**GAME 100:** After pounding the Hillcats last night in game one of the series, the FredNats will try to get over .500 for the first time in the second half tonight against Lynchburg in the 100th game of the year. RHP Luke Young starts on the mound for Fredericksburg, and he's coming off two wins in his two starts over the last two-week home stand. Young has the all of the sudden high-powered FredNat offense working behind him as well. Fredericksburg has scored 19 runs in the last two wins combined, and 53 runs in seven games (six wins) since the arrival of 2023 draft class. The FredNats have gotten strong starting pitching overall of late. The starting pitcher has pitched into the 5th inning in three out of the last five starts for Fredericksburg.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT**: Dylan Crews had four hits, including his first career grand slam, and the FredNats cruised to an 11-2 win in the series opener at Bank of the James Stadium. Roismar Quintana also put up the first four-hit game of his professional career, including a double and an RBI. Andrew Pinckney had two more extra base hits including a home run, and Marcus Brown had two hits and two RBI. In a bullpen day on the mound, the pitching staff allowed just two runs on three hits to the Hillcats in one of the most dominating and impressive wins of the entire season for the FredNats.

A CREWSIAN BLAST: Dylan Crews has played just three games with the FredNats, but he's made a huge impact. He's homered in back-to-back games including a grand slam yesterday, and then he added on three more hits and a walk to boot. Saturday night's debut game with the FredNats is the only organized baseball game in the year 2023 that Crews has not reached base. He reached in every single game he played in for LSU this spring, and he's reached in three out of his four professional games so far as well.

INSTANT IMPACT: Fourth round draft pick Andrew Pinckney has made an instant impact since arriving to Fredericksburg last week. In five games in the series with Salem, Pinckney went 10-for-20 with three doubles, his first professional home run, six RBI, nine runs scored, and struck out just three times compared to two walks. His efforts earned him the Carolina League Player of the Week honor, becoming just the second FredNat this year and the first member of the 2023 draft class to win any type of weekly award at any level. Daylen Lile was the other winner of the award in July prior to his promotion to High-A Wilmington. Then, last night, Pinckney homered again and drove in three total runs after he hit a two-run double. He has 12 hits with the FredNats, and seven of them are of the extra-base variety.

**CLOSE IT OUT:** When the FredNat offense has given the team a late lead in games this year, the bullpen has done well to close the games out. Fredericksburg is 39-5 this year when leading after seven innings, and 35-3 when leading after eight innings. Seven different pitchers have recorded a save this year for the bullpen.

THE CALVARY HAS ARRIVED: In addition to second overall pick Dylan Crews debuting last weekend, a good chunk of the Nationals' 2023 draft class has already arrived in Fredericksburg. 2nd round pick Yohandy Morales (INF) out of Miami (FL) highlights the group that includes 4th round pick Andrew Pinckney (OF) from Alabama, 5th round pick Marcus Brown (INF) from Oklahoma State, 6th round pick Gavin Dugas (UTL) from LSU, 8th round pick Jared Simpson (LHP) from Iowa, 14th round pick Elijah Nunez (OF) from TCU, and 16th round pick Austin Amaral (RHP) from Stetson. Additionally, prior to yesterday's game, 9th round draft pick Thomas Schultz (Vanderbilt) and 12th round draft pick Travis Sthele (Texas) joined the FredNats in Lynchburg.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 33, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Luke Young makes his 10th start in his last 11 outings for the FredNats tonight against the Lynchburg Hillcats. Young's season, much like his fellow relievers, started out a bit rocky before turning around in May. Young worked to an ERA of 8.49 in April, but dropped it to 3.00 in five appearances throughout May.

**SELF MADE:** Young was very lightly recruited as a high-schooler, with his fastball sitting in the mid 80's. He elected to go to Midland Junior College in Texas, where he got the heater up to 96 MPH. That earned him an offer to pitch at Oklahoma State, but Young elected to sign with the Nationals.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Young picked up a season-best eight strikeouts against Salem in his last outing. Luke worked five innings total and allowed just a pair of runs, while scattering six base hits and walking three.
