Today: Coming off their second cancellation in the last three scheduled game days, the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, return to action in the first half finale against the West Michigan Whitecaps, High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Lansing has won five of its last seven games, but dropped the series opener on Tuesday night in Comstock Park. Tomorrow, both teams' records will reset to 0-0.

Tuesday: Whitecaps 4, Lugnuts 1. The 'Caps rallied for two runs apiece in the 6th and 7th, and **Hayden Minton** combined with four relievers to limit the Lugs to a sole tally.

On Deck: The Nuts and Whitecaps play one another through Sunday before the Lugnuts return home for a six-game series against Great Lakes, June 23-28.

LUG-NOTES

Starting Strong: Lugnuts starting pitchers have tossed 308 1/3 innings this year, averaging five innings per game, and posting a 15-20 overall record. In contrast, West Michigan starters are 3-15 and average 3 2/3 innings per start.

Thievery: The Nuts have 29 steals in 31 attempts in June, 4th-most in the Midwest League, averaging 2.4 steals per game. In April and May combined, by comparison, the Lugnuts stole a league low 43 bases.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 75 double plays in 623 games, ranking 1st in all of Minor League Baseball.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 18 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 23 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Big League Nuts: 2024 Lugnut **Kade Morris** made his MLB debut on June 6 vs. Houston, becoming the 205th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the fifth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**). There are eight current Lugnuts on the Athletics: Bolte, Jump, **Lawrence Butler**, **Joey Estes**, **Hogan Harris**, **Jack Perkins**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.

Lugnuts Weekly Honors

- **Midwest League Player of the Week, April 7-12:** C/3B **Davis Diaz** batted .611 (11-for-19) while reaching base 16 times and scoring nine runs in five games at Fort Wayne. Diaz added four doubles, four walks, one HBP, and two runners caught stealing.
- **Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, June 9-14:** Southpaw **Ryan Magdic** struck out nine Cedar Rapids Kernels in seven innings of three-hit, one-run ball on an efficient 77 pitches. Magdic, promoted to Double-A on Monday, whiffed 40 while walking just five in Lansing.

Welcome Back: Right-hander **Mitch Myers** returned to the Lugnuts yesterday from Double-A Midland. Myers pitched 215 1/3 innings for the Lugnuts between 2023 and 2024, going 9-13 with a combined 4.93 ERA in 49 games, 39 relief appearances, with only 60 walks compared to 173 strikeouts. Myers was excellent last year for Midland, posting a 1.99 ERA in 22 2/3 innings before his season was ended by an unfortunate Achilles injury on June 1. In his return this year, he was 0-2 with a 6.94 ERA in 35 innings, walking 16 and striking out 37.

JUNE 16 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2002: The Lugnuts hosted their third Midwest League All-Star Game, setting a new league record with a crowd of 10,334. The East defeated the West, 6-3. The game includes future Major League stars Joe Mauer and Edwin Encarnacion.

2013: CF Dalton Pompey's two-out RBI single in the bottom of the ninth lifted the Eastern Division All-Stars to a 6-5 walk-off win over the West in Dayton. 2B Christian Lopes and 3B Gustavo Pierre started the game for the Lugnuts (with future MLBers 2B Devon Travis and 3B Brandon Drury replacing them as reserves). Wil Browning (0.1 IP, 0 R) also represented the Lugnuts. If Pompey had not come through, the game would have ended in a tie. The West had scored three runs in the top of the ninth to tie the game at 5-5.

2017: Happy Father's Day! Vladimir Guerrero, Sr., made a surprise appearance to throw out the first pitch to Vladdy Jr – and then the West Michigan Whitecaps won, 10-1, to finish off the first half. Bo Bichette went 0-for-2 before leaving the game, giving him a .396 batting average in the first half. Guerrero was 0-for-4 with a strikeout, dropping his average to .321.

2026 Campaign: 2026 Lugnuts Opening Day starter... tossed quality start against Quad Cities, April 22: 6 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 1 HR, 1 BB, 3 K on 80 pitches... quality start in rematch vs. QC, May 12: 6 2/3 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 5 K on 90 pitches... lefties are hitting .230, righties hitting .200... allowing .289 avg in 1st inning, .111 in 2nd, .103 in 3rd, .333 in 4th, .136 in 5th... with no outs, allowing a .273 avg., but drops to .203 with one out, .148 with two outs... has posted a 4.15 ERA at home compared to 6.46 ERA on the road.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarría posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarría debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
