YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 9-3, beginning with a four-run first inning. Grant McCray opened the scoring with an RBI triple and scored on a single by Victor Bericoto. Later in the inning, Adrián Sugastey brought in two runs with a single. Max Wagner hit a solo homer in the bottom of the first and Anthony Servideo brought in a run with a groundout in the fifth to close the score to 4-2. In the top of the sixth, McCray hit a solo homer, his team-leading sixth of the season. Bericoto hit a three-run homer in the eighth inning to push the lead to 8-2. Dylan Beavers hit a solo homer in the eighth for the Baysox to trim the Flying Squirrels' lead to 8-3. In the top of the ninth, Will Wilson hit a solo homer, his second of in the last two games, to push the score to 9-3. Hayden Birdsong started and picked up his third win of the season, allowing two runs over five innings with seven strikeouts. Wil Jensen allowed one run in his three relief innings. Ben Madison closed out the game with a 1-2-3 ninth inning. Bericoto finished the game 2-for-2 and tied his Double-A career high with four RBIs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the third of a six-game series. This is the first of two visits to Bowie for Richmond. They will return for a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from July 1-3. Richmond won four-of-six against Bowie at The Diamond earlier this season.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-1 in their last eight games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They had lost eight straight games before winning last Wednesday night, starting a five-game winning streak.

THE BAYSOX are in fourth place in the Southwest Division, 3.5 games behind first-place Akron and Harrisburg. They won four-of-six last week at Binghamton. Bowie's roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/1B Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), INF Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright, (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24) and INF Frederick Bencosme (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list features 10 Baysox players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 9), Beavers (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 20), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29). On Baseball America's "Best Tools" list for Orioles prospects, Basallo is rated as the best power hitter, Pham is rated as having the best control, Bright is rated as having the best curveball, Silas Ardoin is rated as the best defensive catcher and Fabian is rated as the best outfield arm.

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his eighth start of the season and his second against the Baysox. He last faced Bowie on April 27 in Richmond and threw seven perfect innings en route to being named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week. Last time out, Bertrand threw 5.2 innings and allowed one run in a no-decision against Reading on Friday at The Diamond. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Seth Johnson makes his eighth start of the year and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Friday at Binghamton and worked four innings, allowing one unearned run in a no-decision. He started two games in Bowie's visit to Richmond last month. On April 23, he allowed a season-high five runs over 2.1 innings in a loss. On April 28, he surrendered two runs over four innings and set a season high with six strikeouts. Johnson was selected with the 40th pick in the 2019 MLB Draft by the Tampa Bay Rays out of Campbell University. Prior to pitching at Campbell, he was a shortstop at Louisburg College. He was traded to the Orioles on August 1, 2022 as part of a three-team deal that sent Jose Siri to Tampa Bay and Trey Mancini to Houston. Following the trade, he underwent Tommy John surgery and returned to the field late last year. In 2023, he made five starts, including one start with Bowie to close his season, and combined to throw 10.1 innings. Johnson is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Orioles prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked second among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (8,009).

HATS FOR BATS, KEEP BATS WARM: Over the last eight games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are hitting a league-best .276 (70-for-255) and have scored 48 runs, an average of 6.0 runs per game, which is also the most in the Eastern League. Over the previous 13 games from April 28-May 12, the Richmond offense hit a league-worst .171 (69-for-407) and averaged 1.7 runs per game (22 runs/13 games). The Flying Squirrels broke the slump with a four-run eighth inning in a 6-4 win last Wednesday night. In winning six-of-their-last-seven, the Flying Squirrels have outscored Reading and Bowie, 48-22.

STRONG ARMS: Dating back to May 14 in the last seven games, the Flying Squirrels have a 2.51 ERA (16 ER/59.0 IP), which is the best in the Eastern League. In that span, Richmond starters are 3-0 with a 2.88 ERA (11 ER/34.1 IP). Flying Squirrels relievers have gone 4-1 with two saves and a 2.14 ERA (8 ER/33.2 IP) in that stretch.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers, three Richmond pitchers rank in the top-12 in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (2nd - 0.86 ERA - 2 ER/21.0 IP), **Nick Garcia** (6th - 1.45 ERA - 3 ER/18.2 IP) and **Wil Jensen** (12th - 1.91 ERA - 6 ER/28.1 IP). Jensen also ranks first the league in relief innings pitched (28.1).

SETTING THE TABLE: Carter Howell is batting .309 (17-for-55) over his last 15 games since May 3 with three doubles, a homer, six RBIs, nine walks and six runs scored. Last Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the Fightin Phils, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer in the fifth inning in a 3-1 win. In his 10 games batting first in the lineup, Howell is batting .308 (12-for-39) with two doubles and five walks. When leading off an inning, Howell is batting a team-best .400 (12-for-30).

GRANTING WISHES: In his last eight games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .478 (11-for-23) with two homers, four doubles, a triple, six walks, seven RBIs and 12 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .197. He picked up a season-high three hits on Tuesday night at Bowie. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .478 (11-for-23) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. He is tied for fifth in the Eastern League with 16 extra-base hits this year.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .364 (8-for-22) over his last six games since May 15 with three doubles and five RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .227. Thomas has picked up two hits in three-of-his-last-four games played dating back to the second game of last Thursday's doubleheader and has picked up a double in each of those three games.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
