TUESDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats fought back to win the series opener against the Harrisburg Senators 6-5 at FNB Field on Tuesday night. There were five lead changes in the game and the Fisher Cats trailed until the sixth when Phil Clarke hit a go-ahead two-run homer off Washington Nationals left-handed rehabber and two-time All-Star Sean Doolittle with a fly ball into the right-field seats. The home run gave the Fisher Cats a 5-4 lead, which they would not relinquish for the rest of the night. Leo Jimenez led New Hampshire with a game-high three hits and was a triple shy of the cycle. His second home run of the season to left-center in the fifth tied up the score at the time 3-3. Will Robertson and Damiano Palmegiani both collected a pair of hits with Palmegiani recording a pair of RBI singles in the first and third. On the mound, Sem Robberse got the start for New Hampshire, throwing 4.2 innings and allowing four runs on seven hits and no walks while striking out four, getting a no-decision. Righthander Gabriel Ponce picked up the win after a 1.1 shutout innings of relief with two strikeouts. Left-hander Mason Fluharty struck out four in 1.2 innings of work and right-hander TJ Brock recorded a four out save and struck out the side in the ninth for his second career Double-A save.

SHOVING THE SHOVE: New Hampshire's pitching staff owns the third-lowest ERA in the Eastern League at 3.94 behind Akron and Portland. The Fisher Cats have also struck out the most hitters in the league, averaging 10 strikeouts a game while allowing the fewest home runs in the league along with Somerset (38). New Hampshire starting pitchers are second in the league in strikeouts behind Somerset while opposing hitters are hitting just .211 against the bullpen, tied for second-lowest in the Eastern League.

OWNAGE IS OWNAGE: Several Fisher Cat hitters have seen Harrisburg pitching well through one full series back at Delta Dental Stadium in early May. Leo Jimenez (.417, 10-for-24, HR, 2B, 3 RBI), Will Robertson (.412, 2 2B, HR, 4 RBI), and Steward Berroa (.353, 6-for-17, 3 2B, HR, 4 RBI) have all put up good numbers against Senator

CAN'T STOP CLARKE: Phil Clarke is currently on his longest hit streak of the season at six consecutive games. The catcher is hitting .435 (10-for-23) in that span with a double, home run and four RBIs. Clarke did not have a six-game hit streak all of last year - his season-long was five games. The Vanderbilt product also leads the catching unit in starts with 28 on the season.

THE POWER OF PALMEGIANI: Damiano Palmegiani put together another productive day at the plate on Tuesday, going 2-for-4 with two RBI, including a pair of RBI singles in the first and third. Palmegiani now has an eight-game hit streak (tied for longest on the team), his second eight-game hit streak of the season. He is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with a 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI in that span. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect also has a teamleading 13 multi-hit games on the season and six multi-RBI games, which is second on the team.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (June 7, 2005)- New Hampshire started a week of games at Akron and Erie with a 4-1 win at Canal Park over the Aeros. The first of two pitchers the Fisher Cats have had named Zach Jackson dazzled in his second New Hampshire start, allowing one hit in seven scoreless innings. He struck out eight. Jackson, a compensatory first-rounder in 2004 (Texas A&M) would make it to the Majors Leagues with the Brewers (2006, 2008) and Indians (2008, 2009) after a pair of trades.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays (34-28) bounced back against the Astros, winning 5-1. Kevin Gausman struck out 13 over seven innings and George Springer, Daulton Varsho and Bo Bichette all homered in the win...Triple-A Buffalo (26-32) defeated Toledo 10-7. Luis De Los Santos collected a game-high three RBIs and homered in the victory...High-A Vancouver (27-24) fell to Everett 2-0...Class A Dunedin (25-27) lost to Bradenton 10-3. Tucker Toman drove in two RBIs and recorded two hits.
