Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the finale in a six-game series (and 18-game season series) with the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Lugnuts have lost four of five games in the series, halting a streak of seven wins in nine games for the Nuts entering the series.

On the Air: Today's game is available on MiLB TV with John Nolan, or tune in via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa on the call.

Yesterday: TinCaps 4, Lugnuts 3; TinCaps 7, Lugnuts 1 (7). The 'Caps beat the Lugnuts twice, taking the resumption of Friday's suspended game behind a three-run second inning, a four-hit game from Lucas Dunn and a sterling bullpen effort, and then triumphed over the Nuts in the regularly-scheduled game, shortened to seven innings, behind a five-run first inning against Blaze Pontes.

On Deck: The Lugnuts enjoy a day off tomorrow before welcoming the Peoria Chiefs to Jackson Field from May 28-June 2.

Scar at the Helm: Lansing is managed this series by Steve Scarsone, replacing second-year manager Craig Conklin during Conklin's prescheduled week-long break. Scarsone was drafted by the Phillies in the second round in 1986 from Santa Ana College, rising through the ranks to play seven years and 350 games in the Majors with Philly, Baltimore, San Francisco, St. Louis and Kansas City. He managed in the Midwest League with South Bend in 2001 and Kane County in 2009. Scarsone's current title within the A's system is Minor League Outfield and Base Running Coordinator, a position he has held since 2020. He also served as interim manager last season, skippering the Lugnuts to a six-game split at Quad Cities, July 25-30.

Pride of Palo Alto: 20-year-old Henry Bolte, the youngest player on the team, leads the Midwest League with 38 runs scored. Last week, Bolte was named the Midwest League Player of the Week and a member of Minor League Baseball's Prospect Team of the Week after going 10-for-22 (.455/.586/1.000) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, six walks, nine runs scored, seven runs batted in, and four steals against Lake County. He currently is tied for 2nd in the league in total bases (81), tied for 3rd in steals (17), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (20), tied for 4th in triples (3) and 5th in runs batted in (34).

Three's a Charm: The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League in triples (20), five behind the MiLB-leading Albuquerque Isotopes and four in front of the MLB-leading Detroit Tigers.

Sunday Funday: The Lugnuts have won four of the last five series finales, and are slashing .278/.385/.459 on Sundays this year, led by strong performances from **Danny Bautista, Jr.** (10-for-18, .556/.636/..667), **Euribiel Angeles** (11-for-26, .423/.464/.846), **Will Simpson** (8-for-22, .364/.516/.636) and **Henry Bolte** (8-for-25, .320/.469/.760).

Others of Note: Closer Colton Johnson is tied for 2nd in the Midwest League with 16 appearances and tied for 3rd with five saves. Colby Halter is tied for 3rd in walks (30); Brayan Buelvas is 2nd in extra-base hits (21), tied for 2nd in doubles (12), tied for 4th in triples (3), tied for 3rd in walks (30), tied for 4th in runs (34) and 8th in RBIs (30); and Will Simpson is 2nd in walks (31) and 5th in OPS (.945).

Welcome Back: Euribiel Ángeles, a member of the 2021 TinCaps, opened the year 1-for-22, but is 46-for-137 since, a .336 clip. He is tied for 6th in the league in hits (47), tied for 3rd in RBIs (36, 24 in May alone) and tied for 2nd in triples (4).

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes four MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 27) and southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 30). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and Johnston at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization.

Today in Lugnuts History

2017: Down 7-1 to Great Lakes entering the bottom of the 6th, Bo Bichette bashed a two-run homer, Christian Williams hit a three-run homer and J.B. Woodman lofted a game-tying oppo homer directly down the left field line – but the Loons promptly replied with five in the 7th. Bradley Jones led off the bottom of the 7th inning with yet another homer, but the Lugnuts fell 12-8. The Nuts had hit only three homers all month before breaking out.

2018: The Lugnuts were trailing the Fort Wayne TinCaps, 10-3, into the late-going, and down 10-5 going to the bottom of the 9th, but scored five runs to force extra innings, and then came back from an 11-10 deficit in the bottom of the 10th to walk off with a 12-11 win on a walk-off error on second baseman Esteury Ruiz.

In a Nutshell: One of four undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last lowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 lowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-lowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With lowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... can often be seen at this time of year wearing his Boston Bruins Patrice Bergeron uniform.


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Retrospective: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win... finished with 18 appearances, 84 1/3 IP.
