YESTERDAY: George Valera delivered his first career two-home run game to help the Captains beat Lansing, 8-4. Valera hit a two-run homer in the fifth and a leadoff homer in the eighth to take the team lead with 10 long balls. The Captains also scored three runs in the first on back-to-back RBI doubles. Joe Naranjo hit a two-run double and Victor Nova followed with an RBI double to cap a two-out rally. Starter Kevin Coulter picked up the win after allowing two runs over five innings. Jerson Ramirez earned a four-out save by retiring every batter he faced, including a strikeout.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today one game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels and Great Lakes Loons for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, Great Lakes and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 2.5 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are nine games ahead of Cedar Rapids/Great Lakes. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

MOVING UP: Three of the Captains' most impactful position players have been called up to Double-A Akron in the last week. INF Brayan Rocchio (#7 CLE Prospect - MLB.com) and C Bryan Lavastida (#24 CLE Prospect - MLB.com) were promoted last Friday. OF Will Brennan was called up yesterday. Rocchio departed as the team leader in homers with nine. Lavastida exited as the team leader in batting average at .303 and fresh off a 22-game on-base streak from June 24 to July 24, during which he hit .395/.479/.684. Brennan was sixth among qualified High-A Central League hitters in average at .290 and exits at second in the league with 22 doubles.

JULY IN REVIEW: The Captains closed July with the second-best team ERA (4.00) in the High-A Central League during the month, despite allowing the second-most home runs (38). Offensively, the Captains were third in the league in on-base percentage (.347), fifth in slugging percentage (.405) and fourth in runs scored (149).

GETTING ON: Since July 1, the Captains are second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in on-base percentage (.345) and have worked the third-most walks (133). From May through June, the Captains were last in the league in walks (167) and third from the bottom in OBP (.320). George Valera leads Captains regulars with a .434 OBP and has 27 walks compared to 24 strikeouts since July 1. Victor Nova has a .387 OBP since July 1 after posting a .295 OBP in May-June. Since July 1, Aaron Bracho has posted a 14.1 BB% after a 9.9% mark in May-June.

STARTERS ON A ROLL: Captains starters have a 3.21 ERA (17 ER, 47.2 IP) over the last nine games. No Captains starter has allowed more than three earned runs in an outing during that span.

VALERA RAKES AND TAKES: George Valera leads the Captains in homers (8), walks (27) and on-base percentage (.434) since July 1 and has more walks than strikeouts (24) in that span. His 22.1% BB% is up from 11.1% in May-June.

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .282/.387/.551 (.938 OPS) since July 1. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

ALL OR NOTHING: In his last 12 games, José Tena does not have a single one-hit game. The Captains' shortstop has either delivered multiple hits or gone hitless since July 21. He is hitting .217/.308/.413 (.721 OPS) in that span.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 21-11 at home, compared to 22-26 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.87 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.58 ERA on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF Ka'i Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Burns had an early exit against Lansing on July 16th, but the Captains offense stormed from behind to pick up a 13-9 win. On the second pitch of the game from Burns, Shane Selman hit a home run to out Lansing in front 1-0. After Lake County tied the game, Lansing added two more runs in the third inning to retake the lead and end Burns outing. Lansing eventually stretched their lead to 7-1 against the Captains bullpen before the Lake County offense took over the game late. They tied the game with a six-run seventh inning before Lansing re-took the lead on a Jordan Diaz home run in the bottom of the frame. In the top of the eighth Bryan Lavastida delivered the go ahead blow with an RBI double to drive in two, putting the Captains ahead 9-8. Five consecutive hits in the ninth inning added four insurance runs for Lake County. Lansing pushed across one run in the bottom of the ninth but the Captains hung on for a come from behind win 13-9.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by *Perfect Game*. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by *Baseball America*, *Collegiate Baseball*, *D1 Baseball* and *Perfect Game*. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

TEAM USA: In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS **Carson Tucker** (1st Round – 23rd overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

RECRUITING BATTLE: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT: Kevin Goldstein of *FanGraphs* says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Longenhagen, also of *FanGraphs*, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Longenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Longenhagen said. *Baseball America* sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to learn.
