**THE CROWTIME SOUNDS:** Brewers no. 23-rated prospect Coleman Crow will make his 15th Triple-A start of the season on Thursday night. The right-hander enters the game having won each of his last three starts and has not allowed a run across 18.2 IP with three straight quality starts. Crow has 22 career quality starts and has turned in a QS every time he has gone 6+ IP. His 22 QS are tied for the second-most in the minors for any pitcher with fewer than 65 GS. He has a six-game winning streak overall with Nashville since suffering his only loss on April 24 on the road in Charlotte when he allowed a season-high eight runs and three home runs in an 11-9 loss. Across his last eight Triple-A starts since July 4 against the Jumbo Shrimp, Crow is 4-0 with a 1.69 ERA (8 ER / 42.2 IP) with 40 strikeouts and 15 walks. He leads all Triple-A in ERA over the span and is T-6th among all qualified full-season minor leaguers. His .185 BAA since July 4 also leads all Triple-A. Nashville is 12-2 in his 14 starts so far this season.

**BO AND ARROW:** Catcher Bo Naylor extended his hitting streak to seven games and drove in the only Nashville run in Wednesday's loss with a RBI double. Naylor is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with three home runs, a double, 10 RBI, and five runs scored over his last seven games since August 12. His seven-game hitting streak is a personal season-long, and the longest active streak on the team after seeing Brock Wilken's seven-game streak come to an end after finishing 0-for-4 on Wednesday.

**OH BEE THREE:** Luke Adams pushed his current on-base streak to 12 straight games after drawing a pair of walks and getting hit by a pitch on Wednesday night. Adams has drawn 10 walks in 11 games played in the month of August overall and has drawn a free pass in six straight games after drawing 10 in 21 games in July. The hit by pitch was the 108th of his minor league career since the start of the 2022 season. Adams has been hit the fourth-most in professional baseball over the span with only Braiden Ward (139, BOS), Ripken Reyes (123, SD), and Michael Arroyo (112, SEA) having been plunked more than Adams.

**THE MURRAY SHOW:** Ethan Murray has a hit in six straight games and has reached base in each of his last 11 games after going 1-for-4 on Wednesday night in Jacksonville. He has tied his season-long hitting streak after also recording a hit in six straight games from June 23-July 1. Overall, he has a hit in 14 of his last 17 games since August 5 with one multi-hit game over the span (2-for-4, 2B) on August 7. His 11-game on-base streak also matches his season-long from June 17-July 2.

**PLAY THE HITS:** The three hit game for Nashville on Wednesday night was the 32nd time the Sounds have been held to five or fewer hits this season and the first time being held to three or fewer since July 28 vs. Charlotte. The Sounds are tied for the fourth-most games with five or fewer hits in the International League along with Lehigh Valley. Norfolk leads the way with 45 such games, and Rochester has had the fewest this season with just 14. Gwinnett (16) is the only other team with fewer than 20 games with five or fewer hits in the International League this season. Nashville is 15-42 when being out-hit by their opponent after Wednesday's loss and are 48-9 when out-hitting teams.

**THREES COMPANY:** Tyler Black finished Tuesday night 3-for-4 with 3-RBI, falling a single shy of the cycle to start the series against the Jumbo Shrimp. It was his first three-hit game for Nashville since June 20 and third overall this season, including the first 3-hit MLB game of his professional career on April 28 vs. Arizona. **Tuesday night was the first game of his professional career (502 G) with three XBH.** He had only previously had 15 games with multiple XBH in the same game entering Tuesday with his last coming during that June 20 performance against Memphis where he finished 3-for-5 with a home run, triple, and RBI. Tuesday's series opener against Jacksonville was his sixth 3+ RBI game this year between Nashville and Milwaukee. **Black is hitting .292 (19-for-65) with six XBH and 11 RBI in 19 games in August.** He has recorded multi-hit performances in back-to-back games and has five multi-hit games in the month.

**BROCKET POWER:** Brock Wilken hit his team-leading 14th home run of the season on Tuesday night in Jacksonville and has three homers in the month of August (20 G). He's putting together his best month of the year, hitting .233 (17-for-73) with eight XBH, 14 RBI, 13 walks, and nine runs scored this month and had an XBH in four straight games from August 20-25. With four games remaining in the month, Wilken is looking to finish with the highest AVG in a single month this season after hitting .233 (14-for-60) across his 18 games in June. **He ranks T-6th in RBI (71), 7th in walks (75), and sits T-7th in doubles (22) in the Brewers farm system this season.** 38-of-70 (54%) hits in Triple-A this year for Wilken have gone for XBH.
