LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox took down the Altoona Curve yesterday in a late morning affair, by a final score of 9-3. The early start time did not stiffle the early offense from Bowie, as the Baysox bats got right back on track with a three-run top of the first via a Coby Mayo solo home run (third of the season) and a Zach Watson two-run blast (second of the season). Bowie would add on another run in the third via a Donta' Williams sacrifice fly to make it 4-0 Baysox. On the mound, right-hander Carlos Tavera was solid, striking out the first four batters he faced. However, he would begin to show signs of fatigue in the fifth, as Altoona got back into the game with a two-run frame. Still, Tavera was able to go 4.1 innings before handing things off to Jensen Elliot, who limited the damage and kept Bowie ahead by a score of 4-2. The Baysox offense would come to life again in the later innings - a four-run two-out rally in the seventh, highlighted by a two-run single from Williams, gave the Baysox an 8-2 advantage. Williams would tack on a career-high-matching fourth RBI in the ninth. The Curve got a consolation run of their own in the bottom half, but ultimately, righthander Connor Gillispie went the rest of the way for Bowie with four innings of one-run ball out of the bullpen.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve are off to a 3-6 start and currently bottom of the Southwest division, albeit only two games out of first place. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Altoona currently roster six of the organization's top-30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Headlining the roster is C Henry Davis (No. 3 PIT/ No. 57 overall), who is hitting .226 entering the series with a pair of home runs, six runs batted in and an OBP of .385. Other top prospects include INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHPs Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT) and Kyle Nicolas (No. 20 PIT), along with OF Matt Gorski (No. 17 PIT) and Matt Frazier (No. 23 PIT). Notable standouts through the first nine games include Frazier, who's hitting a team-high .313 and slugging a team-best .594. His 10 hits and five extra-base hits are both fourth-most in the Eastern League. As a team, the Curve enter the series tied atop the Eastern League with 12 home runs and second with a 730 OPS. However, Altoona also enters tied for the most errors in the league with 13. along with the second-worst team fielding percentage at .960. The Curve are led by first-year manager Callix Crabbe, who managed in the Pirates' system in High-A Greensboro last season

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Jared Jones is set to take the ball today for Altoona. The No. 11 Pirates prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Jones has progessed through the system at a steady pace. He is set to make his third start at the Double-A level this evening. In his first two, Jones allowed a pair of earned runs in 4.2 innings against New Hampshire, before pitching four innings of one-run baseball against Erie, but walked four. So far, the right-hander has walked six batters and hit one in 8.2 innings, which is worth noting, given his issues controling the zone in the past. In 2022 at High-A Greensboro, he lead the Pirates organization in starts (26) and strikeouts (142), while throwing the second-most innings (122.2), but also surrendered the most hits (115) and most walks (64). Selected out of La Mirada High School in California in the second round of the 2020 draft, the Pirates took Jones and signed him over slot value at \$2.2 million in the shortened draft, when he initially had the option to be a two-way player at the University of Texas. His power fastball has climbed to 96-99 mph through his professional career, and is accompanied by a curveball with depth and a sweeping slider, along with a changeup that sits in the high-80s, and can even climb into the low-90s at times

HAIL CÉSAR

INF César Prieto has had a phenomenal start at the plate to begin the 2023 season. Prieto leads the Eastern League with 17 hits. Yesterday's two-hit performance was his the fifth multi-hit game of his Dobule-A career-best 10-game hitting streak. That streak is also the longest across the Eastern League thus far in 2023. Prieto's previous Double-A best was an 8-game hitting streak for Bowie last season that spanned from 5/28-6/7, including a 8-for-22 (.364) series in Altoona. Prieto's longest hit-streak in Minor League Baseball is 12 games, with 10 of those contests coming at the High-A level with Aberdeen before he was initially called up to Bowie on 5/24/22 for the final two games of that streak. Prieto is batting .415 during his current hot stretch

MOUND REBOUND

The pitching staff as a whole has bounced back nicely for Bowie so far in 2023. After posting a 4.42 staff ERA last season, Bowie has the second-best team ERA in the Eastern League, and the third-best in all of Double-A, through 11 games at 2.80. Bowie arms have limited the free passes, with the second fewest number of HBP (3) and walks (44) in the league. The Baysox have also held the opposition to a .216 average with runners in scoring positon.

GETTING STARTED ON THE RIGHT FOOT

The Baysox have gotten off to stellar starts throughout the early phase of the 2023 season. Bowie has scored first in 10 of its first 11 games - the only Eastern League team to have done so. Out of those nine opening scores, seven of them have crossed the plate in the first two innings. The Baysox 14 runs across the first two innings are second-most in the Eastern League. Only Altoona has scored more often in the first two frames, with 17 runs. Bowie starting pitching has also done it's part. Baysox starters have a collective 2.22 ERA on the season, along with four outings of at least five shutout innings. Bowie's +12 run differential in the first two frames is by far its best two-inning window in 2023. The second best window of consecutive innings for the Baysox is the sixth and seventh innings, with a +6 run differential.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-26 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helin of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.
