Uncharted Territory... For the first time in team history, the Hot Rods will take on the Frederick Keys. Based in Frederick, Maryland, the Keys joined the South Atlantic League for 2026. The team replaced the Aberdeen IronBirds, flipping Frederick to the SAL, while Aberdeen went to the MLB Draft League. Frederick served as the Class-A Advanced affiliate for the Orioles from 1989 to 2020, spending 2021 to 2025 in the MLB Draft Leage, and returned to High-A in 2026.

McCoy in Motion... Since the beginning of July, Ryan McCoy has been one of the hottest bats in the Hot Rods lineup. Over his past 30 games, McCoy is hitting .360 with 10 doubles, two triples, and eight homers. During this stretch, he has posted a 1.208 OPS. Overall this season, McCoy leads all SAL hitters with a 1.017 OPS, with the next closest being Jared Jones (.949) for Greensboro.

Aybar's Antics... Nicandro Aybar joined the Hot Rods on July 29. Since his promotion, he has been an important piece of the Hot Rods offensive success. Over 10 games, Aybar is 16-for-34 (.471) while driving in seven and scoring six times. Along with his consistent swings, Aybar has excelled at getting on base, walking six times compared to six strikeouts, creating a .550 OBP.

New Face, First Start... Blake Morgan will make his first High-A start on Tuesday for Bowling Green. The southpaw was a 19th round pick by the Rays during the 2025 MLB Draft. Morgan started the season with Single-A Charleston, posting a 4-2 record with a 3.47 ERA. He worked through 62.1 innings, striking out 64 batters while walking just 14.

Santa Maria's Stolen Bases... Tony Santa Maria is now ranked fifth in single-season steals in Hot Rods franchise history. Santa Maria has swiped 45 bases this season, most recently passing Vidal Brujan's 43 steals from 2018. He sits two steals away from Adrian Santana, who stole 47 bases in 2025. The franchise leader is Andrew Toles with 62 stolen bases in 2013.
