**Today's Game:** The Sounds vie for their first series win of the season this afternoon, hosting the Omaha Storm Chasers in the finale of the six-game series. Omaha hit four homers on their way to an 8-2 win in front of a sellout crowd last night. It'll be a bullpen day for both teams - left-hander Nick Bennett will get the ball for Nashville and right-hander Jonah Dipoto will face him for Omaha.

**Nick Bennett:** The 26-year-old southpaw makes his first start at the Triple-A level this afternoon. It's his fourth outing of the season after having worked in relief in the series opener (L, 2.2 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 0 K). Bennett began his minor league career mostly as a starter before transitioning to the bullpen last season - he had just three starts in 32 appearances with the Shuckers a season ago. The Ohioan had just one appearance in each of the last two seasons with Nashville - taking the loss in relief on June 1, 2022 at Durham (0.2 IP, 2 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 4 BB, 1 K) and then grabbing a miraculous win despite allowing four runs (3 ER) in the ninth in a wild 15-14 victory over Columbus on July 5, 2023. Bennett has taken the decision in each of his last two appearances, including the win with 2.0 scoreless innings on April 7 vs. St. Paul in the Sounds' last Sunday home game. The former Louisville Cardinals pitcher was selected in the sixth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by the Brewers.

**Jonah Dipoto:** The 27-year-old is set to make his first start in affiliated baseball this afternoon. The son of former Major Leaguer and current President of Baseball Operations for the Seattle Mariners Jerry Dipoto, Jonah has an 8.10 ERA (3.1 IP/3 ER) through four appearances this season. He got a couple of outs in Omaha's loss to Nashville on April 18. Walks have been his issue, as Dipoto has given out four free passes in 3.1 innings. He spent most of last season in Omaha's bullpen, going 3-2 with a 4.24 ERA (40.1 IP/19 ER). Dipoto was selected in the 35th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by the Royals out of UC San Diego.

**A Fine Brew:** Brewer Hicklen added a double, stolen base and run scored in last night's game. The offseason acquisition by the Brewers is the Sounds' hottest hitter, boasting a .417 on-base percentage and .988 OPS. Hicklen ranks among league leaders in stolen bases (T-2nd, 10), doubles (T-4th, 7) and runs (T-6th, 17). Exactly half (11-of-22) of his hits have gone for extra bases while averaging a stolen base in each of the last four games.

**Big Hit Haase:** Catcher Eric Haase extended his RBI streak to six games with a single in the fourth inning that plated Hicklen with two outs. The streak is tied for the longest in the International League this season (Charlotte's Danny Mendick is also on an active six-game RBI streak). Since making his debut for the Sounds on April 5, Haase's 14 RBI is tied for the third most in the league. It's the longest RBI streak by a Sound since Keston Hiura's six-game streak from August 15-22 last season.

**Injury Report:** This morning, outfielder Chris Roller was added to the 7-day injured list, retroactive April 20. He becomes the sixth Sounds player to join the injured list, a day after left-handed reliever Darrell Thompson was added. The Sounds have lost several key players to injury this season, including losing prospect Jefferson Quero in the first game of the season. However, left-hander and 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year Robert Gasser is expected to return and make his first start of 2024 with Nashville at Louisville on Wednesday morning.

**Saturday in the Park:** The Sounds welcomed 10,420 fans for the first sellout of the season at First Horizon Park yesterday. It was the second largest crowd at any game in the International League this season (ironically, the largest was Toledo's Opening Day crowd of 12,800 against the Sounds on March 29).

**CP is Quality:** Chad Patrick tossed his first quality start on Friday - it was his first since July 30, 2023 with Amarillo (6.1 IP, 5 H, 0 ER, 6 K at Midland). It was also his first quality start at the Triple-A level. Patrick is one of three Sounds starters to toss a quality start this season (Evan McKendry on April 4 vs. St. Paul and Carlos Rodriguez on April 17 vs. Omaha). None of the Sounds pitchers who have thrown quality starts have received a decision in those contests, but Nashville has won all three of those games.

**Bullpen Beat:** The Sounds bullpen had a setback in yesterday's loss, but still continue to lead the league in several categories. They lead the Triple-A level in most statistical categories, including ERA (1.72), WHIP (0.98) and opponent batting average (.156). The next closest bullpen ERA at the level comes in at 3.58 (Sacramento). No other team has a sub-.200 opponent batting average.

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 693-593 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,285-2,113 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

### Most Wins by Minor League Managers

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.
