SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

BISCUITS FOR BREAKFAST: The Shuckers are set to make their first trip to Riverwalk Stadium since Games 2 and 3 of the 2024 Southern League Division Series... In the team's first meeting at Keesler Federal Park between April 22-27, the Shuckers outscored the Biscuits 34-19 (+15) with 9 home runs during the 4-2 series win.

IT STARTS AT THE TOP: After a 1-for-3 day on Sunday, 1B Luke Adams helped the Shuckers improve to 8-0 when he bats first or second... When occupying either of the top 2 spots in the lineup, Adams is 8-for-25 (.320) with 4 doubles, 6 walks and a .980 OPS... In the lead-off spot, Adams averages 4.857 pitches per plate appearance, the 2nd-best mark in Double-A (min.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE A BROCK-STAR: Since April 23 (17g), 3B Brock Wilken leads Double-A in OPS (1.163), slugging percentage [.724] and isolated power (.414) with a 16% walk-rate... Over 10 games in May, Wilken is batting .382 (13-for-34) with 3 doubles, 5 home runs, a .476 on-base percentage and a 1.388 OPS... Over that 17-game span, Wilken has raised his average from .151 to .234, an 83-point increase... Wilken enters today with 8 home runs, tied for the Southern League lead.

WARREN'S CHASING HISTORY: INF/OF Zavier Warren recorded his 33rd career home run with the Shuckers in game one of Saturday's doubleheader... Warren enters today with the 4th most career home runs in franchise history (since 2015)... The franchise record is 36, set by INF Jake Gatewood between 2017-19... Warren is 1 of 5 players in franchise history to recor at least 30 career home runs.

GONE FISHING: With a doubleheader sweep on Saturday night, the Shuckers clinched their 4th straight series win and their 1st series win over the Pensacola Blue Wahoos since September 13-18, 2022 at Blue Wahoos Stadium... Prior to the series win, the Shuckers had split or lost 9 consecutive series against the Blue Wahoos... Over the current 4-series win streak, the Shuckers have gone 18-6, a .750 win percentage.

The Shuckers have won 4 consecutive series of any length for the first time they won 7 consecutive series between May 6 and June 11, 2019... The Shuckers went 26-9 over the 35 game stretch, a .743 win percentage.

NOW THAT'S A TURNAROUND: After a 1-7 start, the Shuckers have won 19 of their last 25 games and enter today at 20-13, the best record in the Southern League... Over their last 25 games, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 143-82, a +61 run differential... Over that span, the Shuckers have averaged 5.7 runs per game... The Shuckers have scored at least 5 runs in 18 of 25 games, including 16 times in their last 20 games.

- 📚 Over that span, the Shuckers lead the Southern League in home runs (29), runs (143), on-base percentage (.368), OPS [.797] and extra-base hits [80]... The Shuckers have scored 32 more runs than any other Southern League team over that span... Their team OPS of .797 is 20 points higher than all Double-A teams over that span.
- 📚 Over that span, the Shuckers have been led by INF/OF Ethan Murray (.311/.403/.590, 8 XBH, 13 RBI), C Ramón Rodríguez [.356/.458/.489], **3B Brock Wilken** [.244/.432/.537, 12 XBH, 6 HR, 16 RBI, 25 BB], **1B/3B Luke Adams** [.234/.410/.494, 12 XBH, 18 RBI) and INF/OF Zavier Warren (.275/.390/.475, 4 HR, 20 RBI).

HUNT (2-3, 5.40): Hunt makes his 7th start of the season and his 1st start in Montgomery since Game 2 of the 2024 SLDS, where he went 7.2 innings and allowed 1 run... Hunt set a season-high with 6.0 innings in his lone start against the Biscuits this season... In 2025, Hunt has limited left-handed batters to a .164

SHUCK FACTS: Named the No. 21 Brewers prospect by Baseball America, No. 29 by MLB Pipeline... Won the 2021 Men's College World Series National Championship with the Mississippi State Bulldogs, the first national title for any sport in school history... Played at Keesler Federal Park with Mississippi State as part of the Hancock Whitney Classic in 2020, 2022 and 2023... Brother, Shooter, was an All-American, the 2008 Conference USA Pitcher of the Year and was selected in the first round of the 2008 Draft by the Minnesota Twins... Middle name is "Clemente", named after his father's favorite player, Roberto Clemente... Roommates with 2024 Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year, Craig Yoho, and 2024 Shucker Brett Wichrowski during 2024 Spring Training.

TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Brewers as an Undrafted Free Agent on July 20, 2023... Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 12th round of the 2022 Draft, elected to return to Mississippi State.

2024: Made 25 appearances, 14 starts across 3 levels with the Shuckers, High-A Wisconsin and Single-A Carolina... Named Brewers Co-Minor League Pitcher of the Year... 139 strikeouts ranked as the second-most in the organization... Set career-high with 7.2 innings on September 19, 2024, in game two of the SLDS, recorded the 3rd-longest playoff start in franchise history... Became the first Southern League pitcher to record an out in the 8th inning in a playoff start since 2019... Became the 31st Southern League pitcher of the Month for August after 29 strikeouts, 2 walks and a 2.38 ERA over 4 starts with the Shuckers... Set career-high with 6.1 shutout innings on August 30, 2024 against Montgomery... Struck out eight over 5.1 innings in Double-A debut on August 9, 2024 at Montgomery... Over eight starts, had a 1.33 ERA with 51 strikeouts in 40.2 innings with Wisconsin prior to promotion... Set career-high with 10 strikeouts over 5.1 shutout innings on July 3, 2024 at Beloit... Named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on June 16, 2024 after 6.0 shutout innings with eight strikeouts on June 12, 2023 at West Michigan in second professional start... Made first professional start on June 6, 2024 against Quad Cities, struck out five over 5.0 shutout innings...
