20 WIN CLUB: After winning two thrillers in the first two games of the series with the Charleston RiverDogs, the FredNats now have 20 wins on the season and are tied for first place in the Carolina League North Divison. Tonight, the squad goes for its third win of the week against Charleston behind RHP Jose Atencio, who battled through five tough innings last time out against Down East. Atencio threw 94 pitches in his start last week, by far the most a FredNat hurler has tossed in any outing this year, starter or reliever. His five-pitch mix will try to keep the RiverDogs off balance, and the FredNats will try to do damage against Charleston starter T.J. Nichols, who has been a strong part of this Charleston rotation that has befuddled hitters all year. The FredNat bullpen has stranded the bases loaded in the last inning of both games of this series, winning by one run Tuesday night and two runs Wednesday.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Travis Sykora pitched much better in his second professional start, pitching into the 4th inning and allowing a weird two-run homer on a part of the left field wall that's a home run. Roismar Quintana and Caleb Farmer accounted for the entirety of the FredNat offense with back-to-back homers in the first inning. Bryan Polanco pitched 4.1 inning of scoreless relief, and Merrick Baldo left the bases loaded in the 9th to secure his first professional save.

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS: Last night, Roismar Quintana and Caleb Farmer homered on back-to-back pitches in the first inning against Charleston starter Santiago Suarez. It was the first home run of the year for both, and the first time all season the Freddies went back-to-back. Fredericksburg only hit back-to-back home runs once in all of 2023.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are a perfect 15-0 this season when scoring first, including all five wins two weeks ago against Delmarva, all four wins last week over Down East, and both wins this week against Charleston.

CONTINUED: Another key to winning this year has been production with runners in scoring position. In 20 wins, Fredericksburg is hitting .259 with RISP, compared to .091 in losses. The Freddies went 2-for-17 with RISP on Sunday, and left 14 men on base in a two-run loss, but it's been a decent bounce back series so far in Charleston as the Freddies are 3-for-8 with runners in scoring position

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. In 157 IP so far for the FredNat relievers, the unit has allowed 38 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.18. The Freddies are also 11/12 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is first in the Carolina League and tied with High-A Wilmington's Todd Peterson for the second-most saves in Minor League Baseball with six. The team is 15-0 when holding a lead after seven, and 18-0 when leading after eight innings this year. Bryan Polanco has been a strong contributor to the bullpen, logging 25.1 innings and allowing just seven earned runs. He pitched 4.1 scoreless frames last night in relief of starter Travis Sykora.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 161-129 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Jose Atencio is set to make his sixth appearance and fourth start of 2024, coming off a third consecutive five-inning outing.

A YEAR AGO: Jose proved to be one of the most important pitchers for Fredericksburg last season, as he seamlessly toggled between the starting rotation and the bullpen. He was most effective as a starter (7 GS) as he went at least four innings in each start, did not allow an ER in three of his outings, and never allowed more than four earned runs.

DEEP IN HIS BAG: Atencio may not feature a triple digit fastball, but he utilizes a true five-pitch arsenal to keep opposing hitters off balance. Featuring three different fastballs and breaking balls darting in all directions, Atencio has made a living off missing barrels.

Atencio added a cutter in the 2023 offseason, modeling it after Corbin Burnes of the Baltimore Orioles.

GETTING TO FXBG: Atencio breezed through the FCL in 2022, earning himself a mid-July promotion to Fredericksburg where he did not miss a beat. The Venezuelan-born right hander worked five innings in his FXBG introduction, allowing just two runs against Salem in a FredNats win. That was a sign of things to come, as Atencio did not allow more than three earned runs in seven of his eight starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Atencio pitched into the sixth inning last week, tying himself and two others for the longest start by a FredNat this year. Down East tagged him for 12 base hits, but just four runs as Atencio did very well to limit hard contact.
