## FRES-NOTES

**MAKING IT A THING:** After trailing by six runs in the ninth inning of the series opener in San Jose on May 5th, the Grizzlies rallied to force extra-innings before winning 13-11. This Tuesday in Fresno, the Grizzlies fell behind by five after the top of the fourth, but a pair of four run innings helped the Grizzlies comeback in another series opener against the Giants, regaining sole possession of first place.

**ALL AROUND EFFORT:** Tuesday's win helped the Grizzlies improve to 11-8, despite playing the fewest home games in the California League to this point. With a 15-12 record on the road, Fresno is the only team in the California League to post winning records at both home and on the road more than a third of the way into the season.

**PATIENCE PAYS:** The Grizzlies continue creating offense even when the hits cool because of their ability to control at-bats. Fresno entered the series with 238 walks, among the top totals in the California League, while several hitters continue forcing deep counts – including Cam Nelson, who leads the league in walks, and Derek Bernard, Clayton Gray, and Roldy Brito, who continue stabilizing innings through on-base ability. Against San Jose, that patience has translated into pressure, helping Fresno average nearly eight runs per game in the matchup. Fresno is 5-2 in the first seven meetings between the clubs.
