RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (33-21)

Modesto Nuts (27-27)

RHP Jared Karros (1-0, 1.86 ERA) vs. RHP Marcelo Perez (0-0, 3.00 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest northern road trip of the year with 12 straight games. Tonight is game four of a six-game set against the Modesto Nuts (Mariners) here at John Thurman Field. From here, the Quakes will head to San Jose next week for their one and only visit to Excite Ballpark. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 20 to take on the Lake Elsinore Storm. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE NUTS: Today's game is the fourth of nine between the two clubs this year and the fourth of six at John Thurman Field. Last year, the Quakes went 3-3 here at John Thurman Field and 5-7 overall against the Nuts.

LAST GAME: A six-run ninth rescued the Quakes from dropping a fifth straight game, as they rallied from a two-run deficit to beat the Modesto Nuts on Thursday night, 7-3 at John Thurman Field. Kyle Nevin's two-run single gave the Quakes the lead for good against Modesto reliever Stefan Raeth (0-1), who gave up all six runs in just one-third of an inning. Jesus Galiz had three hits to lead Rancho and was one of four Quakes with a multi-hit game. Rancho reliever Kelvin Bautista (2-0) gave up a run over two innings, but benefited from the six-run ninth to earn the win. Lucas Wepf set the Nuts down in order in the ninth inning in a non-save situation.

MUCH-NEEDED BREAK-OUT: Thursday's six-run ninth was huge for a struggling offense, as the Quakes ended a season-worst four-game losing streak with the win. To put it in perspective, the six runs were as many as they had scored in the entire four-game skid (1,1,3,1). The 11-hit attack on Thursday was the first time the Quakes have been in double-digits since May 27, which was prior to Chris Newell's promotion. In the month of June, the Quakes are hitting just .199 and have three homers in seven games. Rancho's offense is currently ranked fourth overall with a .250 batting average. They are still tops with 51 home runs in 54 games, but are homerless in four straight.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes activated RHP Payton Martin from the Development List on Thursday, as he gave the team three scoreless innings in his return to the starting rotation. Martin took the roster spot of RHP Jeisson Cabrera, who was placed on the Injured List.

STANDINGS UPDATE: The Quakes now have a 4.5 game lead over Lake Elsinore with 12 to play in the first half. Despite losing six of their last nine, that lead of 4.5 games is just one game off of the high-water mark, as the Rancho lead over Lake Elsinore has fluctuated between 5.5 and 2.5 over the last three weeks. Remaining games for the Quakes include three at Modesto, six at North-leading San Jose, then home for three games against the Storm to finish the first half. Lake Elsinore's remaining games include three at Fresno, Stockton at home for six, then three at Rancho. Inland Empire's recent five-game winning streak has vaulted them into the mix, as they're now just one game back of Lake Elsinore, 5.5 games back of Rancho. The 66ers have three at home vs. Stockton, six at Fresno and then three vs. Visalia.

JARED KARROS: Right-hander Jared Karros will make his sixth career start and his ninth appearance overall this year for the Quakes, his first against Modesto. Karros was recently named Cal League Pitcher of the Month for May, as he went 1-0 with an ERA of 1.40 over four starts and five appearances. He did not allow an earned run in three of his five outings and did not allow more than three hits in an outing. Karros is making his first start since May 28, when he fired four no-hit scoreless innings in a no-decision against the Storm. Karros, the son of former Dodger and 1992 NL Rookie of the Year, Eric Karros, was drafted by the Dodgers in the 16th round of the 2022 draft out of UCLA.

MARCELO PEREZ: Righty Marcelo Perez makes his fourth start of the year and his first against Rancho. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on three hits with six strikeouts over three innings in a no-decision at Stockton on June 3. Perez was an 11th-round choice of Seattle in the 2022 draft out of Texas Christian University.
