HOOKS DOWN RIDERS IN SERIES FINALE:

HOOKS DOWN RIDERS IN SERIES FINALE:
The Frisco RoughRiders' offense picked up steam late on Sunday but a five-run deficit was too large, as the Corpus Christi Hooks won the series finale 7-5 at Riders Field. Down 7-2 in the eighth inning, Frisco (29-28, 60-65) scored three times in the eighth and loaded the bases in the ninth, but both times the Hooks (29-28, 62-64) stranded the tying run at second. Jack Leiter (2-6) struck out seven over 3.1 innings in his start for Frisco, walking one and allowing one run on three hits. The single run came in after his departure in the fourth inning, and since he was responsible for the runner at first, he was charged with the go-ahead run and the loss. All seven of Leiter's strikeouts were on fastballs. He threw 61 pitches on the evening, 42 for strikes. Kellen Strahm doubled in the fifth inning for Frisco's first hit of the game. Diosmerky Taveras (2-3) did not allow any other hits over five shutout innings to earn the win. Logan VanWey pitched the ninth inning without a run to take the save. Angel Aponte led off the sixth inning with his first Double-A home run. Frisco came back for another run that inning when Aaron Zavala singled and later scored on Keyber Rodriguez's sac fly. Four different RoughRiders singled in the eighth inning, including an RBI base hit by Rodriguez. Josh Hatcher doubled for two RBIs on his birthday to bring the Riders within two runs. Frisco stranded Hatcher at second that inning and then left the bases loaded in the ninth. Zavala and Liam Hicks led off the ninth with singles, followed by Jax Biggers' walk, but Frisco did not score. The Riders lost the series, four games to two, and are now five games behind the Amarillo Sod Poodles for first place in the second-half standings with 12 games remaining. with 12 games remaining.

WELCOME, WYATT:
Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games.

START ME UP AND NEVER STOP

RoughRiders starting pitchers were great in the series against the Hooks. Every pitcher through the first five games went at least five innings with **Nick Krauth** throwing six innings on Saturday. **Jack Leiter** went just 3.1 innings while on a pitch count. Overall, in 29.1 innings, they allowed just five runs for a 1.53 ERA. In those 29.1 innings, the Riders ceded just 21 hits while striking out 27 and walking nine.

BROKEN BATS: Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** on August 2nd, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 3rd, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.4 runs per game, a .235 batting average and 17 home runs over their 28 games.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in five of the last nine games. The Riders are tied for the Texas League lead in first-inning runs with 95 over their 124 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.370/.436/.806 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 626 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .356 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: Evan Carter (74, 5th), Trevor Hauver (71, 6th), Aaron Źavala (66, 8th) and Kellen Strahm (65, 10th). In 2015, Drew Robinson set the single-season record with 83 walks.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 58 games since, he is batting .294/.405/.477/.882 with 17 doubles, seven home runs, 33 RBIs and 41 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 42 points and his OPS 98 points.

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 39 games, Hicks is batting .313 (42-for-134)/.427/.410/.837 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 23 walks and 18 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

ROBJECT RELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on August 17th in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 11 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trey Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Went to University of Washington for college. Earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2015, going 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA. In 2016 and 2017, garnered All-Pac-12 honors with a 2.98 ERA and 3.15 ERA, respectively.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (T6th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.
