SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 13-4. Altoona scored runs in the first and third innings to take a 2-0 lead. Richmond tied the score in the fourth with a **Brady Whalen** RBI double and a Curve error. The Flying Squirrels took the lead with four runs in the seventh inning, two on wild pitches and two on a double by **Shane Matheny**. The Curve scored two runs in the bottom of the inning to close the score to 6-4. In the eighth, **Brandon Martorano** hit an RBI double and **Jimmy Glowenke** worked a bases-loaded walk to open an 8-4 lead. In the ninth, Martorano hit a two-run triple and Glowenke added a three-run double to push the lead to 13-4.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond won four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29 and went 3-4 in a series at Prince George's Stadium from June 13-18. The two teams split the most recent series at The Diamond from July 4-9, with the Flying Squirrels taking the first three and the Baysox winning the last three.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 25-15 in their last 40 games since June 18 but went 2-4 in last week's series at Altoona. They went 5-1 the previous week against the Sea Dogs at The Diamond. Over the last 45 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.06 ERA (58 ER/170.2 IP) and have allowed 12 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.83 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 372.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 504.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.58 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE BAYSDX went 4-2 in last week's home series against the Sea Dogs after going 1-5 the previous week on the road against the Patriots. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including SS Jackson Holliday (No. 1), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 10), 3B Max Wagner (No. 12), OF Jud Fabian (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 17), and C Silas Ardoin (No. 28). Holliday is also rated as the No. 1 prospect in baseball.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his 17th Double-A start and his fifth outing against the Baysox. He last pitched last Tuesday at Altoona and allowed one hit over five scoreless innings with a season-high nine strike-outs. That performance led to Seymour being named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He first faced the Baysox on April 25 at Prince George's Stadium and allowed two runs over three innings. He pitched again in Bowie on June 16 and surrendered one run over four innings. On July 4 at The Diamond, Seymour held the Baysox to two runs over 3.1 innings and struck out six, which was a season high at the time. In the finale of that series on July 9, he allowed a season-high five earned runs in three innings. This season, Seymour is fourth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.81), third in WHIP (1.20) and third in BAA (.223). He also has the second-lowest HR/9 (0.65) and fifth-highest groundball percentage (48.0) in the Eastern League. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 14 Giants prospect and No. 16 by MLB. com. FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Alex Pham makes his seventh Double-A start and his second appearance against Richmond. Last time out, he was charged with a loss after allowing a Double-A-high three runs in 5.1 innings against the Sea Dogs last Tuesday at Prince George's Stadium but also set a Double-A high with seven strikeouts. He pitched in Richmond on July 7, his lone Double-A relief outing to date, and fired three scoreless innings with five strikeouts. Pham was selected by the Orioles in the 19th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of San Francisco. He began this season with High-A Aberdeen and went 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings, earning the South Atlantic Pitcher of the Month award for May.

STARTING STRONG: In last week's series, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on Saturday night. On Tuesday, **Carson Seymour** held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. **Spencer Bivens** threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start on Wednesday night. On Thursday, **Wil Jensen** allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season. **John Michael Bertrand** threw five scoreless innings in his start on Friday night. **Hayden Birdsong** made his Double-A debut on Saturday and threw two scoreless innings before allowing three runs in the third. **Ryan Murphy** allowed two runs in his three innings on Sunday afternoon. Richmond starters have a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP) since August 2.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 15 games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .321 (18-for-56) with two doubles, six walks and seven RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in the last home series against the Sea Dogs. He hit .227 (5-for-22) in last week's series against the Curve but picked up three walks in the Sunday finale. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 24 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .310 (26-for-84) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .400 (6-for-15) in his last four games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs. On Sunday, he went 2-for-4 with a double and four RBIs.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 29 times in his last 12 games since July 25 (15 hits and 14 walks), hitting .375 (15-for-40) with one homer, four doubles, one triple and nine RBIs adding a .527 on-base percentage. On July 30 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored on Wednesday night against the Curve. On Friday night, he went 1-for-2 with two walks and he added a hit, a walk and a sac fly on Saturday. He added two doubles and two RBIs in Sunday's game at Altoona. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 122 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

TAKE A WALK: Hayden Cantrelle has walked 64 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is second-most in the Eastern League. His 19.4% walk rate is the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the third-best on-base percentage (.399) in the league this year. His 64 walks this season are the second-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, moving ahead of 62 by Jarrett Parker (2013) and Mark Minicozzi (2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by Jacob Heyward in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 87 walks this season.

MARTY PARTY: In his last five games since July 30, Brandon Martorano is batting .353 (6-for-17) with a double, a triple, two walks and four RBIs. He had five hits and three walks in his four games this week against the Curve. He went 2-for-4 with a walk on Wednesday. On Friday night, he went 1-for-2 with a double. He closed the series on Sunday going 2-for-4 with a double, a triple and three RBIs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 4 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 13), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 14 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 24) and RHP Jose Cruz (No. 26). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Brown (No. 5), Roupp (No. 10), Seymour (No. 14), Murphy (No. 23), Birdsong (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 26).

THIS DATE IN SOUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2010, the Flying Squirrels beat the Portland Sea Dogs, 16-8. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the first with a sac fly by Brandon Belt, but Portland answered with two runs in the bottom of the inning. Over the middle three innings, Richmond score 15 unanswered runs to pull away. Sharlon Schoop went 4-for-5 with a three-run homer and totaled six RBIs, which was a single-game team record at the time. Darren Ford also had four hits. Nick Noonan hit a three-run homer.

IN OTHER WORDS...

Manager **Dennis Pelfrey** on the team's offensive breakout on Sunday afternoon:

"Obviously over the last week, there were some frustrations for our guys offensively. The message was always to stick to the plan, stick to your approach and things are going to work out. I think too many times guys will falter or go away from what has helped them become successful in those moments.
