YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Rumble Ponies, 9-0. Kyle Harrison pitched six scoreless innings, allowing two hits and no walks with 10 strikeouts. Clay Helvey and John Russell pitched the final three innings to finish the shutout. Richmond opened the scoring in the first with an RBI single by Tristan Peters and added a second run on a balk. In the third, Tyler Fitzgerald hit at two-run homer to extend the lead to 4-0. In the fifth, two runs scored on an error, Peters hit an RBI double and Armani Smith extended the lead to 8-0 with an RBI double. Fitzgerald brought in a ninth run with a double in the sixth.

Mon., August 21

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series is the first and only set between the two teams this season. Last year, Richmond and Binghamton met for a six-game series at The Diamond from June 29-July 4, 2021. The Rumble Ponies won the first three games before the Flying Squirrels took the last three, outscoring the Rumble Ponies, 20-9, to close the series. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, but the entire set was canceled. With this series, the Flying Squirrels have now played every team in the Eastern League this year.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 13-27 in the second half. They are 7-19 in the last 26 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost eight and split four this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1/192 strikeouts (10.9 per game) and rank fourth with 136 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 28-24 at home this year. Richmond is 24-22 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 14-23 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 4-8 record in road games and a 10-15 record at The Diamond.

THE RUMBLE PONIES hold the worst-overall record in the Eastern League and are in last place in the Northeast Division second-half standings. After posting a season-high five-game winning streak at Somerset from August 2-5, the Rumble Ponies are 2-8 in their last 10 games since August 6, including dropping four-of-five to the Curve at home last week. Binghamton's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects, including SS Ronny Mauricio (3), INF/OF Carlos Cortes (15), C Hayden Senger (20) and C Nick Meyer (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his league-leading 23rd start of the season. He last pitched on Friday at Portland and struck out 10 batters, allowing two runs over five innings. It was his second straight start with 10 strikeouts in five innings. Over his last three starts since July 30, Teng is 0-1 with a 1.38 ERA (2 ER/13.0 IP) and 26 strikeouts. In the Eastern League this year, Teng is ranked tied for second with 123 strikeouts, tied for first with 2 games started, fourth with 10.4.0 innings pitched and ninth with a 2.49 BAA. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Jose Chacin makes his 15th Double-A start of the year. Last time out, he pitched four score-less innings against the Curve on Friday in Binghamton, striking out seven batters. He began the season with High-A Brooklyn and went 0-1 with a 1.53 ERA in four starts. He was promoted to Double-A on May 2. Chacin signed with the Dodgers as a free agent in 2015 and pitched in their organization through 2019 before being released prior to the start of the 2021 season. He signed as a free agent with the Mets on June 1, 2021 and pitched 14 games at three levels last year.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,187). Richmond is 15th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 136 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. On A 7 in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the se breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in jugames, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 171 home runs. **Sean** is tied for third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Infielder Casey Schmitt was promoted to Double-A Richmond prior to last week's series in Portland. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .375 (9-for-24) with three doubles, a triple and two RBIs in his last six games. He picked up three hits in Sunday's series finale against the Sea Dogs. At the time of his promotion to Double-A from High-A Eugene, Schmitt ranked fifth in the Northwest League in batting average (.273), tied for second in homers (17), second in RBIs (59), third in OBP (.363), second in SLG (.474), first in OPS (.837), sixth in hits (91), tied for sixth in walks (42), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (32), tied for second in total bases (158) and third in runs scored (58).

SMITH STREAKING: Armani Smith is currently riding an 11-game hit streak since August 4, which is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the second-longest hitting streak for a Richmond player this year, trailing a 13-game stretch be Shane Matheny in May and June. During the streak, Smith is batting .326 (15-for-46) with two doubles, one homer and thre RBIs. Smith has also reached base in 14 straight games, tied for the second-longest on-base streak for the Flying Squirrels the season. He hit .313 (21-for-67) in his first 18 Double-A games from May 15-June 16 before batting .168 (17-for-101) in his next 2 games through August 2.

MARTY PARTY: Brandon Martorano posted a seven-game hit streak from July 28-August 11 before going 0-for-8 in his last two games of the series at Portland. In his last 10 games since July 28, Martorano is batting .324 (11-for-34) with a homer, three doubles and six RBIs.

BACH TO FORM: In his last 10 games, Brett Auerbach is batting .300 (12-for-40) with four homers, three doubles, 12 RBIs and nine runs scored. He opened last week's series with a four-hit game on Tuesday at New Hampshire, including a homer. He went deep again last Wednesday, his third straight game with a home run. On Sunday, Auerbach picked up four hits again, including a homer and three doubles, and drove in six runs. On Monday, Auerbach was announced as the Eastern League's Player of the Week for August 2-7. He hi .125 (2-for-16) with one RBI in last week's seres at Portland.

FITZ ON FIRE: Over his last 27 games since July 10, Tyler Fitzgerald has homered nine times. He now has 19 homers this season, which ranks as the third-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of with Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mario Lisson (2014) and trailing only David Villar (20 - 2021) and Sean Roby (23 - 2022). Over his last 17 games since July 28 Fitzgerald is batting .323 (21-for-65) with four homers, four doubles and 15 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .218.

ROBUST: Sean Roby hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of David Villar for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for third in the EL in homers. He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by Adam Duvall in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Frankie Tostado is ranked third in batting average (.284). Sean Roby is tied for in homers (23). Mike Gigliotti is ninth in walks (51) and sixth in stolen bases (24). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for eighth in homers (18) and is 10th in runs scored (58). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for second in strikeouts (123), tied for first in games started (22), fourth in innings pitched (104.0) and ninth in BAA (.249).

WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK: In the Eastern League, Brett Baty is ranked second in batting average (.312), tied for eighth in homers (19), first in OBP (.406), fourth in SLG (.544), first in OPS (.950), tied for third in hits (105), tied for seventh in doubles (22), ninth in extra-base hits (41), third in total bases (185) and first in runs scored (73). Francisco Alvarez is seventh in batting average (.277), eighth in OBP (.368), second in SLG (.553) and third in OPS (.921). Ronny Mauricio is tied for fifth in homers (22), second in RBIs (70), eighth in hits (98), tied for seventh in doubles (22), tied for second in extra-base hits (45) and second in total bases (188).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), Casey Schmitt (6), Ryan Murphy (15), Cole Waites (21) and Ricardo Genovés (30). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), Schmitt (13), Tristan Peters (25) and Genovés (30). Harrison is Baseball America's No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
