FIREFLIES TOP PELICANS 6-1 ON FRIDAY NIGHT

The Myrtle Beach Pelicans were defeated by the Columbia Fireflies 6-1 on Friday evening at Pelicans Ballpark. In the fourth inning, Stone Russell hit a sacrifice fly to score Luke Nowak, and Milo Rushford singled to drive in Jose Cerice and Yandel Ricardo, giving the Columbia Fireflies (28-34, 64-64) a 3-0 lead. In the seventh inning, a wild pitch by Charlie Hurley scored Brennon McNair, and Tyriq Kemp grounded out to plate Rushford, extending Columbia's lead to 5-0. Kane Kepley singled to score Eli Lovich in the seventh inning, getting the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (42-21, 67-60) on the board at 5-1. Tyriq Kemp tripled to score Dionmy Salon in the ninth inning, finalizing the score at 6-1. Jose Gutierrez (2-4) earned the win for the Fireflies, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, while Dash Albus and Augusto Mendieta combined for 4.0 innings, allowing one run. Victor Zarraga (1-2) took the loss for the Pelicans, surrendering three runs in 5.0 innings, with Hurley and Mathew Peters conceding three more runs. Alexey Lumpuy led the Pelicans, going 2-for-5 while Eli Lovich (2-for-3) and Kane Kepley (1-for-4, RBI) contributed. The Pelicans went 2-for-7 with runners in scoring position, leaving 11 runners on base, while the Fireflies went 1-for-7, leaving five.

HERE TO STAY

The Pelicans celebrated their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999–2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present). Following negotiatons with the Myrtle Beach City Council, the Pelicans were awarded a 30-year extension on the lease at the ballpark that keeps baseball at the beach through the 2055 season.

A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

The Pelicans have a new manager in 2025. Yovanny Cuevas joined the Chicago Cubs organization as a player in 2015. His minor league career ran through 2021 with stops in the Dominican Summer League (DSL), the Arizona Complex League (ACL), and the Northwest League with the Eugene Emeralds. Overall, Cuevas' minor league slash line was .241/.369/.356 over 272 games. In 2022 Cuevas transitioned into a coach. His first assignment was with the ACL Cubs. The following season Cuevas was the hitting coach for the DSL Cubs Red squad, the Cubs affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. Last season he returned to the ACL Cubs as the hitting coach.

MEET THE "SQUADRON"

Highlighting the Pelicans roster are five of the Cubs' Top 30 prospects in Kane Kepley (#12) Cole Mathis (#17 - IL), Angel Cepeda (#24), Ty Southisene (#28) and Eli Lovich (#29). Mathis is the 17th ranked prospect in the organization and made his minor league debut this season with the Pelicans after being drafted 54th overall by the Cubs out of the College of Charleston in 2024. Cepeda slots into the 24th spot in the prospect rankings and is also the youngest player on the roster, having turned 19 in January. Angel grew up in New Jersey and scouts began taking interest in his talent when he was just 14 years old. He moved back to the Dominican Republic before signing with the Cubs in 2023.

The Pelicans Opening Day roster also welcomed eight Cubs' picks from the 2024 MLB Draft to the Grand Strand, including Mathis. Of the eight 2024 draftees, four are pitchers and four are position players. Brooks Caple, Evan Aschenbeck, Hayden Frank, Brayden Risedorph make up the pitchers while the hitters include Mathis, Owen Ayers, Matt Halbach and Cameron Sisneros.

16 players who have experience wearing the Pelicans uniform will return in 2025. **Nazier Mule** made 13 starts last season for the Pelicans, which was third most by any pitcher last season and leads all returners. In 2022 he was drafted by the Cubs in the 4th round and the 20-year-old is ready for his second season in Myrtle

Other returning players include Ayers, Sisneros, Jeral Vizcaino, Leonel Espinoza, Eriandys Ramon, Christopher Paciolla, Jose Escobar, Dilan Granadillo, Yenrri Rojas, JP Wheat, Anderson Suriel, Alfredo Romero, Will Frisch, Luis Martinez-Gomez and Mathew Peters.

THE LUCKY NUMBER 19

The Pelicans Opening Day roster featured three of the Cubs top thirty prospects, including 19-year-old Angel Cepeda. Since that roster was announced Cepeda has seen the promotions of three other 19-year-old top prospects in Yahil Melendez (now unranked), Ty Southisene (now 20 years old) and Eli Lovich. Melendez and Southisene were promoted together, each debuting on May 7th against the Delmarva Shorebirds. The two hit back-to-back in the 7th and 8th spots of the lineup and rolled a 6-4-3 (Melendez-Southisene-Sisneros) double play. Eli Lovich was promoted prior to the series opener on June 10th as the Birds hosted the Hickory Crawdads. The lefty opened his tenure with Myrtle Beach with back-to-back multi-hit nights.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- After leading the league in home runs in both 2023 and 2024, the Pellicans have hit 64 homers this season which is 4th in the league. Myrtle Beach has hit 36 of their 64 homers on the road, the 2nd most road homers of any team in the league. Their 28 homers at home are 9th out of 12 teams.

- Owen Ayers 16-game streak from 6/26-7/22 made him just the fourth player in the last decade to this 15-straight for Myrtle Beach. In playing here Triantes. Peter Core, Martengrand Pauli Beach.

- Owen Ayers 16-game streak from 6/26-7/22 made min lost the fourth player in the last declade thit in 15+ straight for Myrtle Beach...joining James Triantos, Pete Crow Armstrong and David Bote.

- Angel Cepeda's 26-game on-base streak from 4/24 to 6/11 was the longest streak for a Myrtle Beach hitter since Parker Chavers reached base in 27 consecutive games from 5/31/23-7/14/2023.

-In the second half, Myrtle Beach has not only found success, but recorded some special feats...on 7/10/25 at Kannapolis Alexey Lumpuy recorded the first cycle for the Pelicans since Jerrod Wong in 1999, going 4-for-4 with 2 RBI and 4 runs scored...the Pelicans also recorded the fifth nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history on 7/18/25 against Augusta (Jostin Florentino -6.0 IP & Kevin Camacho - 3.0 IP) -Pelicans' backstop Owen Ayers had been a dominant force behind the plate...prior to his injury he ranked 2nd in all of affiliated baseball with 42 caught stealings while ranking 18th in total innings caught (485.2). -MB has allowed 3 or less runs in 37 of 63 games in the second half, going 9-17 in games in which they allow 4+ runs.
