# SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (0-2, 43-28) vs. WICHITA WIND SURGE (2-0, 39-32)

LHP PETE HANSEN (4-2, 3.59 ERA) vs. RHP CJ CULPEPPER (0-0, 1.35 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** Springfield and Wichita (MIN) meet for the 3rd game of a 6-game series ... Cards are 4-7 vs. Wichita and 2-6 at Equity Bank Park this season ... tonight's game is the 12th of 24 in the season series and 9th of 12 in the ICT.

**TEXAS PETE:** LHP Pete Hansen makes his 14th start and 2nd vs. WCH ... allowed 1 run on 7 hits over 6.0 IP to pick up the win in last start 6/19 vs. CC ... has allowed just 1 ER over 12.0 IP in last 2 starts ... started at WCH on 4/25 and gave up 1 run on 2 hits over 5.0 IP in a no decision.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cardinals were held to a season-low 2 hits and fell 10-1 at WCH ... LHP lxan Henderson allowed a career-high 6 ER over 3.1 IP, his shortest start of the season ... IF JJ Wetherholt delivered SGF's only run with a RBI-single in the 3rd ... OF Kala'i Rosario completed the cycle vs. SGF going 4x5 with 6 RBI.

**SKID STOPPERS:** Wednesday's loss marked the 1st time the Cardinals have lost consecutive games since May 15-16 vs. AMA ... went 25-6 over that 31 game stretch.

**SPRINGY SWEEP:** The Cardinals swept the TXL weekly awards for the week of 6/17-22 ... RHP Tink Hence earned Pitcher of the Week and OF Joshua Baez was named Player of the Week ... SGF has now won 5 weekly awards this season.

**HENCEFORTH:** RHP Tink Hence earned Pitcher of the Week for his start in SGF's no-hitter ... struck out 8 batters over 4.1 IP ... issued just 1 walk ... was his 2024 debut with SGF ... won TXL

Pitcher of the Year and Pitcher of the Month (April) with SGF in 2024 ... was 4-3 with a 2.71 ERA in 20 starts last year.

**JUST JOSHIN':** OF Joshua Baez hit .500 (7x14) with 3 HR, a double, 10 RBI, and a 1.764 OPS in the series vs. CC to win Player of the Week ... the week included his 2nd multi-HR game at Double-A.

**RISING IN THE RANKINGS:** C Leonardo Bernal was moved into MLB.com's Top 100 Prospects list at #100 ... is now ranked #3 in STL organization.

**HISTORIC HALF:** Springfield wrapped up the 1st Half with at 43-26 to mark the winningest 1st Half in franchise history ... finished the half with an 11-1 homestand vs. TUL and CC.

**THE KINGS IN THE NORTH:** Springfield clinched the 1st Half North Division title with a win last Thursday ... is the franchise's 5th 1st-Half title all-time (2007, 2009, 2016, 2024), first back-to-back 1st-Half titles in team history, and 3rd-straight postseason appearance.

**HISTORY AT HAMMONS:** Springfield threw its firstever 9-inning no-hitter in a 1-0 win over CC on Friday ... RHP Tink Hence (4.1), RHP Zane Mills (2.2), RHP Austin Love (1.0), and RHP Sean Harney (1.0) combined on the feat.
