THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2009, Adam Heether and Brendan Katin hit back-to-back homers in the third inning in Nashville's 11-1 rout of Oklahoma City at Greer Stadium. Heether, Katin and Joe Koshansky combined to go 9-for-11 with six runs and six RBI.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Memphis Redbirds play game two of a six-game series tonight. The Sounds cranked out four homers in a 12-4 series opening win. Right-hander Janson Junk will face left-hander Zack Thompson.

Janson Junk: 27-year-old Janson Junk starts for Nashville tonight. The right-hander is 4-4 with a 3.93 ERA (68.2 IP/30 ER) in 13 games (12 starts) for the Sounds. He also made a start for the Brewers in April. Junk was stellar in his last start on June 23 vs. Norfolk, working 7.0 two-run innings in the win (2 H, 1 ER, 0 BB, 2 K). He enters today ranking among league leaders in WHIP (3rd, 1.22), ERA (4th) and opponent batting average (5th, .244). Junk has earned the win in both of his last two starts and has given up less than four earned runs in each of his last four, boasting a 3.22 ERA (22.1 IP/8 ER), 0.99 WHIP and .217 opponent batting average this month. He is holding right-handed hitters to a .216 average (33-for-153) with a .320 slugging percentage and .600 OPS in Triple-A. The Seattle University product was acquired by Milwaukee in the trade that sent Hunter Renfroe to the Angels on November 23, 2022. He was originally drafted by the Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

Zack Thompson: 25-year-old Zack Thompson starts for the Redbirds in game two. The left-hander is 1-3 with a 9.96 ERA (28.0 IP/31 ER) in nine outings (8 starts) for Memphis. He's also made 11 relief appearances for St. Louis in 2023 (1-2, 4.63 ERA, 11.2 IP, 12 H, 7 R, 6 ER, 9 BB, 18 K). Thompson was lit up by the I-Cubs on June 22 where he gave up seven runs (all earned) in 3.0 innings at Des Moines. He began the season pitching for St. Louis before being optioned to Memphis on May 2. A Wapahani, Ind. native, Thompson was drafted by the Cardinals in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Kentucky.

A-Jax Blast Zone: Alex Jackson launched a pair of homers for the second time this month in yesterday's rout. The homers extended his hitting streak to eight games dating back to June 10th. Jackson is batting .519 (14-for-27) with two doubles, four homers, nine RBI, four walks and 12 runs since the streak began. As a team, the Sounds have had seven multi-homer performances over the past four weeks.

Turang Back to the Show: Brice Turang moved his hitting streak to 13 games last night before getting recalled by Milwaukee this afternoon. He batted .320 (16-for-50) with 10 runs, five doubles, three homers, 15 RBI, six walks and .993 OPS from June 13-28. At the time of his recall, Turang's hitting streak was tied for the second longest active hitting streak in the International League.

The Grand Toro: Abraham Toro broke the game open with a third inning grand slam, the Sounds' third grand slam this season and Toro's second Triple-A homer in 2023. It was Abraham Toro's third grand slam in his career and his first since August 31, 2021 with Seattle vs. Houston.

Good Second Half Start: The Sounds start of the second half of the season 1-0 after yesterday's win. It is the first time that the Sounds have played in a split season since their Double-A Southern League days from 1978-84. Nashville won each of their last six second half titles from 1979-84.

Putting the League on Lock: Limiting Memphis to four runs last night, Nashville hurlers continue to have the lowest ERA in Triple-A (3.99), ahead of Norfolk (4.55). Nashville pitchers also lead the level in fewest hits allowed (587), runs allowed (334), WHIP (1.34) and opponent average (.241). This month, the Sounds have the lowest ERA (3.54), fewest runs allowed (94) and best WHIP (1.28) in Triple-A.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, right-handed pitcher Abner Uribe is the No. 9 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect, who is on the injured list.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 641-552 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Junk spun a 7.0-inning gem his last time out on June 23 vs. Norfolk. He allowed two runs (one earned) on two hits, did not issue a walk and struck out two. Junk was incredibly efficient, throwing just 74 pitches for 51 strikes, earning the win in the Sounds' 10-3 victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Junk has one previous appearance against Memphis, which came on April 7 of this season. He tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits and earned the win
