LAST TIME OUT

Norfolk, VA (July 15) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders topped the Norfolk Tides 10-2 on Saturday night at Harbor Park. All nine RailRiders hitters had at least one hit to even this three-game set with one game to go.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre opened the scoring in top of the first. Oswald Peraza doubled and scored on a single from Ben Rortvedt.

The RailRiders sent eight to the plate in the second to build a 6-0 advantage. Michael Hermsillo was hit by a pitch and Wilmer Difo walked to start the inning. Estevan Florial doubled in Hermsillo before an Everson Pereira double plated both Difo and Florial for a 4-0 lead. Andres Chaparro hit a 1-0 offering from Norfolk starter Garrett Stallings 397 feet to left to extend the lead.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tacked on a pair in the fourth. Jamie Westbrook led off the inning with a double and scored when Hermsillo reached on an error. After a groundout moved Hermsillo to third, a Florial sac fly brought in the eighth run of the night.

In the fifth, Westbrook and Hermsillo again jump-started the offense. Westbrook worked a walk and scored from first on a double to the left field corner by Hermsillo for a 9-0 lead.

Clayton Beeter got the nod for the RailRiders, one week removed from an appearance in the MLB Futures Game. The right-hander held the Tides scoreless on two hits and one walk with six strikeouts over 4.1 innings of work.

Norfolk broke up the shutout bid with a run in the fifth and added one more in the seventh inning against the RailRiders bullpen.

In the top of the ninth, Jake Lamb doubled to left-center and scored on a single by Westbrook to cap the scoring at 10-2.

Deivi Garcia (2-1) earned the win with 1.2 innings of relief in back of Beeter. Stallings (1-2) took the loss for the Tides, allowing the first six runs on six hits over two innings.

Chaparro paced SWB with three hits, falling just a triple shy of a cycle. Florial, Pereira and Chaparro drove in two runs apiece.

NEWS & NOTES

PEREIRA'S POWER: Everson Pereira has really impressed as the Yankees #4 prospect in his week at Triple-A. He has had a hit in all six games, including three of multi-hit and four multi-RBI. He was named the Co-Lackawanna County Player of the Week with a .529 average. In Somerset, Pereira was batting .291 in 46 total games. There the righty had 10 doubles and 10 homers.

FIELDING FAUX PAS - The RailRiders have committed a total of 77 errors on the season with one last night. This puts them second in the International League with a team at 84. Andres Chaparro has the most with 10. Norfolk has made 57 miscues. San Jose leads all of Minor League Baseball with 118 errors.

SYSTEM STATS: The RailRiders have some prospects who rank in categories at the top of the Yankees farm system. Andres Chaparro leads the organizational affiliate players in games played (81) and runs batted in (60). Estevan Florial leads in homers (21), runs scored (58), and triples (4). On the pitching side, Mitch Spence and Tanner Tully have both started 17 games. Greg Weissert holds the top spot in saves with six to his name. Matt Bowman has pitched in the most contests, 30 separate appearances.

TWO FOR ONE: The pitching staff has induced just 49 ground ball double plays, the least in all of the International League. Randy Vasquez has recorded the most with seven to his name. They have hit into 60 GDP, with Jamie Westbrook accounting for eight total.

RUN DIFFERENTIAL Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has the second best run differential in the International League to start off the second half. The team now has a scored 40 more runs than their opponents in the first ten contests. Andres Chaparro has batted in a team-high 14 runs since June 28, while Jamie Westbrook has scored 14 of his own.

HOMER HEAVEN The RailRiders were the first International League team to hit 100 home runs and they now have 147. This puts them first in all of Minor League Baseball to put the Las Vegas Aviators in second with 141. Norfolk has 122 as a team. The New York Yankees have totaled 131, and the Atlanta Braves have the most with 173. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. SWB homered 20 times against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-one.

LEADING THE CHARGE - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb making his debut last night. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect outfielder Everson Periera (#4 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138R, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.

- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
- Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.
