LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped a nailbiter against the BlueClaws, 5-4, on Tuesday night...Brooklyn put the tying and go-ahead run in scoring position in the ninth, but a line out to right ended the game...OF Nick Morabito posted a career-high-tying four hits, scored two runs, and drove in a season-best-matching three...He added a two-run home run — his first as a Cyclone — in the seventh...C Andrick Nava collected a team-high three hits for Jersey Shore, including a double, a run-scoring single in the sixth and a solo home run in the eighth...RHP Kade Morris went 5.0 innings and allowed two runs (one earned) in a no-decision for Brooklyn...RHP Jean Cabrera took a no-decision for Jersey Shore after punching out nine...He allowed a season-high eight hits, as well as three runs, in 6.2 innings.

NICK THE QUICK: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old tied a career-high with four hits and matched a season-best with three runs batted in during Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore...Morabito is the first Cyclone to accrue a four-hit night since 38 Jacob Reimer went 4-for-5 on August 17, 2023, vs. Hudson Valley...The feat occurred six times for the Cyclones in 2023, including 2B Chase Estep's 4-for-5 day on June 4 at Jersey Shore...Morabito is the first Cyclone to register 4+ hits, 3+ RBI, and at least one home run in a single game 3B William Lugo was 4-for-6 with four runs scored, four RBI, and a three-run homer on August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The last three Brooklyn players to achieve that line in one game have accomplished it at ShoreTown Ballpark...CF Alex Ramirez (4x5, 1HR, 5 RBI) did it, as well, on July 22, 2022...Morabito is second in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.371), trailing only former Bowling Green and current Double-A Montgomery OF Chandler Simpson (.376)...He is also fourth in on-base percentage (.491) and tied for ninth in stolen bases (23)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for the league lead in steals (12), tied for second in runs scored (17), and fifth in on-base percentage (.438).

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley...LHP Felipe De La Cruz grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF Nick Lorusso was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26...De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday, logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shutout innings...He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits... He is the first Brooklyn pitcher to receive the honor since RHP Luis Moreno from July 26-31, 2022...On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series...The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/.588/1.286 with a whopping 1.874 OPS...He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday...Lorusso is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Week since OF Stanley Consuegra from April 10-16, 2023...The sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the full-season level in 2021...LHP Gunnar Kines and OF José Miguel Medina were the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

LONG BALL LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched two more home runs in lat Thursday's loss to Hudson Valley, marking his second multi-home run game of the year...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso is third in OPS (919) and slugging (537), tied for third in triples (3), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (18), seventh in RBI (25), tied for seventh in total bases (72), and 10th in batting average (291)...The Connecticut native is on a season-high-tying nine-game hitting streak since May 16... During the streak — the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 — the ninth-round selection is slashing .353/.476/.706/1.182...In that time, Lorusso has added a double, a triple, three home runs, and six RBI.

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter their series against Jersey Shore with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but an 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The 'Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the 10th-best home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball...Chicago-AL's Birmingham (1.91) has the lowest mark in MiLB...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP Felipe De La Cruz put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts - one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP Mike Cox (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP Brad Holt (7/24/08 vs. VER)...De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP Rob Gsellman accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings...De La Cruz enters play with the eighth lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League amongst qualifiers (2.68)...The Dominican native is also tied for eighth in strikeouts (50).

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF Stanley Consuegra has been on a tear lately...Brooklyn's all-time leader in extra-base hits (73), home runs (33), and RBI (108), matched OF Alex Ramírez's mark of 164 hits with a single to left in the top of the second on Tuesday...Last week, Consuegra homered in back-to-back contests - a grand slam Friday and leadoff home run Saturday...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)... On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Justin Crawford (4), SS Bryan Rincon (7), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), and LHP Sam Aldegheri (23)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones 15-11 including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown clones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...The two sides split the first series at Jersey Shore from April 16-21...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 49-41 (.544).

BASEBALK: The Cyclones' pitching staff set a dubious record on Saturday night, being charged with five balks...No team in Minor League Baseball has been charged with more than four..Since the MiLB stat portal began in 2005, no full-season team had ever been charged with 5+ balks in a single game...It has only occurred seven times in total and three times outside of the complex level...In 2023, the ACL Dodgers and DSL Pirates Blue were called for five on July 3 and June 8, respectively...The high-water mark is six by the DSL Cardinals on July 7, 2008.

DOU NOT ENTER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in last Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06) and is eighth in batting average against (.175), and 10th in WHIP (1.06)...Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory last Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (4 ER in 40.0 IP)...Tong is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.90)...Only Arizona's LHP Spencer Giesting (0.66) at High-A Hillsboro has a lower mark...The Markham, Ont. native is fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.4%) is eighth...Tong's 62 strikeouts are tied for eighth-most in the minors.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.65...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.50 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.15)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and fifth among full-season Mil.B squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.21).

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Last Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF William Lugo has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 36 free passes are the second most in the league...Lugo's 21.3% walk rate is also second in the league and sixth in Minor League Baseball.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,006-850 (.542) in 1,856 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 208-219 (.487) in 427 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 53 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.62 ERA (25 ER in 86.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 75.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline..The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision pitching in relief last Saturday night vs. Hudson Valley... Entered in relief of LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** to start the top of the seventh with the Cyclones leading 7-0... Surrendered a run on two hits in 1.0 inning of work... Did not walk a batter and punched out two...Tossed 31 pitches and 21 strikes (67.74%)...Relieved by RHP **Justin Lawson** to start the eighth with Brooklyn still in front, 7-1...Cyclones went on to defeat the Renegades, 7-3, clinching a series victory.

BIRDMAN BIRDMAN: Prior to making the first start of his professional career, Hawkins has impressed in a relief role thus far in 2024...Among South Atlantic League relievers, the 24-year-old is sixth in strikeouts (34) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (24.2)...He is also first in ground ball rate (62.1%) and swinging strike rate (19.7%), second in strikeout rate (33.0%) and FIP (1.88), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.3%), seventh in walk rate (8.7%).

2023: Signed with the New York Mets as an undrafted free agent out of Washington State University on July 19, 2023...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Made a pair of scoreless relief appearances before being transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 26...Did not allow a run on two hits over 6.0 innings with the Mets...Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

I REMEMBER YOU!: Playing collegiate summer ball in 2021 with the St. Cloud (Minn.) Rox of the Northwoods League, Hawkins was a teammate of Jersey Shore infielder Otto Kemp...The Rox won the Great Plains West Division with a 50-18 record and reached the Northwoods League Finals before falling to the Traverse City (Mich.) Pit Spitters...Other members of the St. Cloud squad included former BlueClaws C Caleb Ricketts (2023), former Wilmington Blue Rocks OF Andrew Pinckney (2023), as well as current Asheville Tourists INF Brice Matthews and Blue Rocks RHP Riley Cornelio.

WAZZOU WIZARD: The Chehalis, Wash. native had an outstanding career at Washington State University...After starting his collegiate tenure with two years at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.), Hawkins went on to be named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention in 2023...In 14 starts, he accrued a 5-3 record with a 4.32 ERA (35 ER in 73.0 IP) with 27 walks and 92 strikeouts... His 92 K's were fourth in the conference and ninthmost in a single-season at Washington State.
