MONDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats fell flat in the series finale to the Portland Sea Dogs, losing 9-3 at Delta Dental Stadium on Sunday night. New Hampshire never led in the contest and has now lost 13 of 18 to Portland in three series meetings this season. Starting right-hander Luis Quinones pitched four hitless innings but ran into trouble in the fifth, giving up three runs on three hits and two walks, while striking out five, receiving the loss. The 26-year-old could not get through the fifth, finishing the night with 4.2 innings pitched, which was his longest outing of the season. Steward Berroa collected his 19th RBI of the year with a groundout to the shortstop Yu Chang in the fifth to open the scoring for New Hampshire. Berroa finished the night 2-for-5 with two stolen bases and had 4 RBIs in the series. The 24-year-old is one of three players in the Eastern League with 30 or more steals. Portland hit two more home runs against the New Hampshire bullpen with Alex Binelas and Nathan Hickey teeing off in the sixth inning and ninth inning, respectively. Damiano Palmegiani and Will Robertson both collected a pair of hits each with Palmegiani recording an RBI single in the seventh. Palmegiani leads the team with 18 multi-hit games on the year.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: Orelvis Martinez has been much more patient at the plate this year than last. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect has 36 walks on the season in 66 games played – he had just 40 walks last year in 118 games played. June was his best month so far from a discipline standpoint, striking out only 14 times (fewest in a month) while walking 14 times. He continues to be among the Eastern League leaders in homers (3rd) and RBI (3rd).

IT'S BECAUSE HE GETS ON BASE: Orelvis Martinez is on a 13 game on-base streak while Leo Jimenez is on a 14-game on-base streak after walking three times yesterday. For Martinez, it is his longest on-base streak of the season after his previous season-high was 12 straight games. Jimenez's season-long on-base streak is 18 games from May 23 to June 15

SAY CHEESE!: RHP Chad "Cheese" Dallas gets the start for the Fisher Cats tonight on the 4th of July. In three starts on the road, Dallas has a 1.02 ERA in 17.2 innings with 16 strikeouts over just two walks. Dallas is nicknamed Cheese after growing up watching the 1995 Disney classic A Goofy Movie. His favorite character was the "cool kid" Bobby (voiced by Pauly Shore), who ran around spraying Cheez Whiz into his mouth.

HOT HITTERS: Over their last five games, Orelvis Martinez is hitting .400 (6-for-15, 2B, RBI), Damiano Palmegiani is hitting .368 (7-for-19, 2 2B, 2 RBI), Steward Berroa is hitting .357 (5-for-14, HR, 4 RBI) and Trevor Schwecke is hitting .357 (5-for-14).

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 4, 2010) - Kyle Drabek tossed the only nine-inning no-hitter in Fisher Cats history 4-0 over the Rock Cats before 6,037 in Manchester. Drabek, the son of Cy Young award winner Doug Drabek, allowed two walks and struck out three. Drabek had come to the Blue Jays organization in the deal that sent Roy Halladay to the Phillies. Drabek did play in 43 MLB games, winning eight with Toronto in 2011 and 2012 - but struggled after a second Tommy John surgery.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (45-40) will start Chris Bassitt (8-5) in Chicago tonight against Lucas Giolito (6-5) for the White Sox. Blue Jays are 11 back of first place Tampa Bay - and are currently two games behind the Yankees for the final wild card spot in the AL...Buffalo (37-43) rolled past Worcester 8-1 with a 16-hit attack. Paxton Schultz allowed just one unearned run in five innings for his first Triple-A win. Hagan Danner, Yosver Zulueta, and Jimmy Burnette combined for four hitless innings in relief. The Bisons head to Rochester tonight...Vancouver (44-30) will head to Hillsboro to open a series tonight.. The Canadians had yesterday off after taking five of six from Spokane...Dunedin (37-38) fell 13-11 at St. Lucie last night. Jeffrey Wehler had a big night, going 3-5 with a triple, a homer, and five RBI. He went 11-for-23 in the series that the Jays won 4-2. Dunedin is back home tonight to play Tampa.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their road trip this week against the Hartford Yard Goats. After the series, the Fisher Cats will have a four day All-Star break before returning home for a three-game series against the Altoona Curve beginning on Friday, July 14.
