TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue their lone series of the season against the New Hampshire FIsher Cats at PNG Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Matt Fraizer sent the Curve to a second straight walk-off win with a 3-run homer in the 10th to finish off a 7-5 win.

SEND US HOME: Altoona picked up their eighth walk-off win of the season on Friday, August 30 against New Hampshire when Matt Fraizer yanked a 3-run homer over the right field wall in the 10th inning. The Curve's 8 walk-off wins this season puts them in striking distance for the franchise record of 10, set by the 2005 Curve.

THE GUY WE WANT UP THERE: Infielder Brenden Dixon picked up his second walk-off hit of the season on Thursday, August 29 against New Hampshire. After Altoona bunted the game-winning run to third to start the 10th in a tie game, New Hampshire intentionally walked Matt Fraizer and Termarr Johnson to set up a force play at home and Dixon made them pay with a single to left-center to earn the victory.

THAT BALL IS L0000000NG GONE: Altoona banged three homers in their win over New Hampshire on Wednesday, August 28, the most in a game for the Curve at PNG Field since May 25, 2023 when the Curve hit four homers in a 16-0 win over Hartford.

UNCHAPPED: Emmanuel Chapman has fulfilled a critically important role on Altoona's pitching staff throughout the season. Since June 19 he's recorded a 2-1 record and a 2.14 ERA (46.1 IP / 11 ER), 45 strikeouts and a .152 BAA in his last 17 appearances (4 starts). In that time he's matched his career-long outing of 4.0 innings four times.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27 ahead of their series with the Fisher Cats. At 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, <u>Johnson is the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve,</u> behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro this season, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB. He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94). Johnson's first Double-A hit was a two-run homer off New Hampshire's Nick Fraze on Wednesday, August 28.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (25 games), he's batting: .315/.408/.449/.857 with 5 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 4-5 SB. Siani had a season-long 11-game on-base streak end on August 25 during which he hit: .297 with a .409 on-base percentage.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 58 road games, Cheng is batting .249 with a .772 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 51 home games, Cheng is batting .175 with a .543 OPS totaling 7 2B, 1 HR, 18 RBI and 32 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .362 with a 1.111 OPS in 47 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

KERVIN AND THE GIANT PEACH: Infielder Kervin Pichardo had a 17-game on-base streak from July 23 - August 15, and has picked up right where he left off with hits in 5-of-8 games since. <u>Pichardo has reached base safely in 24-of-28 games since July 23, during</u> which he's hitting .261/.317/.486/.803 with 3 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR, 17 RBI and 2-2 SB. Since then he ranks T-4th in the EL in HR (6).

THE CATS THAT FISH: Cesar Martin is back for his fourth season as the Manager for the Fisher Cats. New Hampshire has spent much of the season in the bottom of the standings for the Northeast Division and enter this week with 48 wins, the fewest in the Eastern League and third-fewest by a Double-A club. New Hampshire's roster is a bit light in the prospect department, though former Curve INF Charles McAdoo is currently manning the hot corner for the Fisher Cats. McAdoo was traded to the Jays in exchange for INF/OF Isiah Kiner-Falefa at the trade deadline this season.

THE FIRST MEOWER: Abdiel Mendoza takes the ball for New Hampshire tonight. A 25-year-old from Chitre, Panama, Mendoza makes his 30th appearance and 7th start for the Fisher Cats this year, he's recorded a 3.47 ERA. Mendoza has also made 3 appearances for Triple-A Buffalo this year and has gone 2-3 with a 3.10 ERA in 5 games, 4 starts in the month of August. Mendoza spent the first five years of his professional career with the Texas Rangers and was claimed in the minor league Rule V by Toronto following the 2021 season.
