YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats hit three more home runs on Friday night, defeating the Reading Fightin' Phils 14-6 at FirstEnergy Stadium. **Orelvis Martinez** hit his eighth and ninth home runs of the season, part of a five RBI night for the Blue Jays No. 4 prospect. It's the second straight multi-home run game for Martinez. He has five home runs and 10 RBIs in the series. **Miguel Hiraldo** also drove in five RBIs for the first time this season, blasting a three-run home run in the fifth. **Will Robertson** and **Trevor Schwecke** collected multi-RBI performances while Robertson recorded a game-high three hits on the night. Eight of the nine Fisher Cats in the starting lineup recorded at least one hit on the night. New Hampshire matched season-highs in runs (14) and hits (13). **Gabriel Ponce** picked up his first win of the season, pitching a scoreless fourth and fifth in relief with two strikeouts. **Alejandro Melean** struck out a season-high eight batters over three innings pitched in relief.

HOME RUN DERBY: New Hampshire has hit 13 home runs in the four games so far in this series (two on Tuesday, three on Wednesday, five on Thursday, three on Friday). Coming into the series, the Fisher Cats had only hit 17 homers all season through the first 26 games of the year. **Orelvis Martinez, Damiano Palmegiani,** and **Miguel Hiraldo** have all hit more than one homer in the series (Martinez has five, Palmegiani has two, Hiraldo has two).

MUST SEE MARTINEZ: IF Orelvis Martinez is thoroughly enjoying his week in Reading at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect has multi-home run performances in back-to-back games and has five home runs and 10 RBIs in the series after hitting another two homers and five RBIs yesterday. All five of his hits in the series have gone over the wall. It's his 10th career multi-homer game and his second five-RBI game of the season. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native is tied for second in the Eastern League with nine home runs and second in the Eastern League with 25 RBIs. He hit a team-high 30 home runs last season, breaking the Fisher Cats single-season record of 27 home runs previously set by Chip Cannon (2006) and Eric Thames (2010).

WILLING US TO VICTORY: OF Will Robertson has turned things around ever since the calendar flipped from April to May. After hitting .116 (5-for-43) with three RBIs all of April, he is hitting .375 (12-for-32) with nine RBIs in eight games here in May and is on a six-game hit streak. Robertson recorded another two-RBI performance yesterday, his third multi-RBI game of the season. He has recorded all three of his multi-RBI performances in May.

ON-BASE PALMEGIANI: IF **Damiano Palmegiani** is at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .417 clip, fourth-best in the league. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect is third in the Eastern League in walks (24). He has more walks than hits (21). Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 23 of 27 games played this season and has walked in 18 games.

CAN'T STOP STEWARD: OF **Steward Berroa** currently has the longest active hit streak on the team at six consecutive games. The speedy outfielder has driven in six RBIs over his last six games after driving in six RBIs all of April. During his hit streak, Berroa is 8-for-22 (.364) with three doubles, a homer and six RBIs.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 13, 2005)- Fisher Cats 3 Curve 2 – For the second straight year, Cam Reimers (RY-mers) won for the Fisher Cats on May 13. Reimers, who started the first game in Fisher Cats history, improved to 5-0 with a win against Trenton on this date in 2004. The next year, he started and won at Altoona. Reimers allowed two runs (both unearned) in his six innings.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (22-16) blanked Atlanta 3-0 behind a complete-game two-hitter by Chris Bassitt. Bassitt improved to 5-2- he walked two and struck out eight (103 pitches). Game 2 is this afternoon at Rogers Centre...Triple-A Buffalo (16-21) walked-off Syracuse again. Spencer Horwitz had an RBI single ahead of Jordan Luplow's three-run homer that ended the game after the Mets had taken a 6-4 lead in the top of the ninth. Luplow went 2-4 with 2 HR, 5 RBI...High-A Vancouver (17-10) won 10-2 over Everett for a third straight win in the matinee. Trenton Wallace threw five hitless innings, striking out seven, to improve to 4-1...Class A Dunedin (17-14) dropped a 9-3 decision to Clearwater in a game shortened to eight innings due to rain.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their road trip at Reading for a six-game series against the Fightin Phils'. The next home stand for New Hampshire begins on Tue. May 16 when they host the Binghamton Rumble Ponies for a six-game set.
