#### By the Numbers

The Captains are currently on a 6-game winning streak, which is their longest winning streak of the season. This is the third-longest active winning streak in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Cleveland's Double-A affiliate Akron RubberDucks (8 games) and the Great Lakes Loons (7 games).

Captains INFs Maick Collado and Nate Furman are both currently on 12-game on-base streaks. During their respective streaks, Furman and Collado have recorded a combined 30 hits and 14 RBI, while tallying OBPs of .577 and 404 respectively.

As a team, the Captains have hit 19 home runs so far this season, which are tied for the third-most in the Midwest League. Lake County hit 4 home runs last week at West Michigan, and has hit 7 in its first 6 games against Fort Wayne this year.

#### CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Tuesday night, the Captains defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps in the first game of a six-game home series by a final score of 1-0 in 10 innings at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake. This was Lake County's sixth consecutive victory, extending its longest winning streak of the season.

Offensively, the Captains scored the only run of the night on a walk-off throwing error in the bottom of the 10<sup>th</sup> inning. After LF **Justin Boyd** hit a two-out single to right field, SS Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, got caught in a rundown between third and home. After a 9-2-5-2-5 exchange, an errant throw from third base hit **Devers** on the back, allowing him to score the game-winning run. **Devers** also recorded his second consecutive 3-hit game, tallying his team-best sixth multi-hit game of the season.

Lake County RHP Austin Peterson (ND) recorded his second consecutive quality start, and the longest start by a Captains pitcher this season. The 24-year-old pitched a season-high 7.2 scoreless innings, allowing 4 hits and one walk, while throwing 6 strikeouts in 86 pitches (67 strikes). After RHP Magnus Ellerts pitched 1.1 scoreless frames of relief, RHP Alaska Abney (1-0) earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 10th inning out of the Lake County bullpen.

21<sup>ST</sup> SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21<sup>St</sup> season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,755 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,385-1,370 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

#### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

A WILD WIN LAST NIGHT: With its 1-0, 10-inning, walk-off win over Fort Wayne on Tuesday night, Lake County recorded plenty of firsts this season. This was the team's first extra-inning game and win, walk-off win, and shutout of the year. It was also the Captains' first 9+ inning 1-0 walk-off victory since April 9, 2009 versus Hagerstown (also went 10 innings).

MOONEY'S STELLAR SERIES: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, was named the second Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for his performance in last week's series at West Michigan. The 21-year-old hit 8-for-21 (.381), with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, one walk, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-bypitches. Mooney's 2 home runs (tied for 2nd), 5 extra-base hits (3rd), and 7 runs (tied for 3rd) all ranked top-three in the Midwest League this past week.

KAYFUS CRUSHING THE BALL: Lake County INF/OF C.J. Kayfus has been one of the Midwest League's premier hitters in his first 14 career High-A games. The 22-year-old ranks top-eight in the Midwest League in slugging percentage (.630, 2<sup>nd</sup>), batting average (.352, 4<sup>th</sup>), OPS (1.040, 4<sup>th</sup>), and RBI (15, tied for 8<sup>th</sup>). He is also currently of a 6-game hitting streak, during, which he is hitting .348 with 8 hits, 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 7 RBI, 3 walks, and a 1.081 OPS.

COLLADO COLLECTING BASES: Captains INF Maick Collado has reached base at an incredible rate in his first 13 career High-A games. The 21-year-old has a .536 OBP, while hitting .350 with a .986 OPS. Collado also ranks top-10 in the Midwest League in walks (15, tied for 8th). He is also currently on an 8-game hitting streak, which is tied for the second-ongest active streak in the Midwest League. During this stretch, Collado is hitting .379 with 11 hits, 2 runs, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 7 walks, and a .997 OPS.

DEVERS DELIVERING AT THE PLATE: Lake County INF Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, has been performing very well at the plate recently. Over his last 5 games, the 20-year-old is hitting 9-for-20 (.450) with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 walk, 1 stolen base, a .476 OBP, a .550 SLG, and a 1.026 OPS.

MOONEY MAKES HISTORY: On Saturday, April 27, Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied a pair of franchise records. The 2023 seventh-round pick went 5-for-5 with 3 doubles, becoming the 16th Captain to record a 5-hit game, and the 13th to record a 3-double game. Mooney recorded the first 5-hit performance by a Lake County player since Bobby Ison on 8/7/2016 vs. West Michigan, and the first 3-double performance since current Double-A Akron RubberDucks OF Chase DeLauter on 7/9/2023 at Lansing.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Back on April 25 at West Michigan, **Parker Messick** (1-0) tossed his first quality start of the season, earning his first win of the year. The left-hander tossed 6 shutout innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts in the 4-1 win.

**BEST SINCE BIBEE: Messick**'s 1.77 ERA is the lowest by a Captain through four starts since 2023 American League Rookie of the Year runner-up **Tanner Bibee** posted a 0.00 ERA through four starts in 2022.

**MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Messick** ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Midwest League in ERA (1.77), 4<sup>th</sup> in strikeouts (27) tied for 6<sup>th</sup> in innings pitched (20.1), and 10<sup>th</sup> in opposing batting average (.221). Since his High-A debut on 6/29/2023 vs. Fort Wayne, **Messick's** 102 strikeouts are the most in the Midwest League.

**TOP 30 PROSPECT: Messick** is currently Cleveland's No. 21 prospect according to MLB Pipeline. Per Baseball America, "He throws from a low release point, which helps him get swings and misses on his fastball. His tumbling changeup is his best pitch and gives him a strong weapon against right-handed hitters."

**2023 IN REVIEW: Messick** started his first career 13 games with Single-A Lynchburg from April 7 to June 10 before starting 11 of 13 games with High-A Lake County from June 29 to September 9. **Messick** finished second in the Cleveland player development system with 136 strikeouts and a 3.77 ERA. In his final seven starts for the Captains, he posted a 2.52 ERA, 48 strikeouts, 12 walks and a .211 opposing average in 35.2 innings of work. Overall, **Messick** also recorded 6 quality starts (4 with Single-A Lynchburg, 2 with Lake County).

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Last season, **Messick** was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 5/8-5/14. On May 10, the left-hander excelled in a road start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (CHC). **Messick** earned his second career Minor League win, pitching a career-high 7 innings and allowing career-lows of 1 hit (since tied), zero runs (tied), and zero walks (tied), while throwing a then-career-high 7 strikeouts.

FLORIDA STATE PHENOM: Messick had a stellar college career at Florida State. In 2020, as a true freshman, he was named a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper Freshman All-American. Then, in 2021, as a redshirt freshman, Messick became just the second-ever player to be named ACC Pitcher & Freshman of the Year in the same season. He was also named a semifinalist for the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year Award, as he finished with a .225 batting average, 9 hits, one home run, and 5 RBI on the season as a hitter. Messick's 2021 performance led to him being named a 3rd Team All-American by four different publications, as well as pitching for the 2021 USA Baseball Collegiate National Team. Finally, in 2022, he led Florida State with 144 strikeouts, as he was the only ACC pitcher named a finalist for both the 2022 Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy. Messick was also named a 2022 1st Team NCBWA All-American. When his collegiate career ended, Messick was FSU's all-time leader with a 6.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
