**Tonight:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open their 27th home schedule with the first of a six-game series against the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps, the High-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Whichever team prevails today would break a 214-214 tie in the all-time series between the two clubs.

**Starting Matchup:** Venezuelan right-hander **Christian Fernandez**, who started last Tuesday's Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental against Michigan State, makes his official 2023 debut, facing Australian left-hander **Jack O'Loughlin**, the third southpaw starter to face the Nuts in the first four games of the season. Fernandez faced West Michigan once in 2022, allowing one run in 3 1/3 innings, while O'Loughlin tossed 14 1/3 innings against the Lugnuts in six combined outings, allowing eight runs (six earned). O'Loughlin also made two starts against Lansing in 2021, allowing four runs (three earned) in 10 innings.

**On the Air:** Today's game is available for viewing at MiLB TV with audio streamed via <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing>. **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** has the call.

**Off the Field:** Today, like all Tuesday home games, is **Tacos and Tallboys**, with \$4 tacos and \$4 tallboys. Unlike all Tuesday home games, however, today also features a Dixieland band, a caricaturist, a magician and much more! Tomorrow is the first **Dog Days of Summer** of the year, with dogs welcome, followed by a **Coors Light Thirsty Thursday** (\$2 domestics and \$5 craft drafts). A 2023 Lugnuts schedule poster will be given to fans upon entering the ballpark.

### LUG•NOTES

**Meet the New Boss:** **Craig Conklin**, the Nuts' Assistant Hitting Coach last season, is the 18th manager in Lugnuts team history. Hailing from Malibu, Calif., Conklin entered professional baseball as an area supervisor at the Major League Baseball Scouting Bureau. He then spent four years scouting Southern California for the Athletics before serving on the Triple-A Las Vegas Aviators' staff in 2019 and on the Single-A Stockton Ports' staff in 2021. This is his first season managing in Minor League Baseball.

**Sweeping into the New Season:** The Lugnuts opened 2023 with a three-game sweep at Great Lakes, beating the Loons 4-3 (10 innings), 4-1 and 4-2. The last time the Nuts swept a season-opening series was 2017, a four-game home-and-home sweep of the very same Loons. At that series' end, 18-year-old **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was hitting .417 with a 1.338 OPS while 19-year-old **Bo Bichette** was batting .400 with a 1.204 OPS. The Lugnuts also swept a season-opening series in 2012 from Great Lakes.

**Singles Club:** Lansing pitchers posted a 1.61 ERA over the 28 innings of the series, limiting Great Lakes to a .149 batting average. Of the Loons' 14 hits, only two went for extra bases – and those came in the final inning of the series. The Nuts' 0.89 WHIP and .149 average allowed each ranks second in the MWL, and the pitchers' four double plays induced is tied for 1st.

**To the Max:** Lugnuts shortstop **Max Muncy** hit safely in all three games in Midland and leads the Midwest League in batting average (.462), hits (6), doubles (3) and extra-base hits (3).

**Ready for a Roundtripper?** No HRs have been hit in the first three games of the season, with the cold conditions having a little something to do with that. Number of games it took to see the first home run in a season: 2022 - four; 2021 - one; 2019 - three; 2018 - two; 2017 - one; 2016 - two; 2015 - two; 2014 - one; 2013 - one; 2012 - four; 2011 - one; 2010 - one; 2009 - six; 2008 - one; 2007 - one; 2006 - five; 2005 - two.

**Fast Start:** The Nuts lead the MWL with eight stolen bases, led by **Lazaro Armenteros'** league-leading four steals, more than seven of the 11 other teams. The opponent over these next six days, West Michigan, is the only team in the circuit that has yet to attempt a steal.

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** It was the Lugnuts' first win of the year, an offensive outburst that saw Lansing score four runs in the seventh and five runs in the eighth inning to wipe away a seemingly commanding 7-1 Great Lakes lead. Kevin Nolan supplied the crowning blow with a two-run single, delivering the Nuts a sensational 10-8 victory at Dow Diamond.

**2018:** The Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Lugnuts at Parkview Field, 9-4, thanks to an eight-run seventh inning off reliever Dany Jiménez, capped by a Carlos Belen grand slam to left field.

**Life as a Lugnut in 2022:** Assigned to Lansing on July 10 after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays with Triple-A outfielder Cal Stevenson on July 9 for Christian Bethancourt... debuted for the Nuts on July 13 at Fort Wayne, looking great with a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing three runs on three singles and two walks in the second inning and then a fourth run in the third inning on two singles sandwiched around a wild pitch... after delay due to All-Star Break, made second start on July 27th, allowing seven runs at Great Lakes in two innings (four runs in 1st, three in 2nd... gave up leadoff home run in each frame (Eddys Leonard, Edwin Mateo)... impressed with five hitless innings at Dayton, August 10th.

**The Early Word:** When announcing the trade with the Rays, Athletics general manager Dan Feinstein summed up Fernandez to the media, "A four-pitch mix. Fastball averages 93. Three really good off-speed pitches. The change-up is probably the best one. Has the ability to get swings and misses, plus a slider and curve ball." Feinstein also informed the media that Fernandez missed the 2021 season with an unspecified arm injury.

**Home Cooking:** Home of Cabimas is located in northwestern Venezuela on the shore of Maracaibo Lake in the state of Zulia... notables from Cabimas include MLB ace Pablo López and longtime Major Leaguer Vic Davalillo (1963-1980).

**Path Through the Pros:** Debuted in 2016 in Dominican Summer League working entirely out of the bullpen... converted to starting pitcher in 2017 DSL with greater success... split 2018 between DSL and Gulf Coast League... spent 2019 in Appalachian League... missed 2020 (canceled MiLB season) and 2021 (injury).

**2022 Dominance in the Rays' System:** Opened this season as a middle reliever in the Charleston RiverDogs bullpen, striking out five in 2 1/3 innings vs. Myrtle Beach on April 10 in season debut; it had been 958 days since his last MiLB appearance on August 27, 2019... pitched out of the bullpen through late May, peaking in final appearance with eight strikeouts in four innings vs. August, May 20... moved into the starting rotation May 26 vs. Delmarva and responded with four scoreless innings, six strikeouts... made five starts in June: 3.27 ERA, 22 IP, 10 BB, 30 K, .195 avg. ... in two starts in July: 2.79 ERA, 9 2/3 IP, 3 BB, 10 K, .263 avg. ... longest start: 5 2/3 IP at Myrtle Beach, July 1 (5 H, 2 R on 2 solo HR, 1 BB, 6 K)... excelled at home (33 2/3 IP, 2.14 ERA, .197 avg., 1 HR) compared to road (24 1/3 IP, 3.70 ERA, .207 avg., 5 HR)... because of change-up, very tough on lefties (.179, 0 HR) vs. righties (.223, 5 HR)... limited opposition to .179 avg. with runners in scoring position.
