooklyn's 230 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.61%). The Cyclones have also earned 22 wins in their last at-bat.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline. The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Weninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30). Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL. Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), Ziegler (21), OF **Nick Morabito** (23), and Weninger (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a no-decision in his first start since being reinstated off the injured list and final start with Single-A St. Lucie last Sunday vs. Palm Beach...Permitted one run on four hits over 2.1 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out three...Tossed a wild pitch...Threw 41 pitches and 30 strikes (73.17%)...Relieved by LHP **Brayhans Barreto** with the bases empty and one out in the top of the third inning and the game tied at one...The Cardinals scored three runs after Thornton departed in the third and went on to defeat the Mets, 5-1.

**THE COMEBACK REPORT:** Thornton spent a little over a month on Single-A St. Lucie's 7-day injured list...The 22-year-old was placed on the IL on June 4 and was reinstated on July 14...In three appearances (one start) since returning, Thornton is 1-0 with an 8.31 ERA (4 ER in 4.1 IP), one walk, and six strikeouts.

**WHAT'S IN A ROLE:** The Lawrence, Kan. native has seen varied results between his appearances as a starter and a reliever in 2024...In six starts, Thornton holds a 2-0 record with a 3.42 ERA (9 ER in 23.2 IP), seven walks, and 20 strikeouts...Over seven outings in relief, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 5.71 ERA (11 ER in 17.1 IP), one save, nine walks, and 12 strikeouts.

**DOMINANT IN THE DESERT:** Thornton enjoyed plenty of success during his lone season in the desert at Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Ariz...The fifth-round selection earned All-WAC Second Team honors in 2023 after accumulating a 9-2 record with a 3.87 ERA (38 ER in 88.1 IP), 18 walks, and 91 strikeouts in 15 starts for the Antelopes...Thornton finished the 2023 season at GCU as the team's leader in ERA (3.87), wins (9), innings pitched (88.1), and strikeouts (91)...The left-hander started his collegiate career with two years (2021-22) at Barton Community College (Great Bend, Kan.).

**FAMILY BUSINESS:** Zach is far from the only athlete in the Thornton family...His father, **Paul**, ran track at St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.) from 1989-93 and was a conference champion in the 1000m in 1993...However, the best athlete in the family may be his mother, **Julie**...From 1988-92, she participated in track and field, cross country, and soccer at Lewis & Clark College (Portland, Ore.) and St. Olaf College...Julie was a two-time All-American in the heptathlon (1991-92) and was later inducted in to the St. Olaf College athletics Hall of Fame.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor into the decision pitching in relief last Saturday night vs. Rome...Entered in support of LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** (4.1 IP), RHP **Luis G. Moreno** (1.2), and RHP **Joshua Cornielli** (2.0) to start top of the ninth inning and Brooklyn trailing 5-1...Did not allow a run or a hit in an inning of work...Walked two and did not register a strike out...Induced a double play...Threw 18 pitches and eight strikes (44.44%)...The Cyclones stranded a pair of baserunners in the bottom of the ninth in a 5-1 loss to the Emperors.

**IT'S BEEN A WHILE:** Loper is probable to make the first start since at least high school during the seven-inning nightcap of today's twinbill...The 24-year-old has not started in the first 46 appearances of his professional career...Loper never made a start in his collegiate or collegiate summer ball career either...All 57 of his outings at Duke University were in relief...So were Loper's eight appearances with the North Adams (Mass.) SteepleCats in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2019.

**FLO-PER:** The Honolulu, Hawai'i native dominated to start the year in his return to the Florida State League... Before joining Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on May 13, Loper was among the best relief arms in the FSL...Among relievers with 14.0 or more innings of work at the time of his promotion, the right-hander was second in strikeout-to-walk rate (9.50), tied for second in fewest walks (2), and tied for seventh in WHIP (1.00)

**2023:** Loper spent his first full professional season with Single-A St. Lucie after being assigned from extended spring training on April 11...in 24 relief appearances, the 24-year-old accumulated a 1-3 record with a 3.86 ERA (19 ER in 44.1 IP), four saves, 19 walks, and 55 strikeouts... Loper was ultimately placed on the 7-day injured list for the remainder of the season on August 12...Among Florida State League relievers with 44.0+ innings pitched, he was sixth in opposing OPS (.617), tied for seventh in fewest walks (19) and hits (40) allowed, and 10th in ERA (3.86) and strikeout-to-walk rate (2.89).

**ADULT SWIM:** Loper was not only a standout in baseball, earning Rawlings/Perfect Game All-American Honorable Mention recognition, during his time at Hickory High School in Chesapeake, Va...The Duke University alum was also a star in the pool...Loper was a All-Conference First Team swimmer in high school and set the Hickory High School record in the 400 medley relay...Loper attended the same high school as former New York Mets captain, seven-time All-Star, and two-time Gold Glove and Silver Slugger award winner 3B **David Wright**.
