FRISCO FALTERS IN FINALE AGAINST WIND SURGE:

The Frisco RoughRiders took a 2-0 lead early, but could not hang on in a 5-3 loss to the Wichita Wind Surge on Sunday afternoon from Riverfront Stadium. **Jonathan Ornelas**, **Trey Hair** and **Matt Whatley** all tallied two hits in the defeat. The Riders (27-24) jumped out in front early on an RBI single from Ornelas in the second inning, plating **Josh Stowers**. Ornelas finished his day 2-for-4, his 19th two-hit game of the season to lead the RoughRiders. In the third, **Sandro Fabian** cracked his seventh home run of the season - and his second in as many days - to make it 2-0. From there, the Wind Surge (30-19) began their comeback. Anthony Prato brought Edouard Julien in on a sacrifice fly in the third and tied the game at 2-2 in the fourth on a Chris Williams solo home run. In the sixth, the Riders saw **Justin Slaten** (0-3) come into the game in relief and allowed a three-run double to Ernie Yake to put the Wind Surge out in front 5-2. Frisco added a run in the seventh when **Blaine Crim** lifted a sacrifice fly to right, but it was not enough in the 5-3 loss.

READY TO LEIT THEM UP:

Rangers No. 1 prospect and the No. 15 prospect in baseball **Jack Leiter** starts for Frisco in Amarillo today. This matchup will be strength against strength in terms of power. Leiter has allowed just one home run over his 34.2 innings (0.26 HR/9, second in the Texas League with min. 30 IP) while Amarillo has hit the second-most home runs in all of Minor League Baseball (52 over 27 games, 1.9 per game). Amarillo's home OPS of .922 as a team is third in the minors as well.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 2-16 when scoring three runs or fewer and 14-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

BROKEN BATS:

Over the Riders last six games, Frisco is just hitting .211 (12-for-57) with runners in scoring position and have stranded 57 on the basepaths (9.5 per game). In the series against Wichita, the Riders were last in the Texas League with a .227 batting average and a .670 OPS. Frisco is 2-4 over those games, in part due to a 3.60 ERA over the last five games (20ER/50IP). On the bright side, the Riders start a series in Amarillo, which has been one of the most offensive-friendly ballparks in Minor League Baseball this season.

RIDERS OFFENSE BLOOMING LIKE MAY FLOWERS?

In the month of May, the RoughRiders exploded on the offensive side, trailing just the Tennessee Smokies (Double-A, Cubs, 45 home runs) with 44 home runs to place second in all of Minor League Baseball. Their .466 slugging percentage as a team was second in the Texas League (Tulsa, .486) and seventh in Minor League Baseball as well. Their 6.0 runs per game in the month were third in the Texas League as well and 16th in the minors.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 51 games, Frisco has hit 68 long balls (1.3 per game) which is third in the Texas League and tied for 17th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 184 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (beating 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). In May, the RoughRiders hit 44 home runs in 26 games, the second-best total in Minor League Baseball (and averaging 1.7 per game). Out of their 51 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 35 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 1.9 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 16 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-9. **Blaine Crim** leads the Riders with 10 long balls - and is ninth in the league - while **Dustin Harris** is tied for 10th with his nine homers.

CRIM CRUSH:

Blaine Crim has heated up as the season has shifted into late May. Over his last 30 games, Crim is hitting .313 (35-for-112)/.394/.625 with eight doubles, nine home runs and 26 RBIs. Crim had a season-best 17-game on-base streak snapped on Sunday, hitting .323/.429/.554 with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBIs and 14 runs. Crim led the Riders organization in 2021 with 29 home runs and he is atop the org again this season with 10 so far in 2022. His eight homers in May were tied for the most in the Texas League. Overall, Crim was sixth in the league with a 1.096 May OPS.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .338 (27-for-80)/.384/.488/.872 in his last 18 games. He has eight games with at least three hits this season to lead the club and also leads the team with 21 multi-hit games. Ornelas is the youngest player on the Riders as well and the 22-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .342 average on the season, which is fourth in the Texas League, fifth in Double-A, the best in the Texas Rangers organization and 11th in MiLB. Ornelas owns 65 hits, the most in the Texas League and tied for third in MiLB.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 1,008 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well. For the first time during the streak, the Riders have been overtaken by winning percentage, but still are tied with San Antonio atop the South by record.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com. He is listed as the No.1 prospect in the Rangers organization as well.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen in a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
