**JUMBO SHRIMP LOSE FOURTH-STRAIGHT TO BATS**  
Despite three scoreless innings from **Anderson Pilar**, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp lost their fourth-straight contest to the Louisville Bats, 4-3 Saturday. Louisville (62-74, 24-38) found life trailing in the seventh. Joey Wiemer led off with a single off **Collin Lowe**. **Tucker Barnhart** followed with an RBI double cutting the deficit to 3-2. After an error **Erik González** singled, tying the game at three. Two batters later, **Bubba Thompson** grounded into a double play but González scored the go-ahead run to put Louisville on top 4-3.

### SLIP 'N SLIDE

Despite owning a 5.89 ERA through the first 15 games in August (third-worst in the International League), Jacksonville balanced that with the second-best batting average (.283) while going 8-7. On Monday, August 19, the Jumbo Shrimp were just 5.5 games behind first-place Columbus for the top spot in the IL. Since then, Jacksonville has been free falling in the standings, falling to 13th in the International League. In their last 17 games, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .223/.2924/.318/.612, which ranks 18th, 19th, 20th and 19th respectively. On the flip side, despite posting a 6-11 record, the pitching staff's ERA ranks third (4.25) and they're holding opponents to the lowest batting average against (.222).

### ONE RUN TO RULE THEM ALL

After last night's 4-3 loss, Jacksonville has now played in 49 one-run contests in 2024 and their eighth in their last 17 games. The Jumbo Shrimp are 3-5 in one-run games during this stretch. Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents 25-23.

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 31-37 (.456) record. Jacksonville has scored only 281 runs at home (4.1 per game), the second-fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 312 (4.7 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 304 runs (4.5 per game), the fourth-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded tied for the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (331, 4.9 per game). Thus, their run differential is +8 on the road, but -50 at home.

### STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 12 wins during the month of August, nine came by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 49 games this season decided by one run (22-27) the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 87 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 64.4 percent of the club's 135 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 44-43 (.506) in those tightly-decided contests.

### LADIES FIRST

When Norfolk scored the game's first run on Sunday against Jacksonville, it marked the 17th consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .529 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark, with a 9-8 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 68 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 46 contests (67.6 percent). Jacksonville is 16-30 (.348) in those affairs.

### IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

After the last 17 games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of Nashville, Norfolk and Louisville have combined to surrender only 21 runs, 18 earned, on 46 hits (6.1 H/9) in 67.2 innings (2.39 ERA, 70 K, 28 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this 17-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 42-for-231 (.182) at the plate, scratching across only 16 runs in 57 innings.

### SHRIMP BITES

With Louisville scoring first Wednesday night, opponents have opened the scoring against Jacksonville in eight of the last 10 games. In seven of those contests, opponents have scored in the first inning. With his solo homer Thursday night, **Deyvison De Los Santos** has extended his Minor League home run total to 37 across multiple levels. De Los Santos has clubbed 14 homers in the Texas League, Pacific Coast League and nine in the International League. He leads all of MiLB in HR (37), RBIs (109) and total bases (283).

### ABOUT RYAN

-Had committed to Vanderbilt University prior to signing with the Padres, who selected him with the seventh overall pick in the 2018 draft.

-Named the Tennessee Gatorade National Baseball Player of the Year in 2018 after posting a 0.09 ERA and going 11-0 with 148 strikeouts in 76 innings.

-Led MLB in pickoffs (9) in 2021, the most in a single season since Eric Lauer (10) in 2018. The Padres own three of the highest single-season pickoff totals since 2016: Clayton Richards (8, '17), Weathers (9, '21) and Lauer (10, '18).

### 2024 SEASON

-Placed on the 15-day injured list on June 8, 2024 with left index finger strain.

### 2023 SEASON

-Traded from San Diego to Miami on August 1 in exchange for first baseman Garrett Cooper & right-handed pitcher Sean Reynolds.

### 2022 SEASON

-Set career high in appearances with El Paso (31) and IP (123.0).

### 2021 SEASON

-Posted a 6.38 ERA in 18 starts but made 12 appearances out of the bullpen, where he posted a 2.49 ERA.
