- The Blue Jays were no-hit in a six-inning, rain-shortened contest on Tuesday night at TD Ballpark, dropping the opener to Fort Myers 2-1.
- Dunedin starter Ryan Watson took a perfect game through 5.2 innings.
- The Blue Jays backed up their starter with a second inning run. Cristian Feliz drew a two-out walk, stole second and then scored on a throwing error from third baseman Yohander Martinez.
- With two outs in the sixth, the Mussles strung together three straight hits against Watson to break the perfect game and shutout, capped off by a go-ahead, two-RBI double off the bat of Byron Chourio.
- Wilker Reyes set the Blue Jays down in order in the bottom of the sixth inning, which turned out to be Dunedin's final at bat. Shortly after Yhoangel Aponte grounded out to end the frame, a thunderstorm moved overhead and the game was called after six innings.

D'ON ON

Fort Myers hurlers Ross Dunn (3 IP), Justin Topa (1 IP), and Wilker Reyes (2 IP) combined to no hit Dunedin in a six inning game last night. The shortened no-no marks the first time the D-Jays have been held without a hit since May 15, 2021, when four Bradenton pitchers combined for a nine inning no hitter.

THANKS, MOTHER NATURE

Last night's storm-shortened loss for Dunedin is just the second time this season a game has been cut short due to rain.

BIG STRETCH

After splitting two games with Lakeland, Dunedin continues its critical eight game stretch out of the All-Star Break by hosting first-place Fort Myers for a six game set. With last night's loss, the Blue Jays now trail the Mussels by four games in the FSL West standings. This week's series will mark the final head-to-head matchups of the season between the clubs.

EIGHT IS SURE GREAT

Tonight's Blue Jays starter Jorge Bautista went eight innings in his last start on July 12 against Tampa, marking the first time since 2018 (Maverik Buffo, 7/9/2018 vs Clearwater) a Dunedin pitcher completed eight full innings. Bautista is the only hurler in the FSL to complete eight full innings this season and one of four pitchers to do so in Single-A in 2024. Despite the accomplishment, Bautista was not awarded FSL Pitcher of the week.

SECOND HALF SLUGGING

Arjun Nimmala and Victor Arias are off to strong starts at the plate in the second half. Nimmala's .993 OPS in 17 games is fourth among FSL hitters (with at least 12 GP), while Arias' .952 mark is good for 6th.

ARIAS AMONG THE BEST

Blue Jays outfielder Victor Arias' full-season wRC+ of 139 ranks third in the league, behind Kevin McGonigle (150) and Ryan Ignoffo (141). wRC+ quantifies a player's total offensive value measured by runs, on a scale where 100 is league average.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Blue Jays have played 32 one-run games this season - tied for the most in the FSL. The Jays are 16-16 in those contests. 61 of the Blue Jays 89 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 32-29 record in those games.

JAMMIN' IN JULY

The Blue Jays' team OPS in July stands at .777 through 15 games - the best mark in the FSL this month, despite last night's no hitter. Dunedin is second in runs scored this month, posing 75 (5 per game).

SERIES SUCCESS

With last weekend's split with Lakeland, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in nine of their last 10 sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series). The lone series loss came at Lakeland, June 25-30, when the Flying Tigers took four of six games.

GIVING IT THE COLLEGE TRY

Of Toronto's 21 draft picks in last week's first year player draft, 16 were drafted out of college, including 10 of the team's first 11 selections. The selections could lead to an influx of college talent to Dunedin's roster. Of the team's 28 current players, just eight played college ball.
