**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve play their final series before the All-Star Break, a six-game set with Bowie at PNG Field.

**LAST TIME OUT:** **Yoyner Fajardo** and **Tres Gonzalez** each had two hit days, but the Curve's 7-game win streak ended with a 2-1 loss.

**A BIG ADDITION:** Utilityman **Yoyner Fajardo** has reached base safely in 23 straight games, during which he's batting .360/.446/.419 with 5 2B, 6 RBI, 13 BB, 10-11 SB. Since June 1, his .340 batting average is 5th in the Eastern League. Fajardo's on-base streak is tied for the 2nd longest active streak by a Double-A player and the 2nd-longest in the Eastern League player this season.

**THE CHEN CHRONICLES:** Righty **Po-Yu Chen** overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed just one run 5 times in his last 9 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.47 ERA (15 ER / 54.2 IP) with 46 strikeouts.

**THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS:** Righty **Thomas Harrington** matched his career-long 7.0 innings in back-to-back outings on July 4 and July 10. Harrington became the third Curve pitcher this season to strike out at least 10 batters with his 11 strikeout performance on July 10 vs Bowie. Since June 16 (5 starts) Harrington has gone 2-1 with a 1.50 ERA (5 ER / 30.0 IP) and allowed a 0.90 WHIP with 31 strikeouts. Harrington has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 9-of-11 outings with Altoona this year and his 42 strikeouts since June 1 are 3rd-most by an Eastern League pitcher.

The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (**Harrington**, **Bubba Chandler** and **Braxton Ashcraft**) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The Curve are one of 12 teams in the affiliated minors, one of two at Double-A (Binghamton) to have at least five 10-K games this season. The five 10-strikeout games this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (34 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

**TWO PIRATES ARE BETTER THAN ONE:** On Tuesday, July 9, the Curve hosted MLB rehabs for RHP **David Bednar** and LHP **Ryan Borucki**. Bednar, recovering from a left oblique strain, and Borucki, recovering from left triceps tendinitis, are the second and third Pirates to rehab with Altoona this season after **C Henry Davis** played two games in late-June. Borucki and Bednar combined to toss 2.2 scoreless innings with 3 K's and allowed only one baserunner on a fielder error in their outing. Borucki also tossed a scoreless innings on Friday, July 12. July 9 was the seventh time in franchise history that the Curve are hosting more than one Pirate on rehab in the same game, the first since 2022 when Altoona hosted INF/OF **Tucupita Marciano**, LHP **Dillon Peters**, and RHP **Duane Underwood Jr.** on June 28, 2022.

**QUITE A START:** From June 21-July 11 (18 games) Altoona starters have been the backbone of the team's success. 9 times in the 18 game stretch, a Curve starter threw a quality start (6.0 IP+ and 3 ER or fewer) with 7 outings lasting 7.0 innings or longer. Altoona's 3.26 ERA since June 21 was 5th-best among Double-A teams. Curve starters went 8-5 with a 2.64 ERA (30 ER / 102.1 IP) allowing 70 hits, 28 walks (0.96 WHIP) and 97 strikeouts from June 21-July 11.

**BUBBA'S BURGERS:** **Bubba Chandler** has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 39.0 IP with 47 strikeouts, recording a 4-2 record with a 2.08 ERA (9 ER / 39.0 IP) with a 0.72 WHIP. Since June 1, his 44 strikeouts are the 4th-most by a Double-A pitcher and he ranks 2nd in WHIP with a 0.69 mark. Chandler is the 22nd player in franchise history to be selected to the MLB Futures Game which will take place on July 13 at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Altoona has had 21 players previously selected to the MLB All-Star Futures Game since its inception in 1999. **C Henry Davis** (2022), and RHP **Roansy Contreras** (2021) were the most recent players selected to the roster, **3B Ke'Bryan Hayes** was the last Curve player to participate in the game, doing so in Washington, DC in 2018. Chandler would become the first active Curve player to pitch in the Futures Game since RHP **Dovydas Neverauskas** pitched in 2016 at Petco Park in San Diego.

**HE WILL McADOO:** Infielder **Charles McAdoo** made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. He's reached base in 13-of-17 games since joining the Curve, batting .250/.360/.467/.829 with 3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, 11 BB, and 14 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (91), 2B (18), RBI (58), T-3rd in SB (16), and 2nd in OPS (.955), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

**THE MEN FROM THE BAY:** Roberto Mercado leads the Baysox after two seasons managing the Orioles High-A affiliate in Aberdeen. Mercado led the Ironbirds to a playoff appearance in 2022 and took home the organization's Cal Ripken Sr. Award given to the minor league instructor with the most dramatic impact during the season. The typically loaded Baysox are a bit light in the prospect department this year, but OF **Dylan Beavers**, C/DH **Samuel Basallo** and C **Silas Ardoin** highlight the position player group.

**THE FIRST TO PULL ON THEIR SOX:** Ryan Long takes a break from stacking kegs to pitch for Bowie tonight. Long was Baltimore's 17th Round pick in 2021 out of Division III Pomona-Pitzer College. A native of Woodinville, WA, Long pitched for Team Great Britain (his mom, Liz was born in England) in the World Baseball Classic in 2023 and faced Team USA where he allowed a homer to Kyle Schwarber and struck out Mike Trout. Long was slated to attend graduate school at Georgetown and has passed the LSAT, before he decided to give pro ball a chance. Long took an informal role representing minor leaguers in CBA unionization in 2022.

Was rated as the 237th-best prospect by Baseball America prior to the 2021 draft... Signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$125,000...

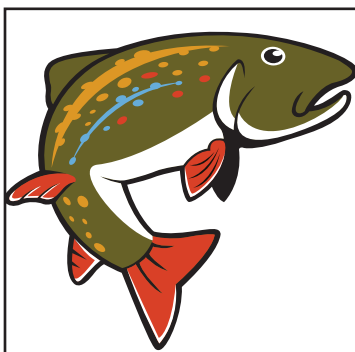

## GONE FISHIN'



Returning to Curve, PA for the first time since 2021, Altoona will once again celebrate Brookies Weekend from Saturday, July 13 through Sunday, July 14 when the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, come to town. The Curve will wear their signature Brook Trout themed jerseys and caps paying tribute to the Pennsylvania State Fish, presented by Blair County Suicide Prevention Task Force, American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, and Blair County System of Care. Fans can place their bids on game-worn and autographed jerseys via the LiveSource app. The Brook Trout was named the Pennsylvania state fish in 1970 and are the most common state fish in the country with nine states recognizing the Brookie as their *oh-fish-al fish*. A wild Brook trout may be from five to 18 inches long.
