BIRDS' BATS SILENCED BY TRAVS IN 3-1 LOSS: The Cardinals tied a season-low with just 3 hits and the Arkansas Travelers scored twice in the bottom of the 7th inning to break a 1-1 tie as Springfield fell 3-1 in the series opener on Tuesday night at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock. Cards starter Ian Bedell was brilliant for the second straight start with 6.0 innings of one-run ball allowing just 4 hits while striking out 8 in a no decision. Springfield led 1-0 after a run in the 6th inning, but Arkansas came back with a single run in the bottom of the inning before taking the lead for good in the 7th.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Jimmy Joyce** makes his 5th start of the season with the Travelers... Last pitched on Thursday, May 30 against Amarillo and fired 3.0 shutout innings allowing just 1 H with 6 K...Did not factor in the decision, an 8-3 Arkansas win...Has not allowed an earned run over his last 3 starts (9.2 IP) and gave up just 4 H with 11 K in that time...Made his first start of the season on May 6 in the ACL after rehabbing an elbow injury...Made 7 starts with the Travelers at the end of last season and went 0-3 with a 3.82 ERA...Began 2023 with High-A Everett going 2-0 with a 1.60 ERA in 9 starts...2023 considered a breakout/turnaround season catapulting him onto prospect lists thanks to controlling his walk rate (10% to 7%)...Spent most of the 2022 season with Everett going 7-11 with a 5.74 ERA in 23 starts... Selected by the Mariners in the 16th round of the 2021 draft out of Hofstra...Went 3-4 with a 3.71 ERA in 11 starts in final year at Hofstra, earning 2nd team all-CAA...Served as a two-way player in first two seasons with the Pride, batting .209 with a HR in 20 games in 2019...25 years old

CARDS AND TRAVS SQUARE OFF IN CRUCIAL SIX-GAME SERIES: The Cardinals make their second and final trip to North Little Rock this week for a six-game series against the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners). Just a half game separates the two clubs coming into the series with 18 games remaining in the first half. The Cards swept a 3-game series at Dickey-Stephens Park to star the season.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

ROAD WARRIORS: The Cardinals have been more than solid on the road this season, going 17-10 away from Hammons Field. The Cards have a 3.85 ERA on the road, the 2nd best road ERA in the league behind Midland's 3.42, compared to a 5.80 mark at home.

HITS, HITS: Despite being held to only 3 hits in the series opener against Arkansas, the Cardinals still own the top hitting offense in Double-A with a .270 batting average, 5 points better than any other team in the level. The Cards also have 9 more hits than any other Double-A team with 463. Both numbers lead the 2nd-best hitting team at the level, the Portland Sea Dogs.

Nathan Church leads the Texas league in hits with 57, and Bryan Torres ranks 4th with 54.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. After a season-low 3 K's, the Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 363 whiffs in 52 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (355 K in 52 games). The Cards are averaging just 6.98 K's per

POWER OUTAGE: While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. The Cards have not hit a home run in any of their last 8 games, and have hit just one longball over their last 11 contests. Springfield's last home run came on Saturday, May 25: a two-run shot by Mike Antico off Orlando Ortiz-Mayr of the Drillers at Hammons Field.

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a good run of late. Over their last 10 games, the Cards have a team ERA of 3.11, 3rd in the Texas League during that time. During their series in Wichita, the Cardinals registered a 2.55 ERA. The Cards' bullpen was particularly effective against the Wind Surge, regsitering a 2.21 ERA over 20.1 IP with 3 saves on the week.

BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL PLAGUING CARDS STAFF: So far in 2024, home runs and the big inning have hurt the Birds. Springfield has surrendered 36 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 36 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 140 of the 268 total runs scored by the opposition, 52.2% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 8.3% of their innings pitched. In the other 407.2 IP Springfield has allowed 128 runs, which comes out to 2.83 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 21-4 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning". The Birds have not allowed a "big inning" in 6 of their last 7 games.

The Cardinals have also allowed 59 homers in 52 games this season, most in Double-A.

RED-HOT RIVAS: Riding a 8-game hitting streak and an extended solid 15-game stretch, Cardinals shortstop Jeremy Rivas has seen his name rise amongst the top hitters in the Texas League at 3rd among qualified hitters with an average of .310. Over his last 15 games since May 16, Rivas is batting .367 (18-for-49), 2nd in the league behind Bryan Torres (.370) during that time.

SLAM THE DOOR: Since the promotion of **Andre Granillo** to Triple-A Memphis on May 21, Cardinals reliever Matt Svanson has been a workhorse at the end of Springfield's bullpen. Svanson leads the Texas League in appearances with 20 and is 8-for-8 in save opportunities, also tops in the circuit. Since May 21, Svanson is 4-for-4 in save opportunities and has not allowed an earned run over his last 6 appearances and has allowed just one earned run over his last 11 appearances since May 7 and is on a 6.0 inning scoreless streak.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 23 straight games without a home run.




