TODAY'S GAMES: With the series at 3-2 in favor of the River Cats, the Space Cowboys can split their six-game series in the finale on Sunday... This is the first time the River Cats are coming to Constellation Field and just the second series all time between Sugar Land and Sacramento (4/5-10, 2022), with Sacramento taking 4 of 6.
ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: LHP Nick Allgeyer allowed a run in the first but then hurled 6.0 innings without allowing another run... Sugar Land took advantage of 5 errors by the River Cats and blasted three home runs, with homers from Justin Dirden, Joe Perez and David Hensley in a 10-3 victory.
ROSTER MOVES: 6/18-RHP Shawn Dubin recalled by Houston... RHP Brandon Bielak optioned to Sugar Land... 6/17-RHP Joel Kuhnel acquired in a trade with Cincinnati and optioned to Sugar Land... 6/16- LHP Matt Gage optioned to Sugar Land... 6/11 - LHP Matt Gage recalled by Houston.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 12 players drafted by the Astros, 4 international signings and 2 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys roster boasts seven of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline They include C Korey Lee (\#5), OF Pedro León (\#6), OF Justin Dirden (\#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (\#11), INF Joe Perez (\#14), RHP Forrest Whitley (\#19) \& OF Quincy Hamilton (\#22)

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 4-5-0 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-0 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 2-0-0 in their last two home series and 2-2-0 overall at Constellation Field.

SAY JAI-RO: On Monday, RHP Jairo Solis was named the PCL Pitcher of the Week for the week of $6 / 5-11$.. The righty tossed a season-high 6.0 innings against the Isotopes on 6/8... After allowing a single and a home run to the first two batters, Solis faced the minimum over his next 13 hitters and retired 17 of the final 20 he faced, giving up just one hit, a hit batter and a walk during the rest of his outing, striking out 7 .

ON THE RECORD: RHP Joe Record had his streak snapped at 13 straight outings without allowing an earned run on Tuesday night, giving up two runs in the 9th... It was just the second blown save of the year for Record, who still picked up the win for Sugar Land... In 22 of his 27 appearances, Record has not allowed an earned run this year... His nine saves are the second most in the PCL, and Record is tied for the league-lead in appearances in the Pacific Coast League with 27.

## BIRTHDAY LAUNEHING POINT: Outfiedder Pedro Leon

 turned 25 on $5 / 28$ and celebrated by blasting a solo home run... Since his birthday bomb, Leon has hit safely in 10 of his last 15 games with 2 doubles, 5 home runs, 10 RBI, 2 stolen bases and 14 runs scored.WHIT-BOMB: Shay Whitcomb has brought his power to the Space Cowboys, launching another home run in the 3rd inning on Thursday night... All told, Whitcomb has homered in five of his first 11 contests, accounting for 12 RBI... Whitcomb was held without a hit on Friday night, snapping a seven-game hitting streak.

Whitcomb now has 17 home runs between Double-A and Triple-A, tied for the third most home runs in MiLB (Jo Adell, Trey Cabbage \& Chris Newell - 19, 4 Players with 18,7 players, including Whitcomb, with 17).

The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs, RBI (48), extra-base hits (29) \& total bases (124), is second in runs scored (45), and third in hits (61).
WHAT'S YOUR NAME, MAN?: In his Triple-A debut on 6/7, Quincy Hamilton homered in each of his first two times up, launching an opposite-field homer to left in the 2 nd and a solo home run to right in the 4th... It's the second multi-home run game of his career for Hamilton, with his other coming on July 15, 2022 while with High-A Asheville... Hamilton provided an encore on $6 / 8$, hitting a solo home run in the 7 th inning, and homered for a third straight game on $6 / 10$ with a solo shot in the 8th.
In his first game at Constellation Field, Hamilton launched a go-ahead grand slam in the fourth, the fourth grand slam of the year for Sugar Land... Including his final game with Double-A Corpus, Hamilton has gone deep in seven of his last 14 contests.
POWER SURGE: Since the start of their six-game series in Albuquerque on $6 / 6$, the Space Cowboys have homered in 11 consecutive games, their longest consecutive streak with homers this season... In that span, Sugar Land has hit 24 homers, the second most in the PCL, trailing the Sacramento River Cats, who have hit 26.
WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high among full season MiLB teams.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a $24-8$ win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee-6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) \& at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on $5 / 4$ against ABQ, going 4-for- 5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on $5 / 5$ @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 \& 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, $5 / 2$ @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5 -for- 6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- Primary Logo: The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- Horizon Gradient: Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- Mission Patch: This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in ' 16 and ' 18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its ' 13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

LAST TIME OUT: Got the start in the opener on Tuesday night... Tossed a season-high 5.0 innings and struck out five, allowing four runs on six hits... Departed with a 5-3 lead and looked to be in line for the victory when Sugar Land took a 7-4 advantage heading to the sixth... Sacramento tied the game with two in the ninth, but the Space Cowboys ultimately won 9-8 in the ninth.

COMING BACK: Placed on the IL on 4/29... Activated on $5 / 20$
WALKING THE TIGHT ROPE: Walked a career high 8 batters in 4.1 innings of work on April 11 against Oklahoma City. Despite the eight free passes, Tamarez allowed just one run against the Dodgers.

SHOW BEFORE THE SHOW: Made his Triple A debut on Sept. 8, 2022 at Round Rock ... Made four appearances to end the year with Sugar Land, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA... In his final appearance of 2022, threw five nohit innings against and allowed a run on five walks and six strikeouts.
