### HIGHLIGHTS

HARD-HIM: In Friday night's 10-0 win, Tyler Hardman set a career-high 6 RBIs, while tying a career-high 4 hits for the second time in his career with his sixth career multi-homer game. After going his first 190 career games with one multi-homer game, Hardman has now posted five multi-home run games over his last 30. Over those 30 games (dating back to 6/17), Hardman leads all MiLB players with 15 HR. His 26 HR this season are tied for the most in MiLB (Shay Whitcomb, HOU).

HARDMAN > RUNNING MAN: On Friday night, Tyler Hardman tied a career-high mark in scoring three runs. Hardman has now scored a run in nine straight games, which is the longest active streak in the Eastern League.

**BASHING BOWIE:** In nine games vs. Bowie this year, Tyler Hardman has posted 7 HR with a 1.010 SLG, while Somerset has a +29 run differential. SWEENEY'S SUCCESS: Trey Sweeney has hit safely in a team-high 11 straight games, going 17-for-54 (.315 BA, .890 OPS) with 12 RBI, 10 R and 6 BB. Sweeney has now reached base in 18 of 21 games in the month of July.

**PATRIOTS PUNCHOUTS:** With 10 strikeouts in Friday night's 10-0 win (the Patriots' seventh shutout win of the season), Somerset's pitching staff has now struck out 10+ batters in 7 of its last 8 games and 16 times out of 22 games during the month of July. Overall, the Patriots have struck out double-digit batters in 58/93 games (62.4 percent of games) this season. MONTH OF THE MARTIAN: During July, Jasson Dominguez is 27-for-93 (.290/.359/.387) with 12 RBI, 13 R, 2 HR, 10 BB and 10 SB. **ROSIE IS RED:** On Friday night, Jeisson Rosario registered his second three-hit game of the season, reaching base four times. CAREER: (13-13, 3.72 ERA, 212.2 IP, 239 K, 44 BB)

PITCH SELECTION: Fastball (94-96), Changeup (upper 80s), Slider (83-88), Cutter (85-87)

**2023:** In his second start of the season and at the Double-A level on 4/12 @BNG, Fitts struck out a career-high 10 batters, which was the most he had struck out in a game since high school. Fitts matched this mark on 6/10 @HFD, when he also went 8.0 IP, matching his career-best mark.

**2022:** Split his pro debut season between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley, winning Pitcher of the Week honors three times en route to being named a MiLB.com Yankees Organization All-Star in 2022. Began the season with 17 GS in Tampa, going 3-8 with a 5.01 ERA (79.0 IP, 73 H, 93 K, 17 BB). Won his first Florida State League Pitcher of the Week award on 6/27/22, after going 6.0 IP with 6 K, BB and allowing just one hit on 6/25/22 vs. CLR. During his final week with Single-A Tampa, won FSL Pitcher of the Week for a second time on 8/8/22, following another 6 IP, 0 R, 1 H, 7 K performance on 8/5/22 vs. CLR. Promoted to Hudson Valley on 8/9/22. Earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week honors after he took a perfect game into the eighth inning on 8/27/22 vs. HIC (8.0 IP, ER, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K). Struck out a career-high nine batters in his penultimate start of the season on 9/1/22 vs. JS. Across 5 GS to end the season in Hudson Valley, Fitts went 4-0 with a 0.55 ERA (2 ER in 33.0 IP) with a 0.61 WHIP and .152 BAA. Cumulatively on the year, he went 7-8 with a 3.70 ERA and his 0.98 WHIP was the lowest of any qualifying Yankees minor leaguer in 2022.

2021: Did not pitch following the 2021 MLB Draft.

RICHARD FIT

**College:** In three seasons at Auburn (2019-21), went 6-6 with a 5.23 ERA in 40 appearances (14 starts). Heading into his junior season at Auburn, he was named Second Team Preseason All-America by D1 Baseball, Third Team Preseason All-America by Baseball America and was named to the Golden Spikes Award Preseason Watch List.

**Personal Notes:** Attended Helena High School (AL) and was named a 2018 Rawlings-Perfect Game Honorable Mention All-American, after posting 102 K with a 1.68 ERA as a senior. Named a 2017 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention All-American, after he missed most of the season with an injury, but Helena won the AHSAA 6A State Championship and finished No. 1 in a national poll. Named All-Shelby County Honorable Mention as a sophomore. Brother, Trevor, played baseball at Mississippi State, before becoming an assistant coach at Austin Peay and now at the Tigers' High-A affiliate in West Michigan. Fitts grew up a Washington Nationals fan from the point that Stephen Strasburg debuted with the team, because he admired Strasburg growing up. **Career Notes:** Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. He was named a first team All-American by Baseball America, Perfect Game and ABCA becoming the first player in EIU program history to earn first team All-American honors at the NCAA Division I level. His 46 walks (including 11 intentional) set a single season school record. He played in 14 games during the Covid-shortened 2020 season and hit .351. During his freshman season in 2019, he appeared in 55 games, hitting .266. Sweeney was drafted 20th overall in the first round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Yankees, signing for \$3 million as one of three first rounders in EIU history.

Personal Notes: Sweeney attended St. Xavier High School in his hometown of Louisville, KY (same high school as actor Tom Cruise and golfer Justin Thomas, NFL quarterbacks Tony Romo and Jimmy Garoppolo). After entering his junior year at 5'4" in height, he hit an 8-inch growth spurt. Grew up a Reds fan, Ken Griffey Jr. was his favorite player and he would go to Red Triple-A games in Louisville as a kid. Sweeney went undrafted out of St. Xavier and EIU was the only college to offer him a scholarship. In high school, he hit .389 as a senior with 41 RBI and 18 SB en route to leading St. Xavier to a Kentucky State Baseball Championship. His name is Trey because he's the third child in his family, which is also why he chooses to wear No. 3. Upon signing his \$3 million bonus after being drafted, the only major purchase he made was a new set of golf clubs--while he bats left-handed, he golfs right-handed.
