RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (5-3)

Inland Empire 66ers (2-6)



RHP Cam Day (0-0, 2.45 ERA) vs. RHP Riley Bauman (0-1, 27.00 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Today's game is the second of six straight on the road, as your Quakes take on the Inland Empire 66ers (LAA) at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes return to LoanMart Field next Tuesday, April 23, hosting Lake Elsinore in a six-game set. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the second of 24 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the second of 12 at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 8-4 here at San Manuel Stadium, 14-13 overall against the 66ers. **LAST GAME:** Jose Rodriguez pitched five strong relief innings and Jeral Perez ripped his first homer of the year, as the Quakes won their fourth straight, with an 11-2 win over the Inland Empire 66ers on Tuesday night at San Manuel Stadium. Perez blasted a two-run shot in the fourth inning, giving the Quakes the lead for good at 2-0 against 66ers' starter Francis Texido (0-1). Rodriguez (2-0) followed starter Edgardo Henriquez (two scoreless innings) by allowing one run on three hits over five innings, while striking out a season-high eight batters. Wilman Diaz and Jesus Galiz each had a two-run triple, while Zyhir Hope extended his personal hitting streak to eight straight with an RBI double. **GELOF GETS POW:** The Cal League announced its first set of weekly awards in 2024 and Quakes' third baseman Jake Gelof was named the Cal League Player of the Week after a strong start to the 2024 season. Gelof knocked in 12 runs in his first seven games and entered this week's action with a .320 batting average and a .424 on-base percentage. Gelof also took home the final Cal League Player of the Week award of the 2023 regular season.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made five moves Tuesday, placing RHP Eriq Swan on the Injured List, while also sending INF Oswaldo Osorio and RHP Ben Serunkuma to Extended Spring Training in Arizona. They filled two of the three spots with a pair of 2023 Quakes, INF Jordan Thompson and RHP Noah Ruen, giving them 29 active players. FAMILIAR FACES ON THE FIELD: The Quakes have 29 active players on their 30-man roster to open this road trip. Of the 29, 23 have seen time in Rancho within the last two years. Returning Quakes include pitchers Patrick Copen, Carlos Duran (2022), Gabe Emmett, Jorge Gonzalez, Roque Gutierrez, Edgardo Henriquez (2022), Carlos Martinez, Garrett McDaniels, Jose Rodriguez, Christian Ruebeck, Noah Ruen, David Tiburcio and Reynaldo Yean. Re turning position players include Jesus Galiz, Cameron Decker, Wilman Diaz, Jake Gelof, Jeral Perez, Jordan Thompson, Joe Vetrano, Juan Alonso, Josue De Paula and Kendall George.

PROSPECTS TO WATCH: The Quakes have four players on their current roster who are rated by MLB Pipeline as Top-30 Dodgers prospects. Three of them play in the outfield, with Josue De Paula (#4), Kendall George (#12) and Zyhir Hope (#21). Infielder Jake Gelof is the other ranked prospect, as he checks in at #23.

CAM DAY: Cam Day will make his first start and second appearance of the year, his first against Inland Empire. In his debut on April 9, Day allowed one run on four hits over 3.2 innings in a no-decision versus Stockton. Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

RILEY BAUMAN: Right-hander Riley Bauman makes his second start of the year and his first against the Quakes. In his only start of the year, he allowed six runs on two hits with three walks and two hit batters over just two innings in a loss at Fresno on April 9. Bauman was selected by the Angels in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of Abilene Christian University in Abilene, Texas.
